2021 Census Data for Carmarthenshire - National Identity

Analysis:

- Carmarthenshire has seen a proportional decrease of 2.7% in residents who consider themselves to have Welsh only identity since the 2011 census.
- The proportion of residents who consider their identity to be Welsh and British only has increased by 1.0%.
- There has also been an increase (1.8%) in the proportion of residents whose national identity is British only.
