2021 Census Data for Carmarthenshire – Distance travelled to work

Analysis:

- The number and proportion of residents travelling to work in all categories of distance (from 'Less than 2km' to '60km and over') have reduced in Carmarthenshire, Wales, and England and Wales. The highest number in Carmarthenshire travel between 10 and 20km to work but has reduced by 2.9 percentage points from the 2011 census.
- Reduction in the above figures is mainly due to the increase in the number that work at or from home with a 9.1 percentage points increase in Carmarthenshire, 15.2 in Wales and 20.9 in England and Wales. The census took place in March 2021 in the middle of the Covid-19 pandemic when people were requested to 'work from home wherever possible' therefore this may well be different by now.

Definition:

- The distance, in kilometres, between a person's residential postcode and their workplace postcode measured in a straight line. A distance travelled of 0.1km indicates that the workplace postcode is the same as the residential postcode. Distances over 1200km are treated as invalid, and an imputed or estimated value is added
- "Work mainly at or from home" is made up of those that ticked either the 'Mainly work at or from home' box for the address of workplace question, or the "Work mainly at or from home" box for the method of travel to work question.
- "Other" includes no fixed place of work, working on an offshore installation and working outside of the UK.
- Distance is calculated as the straight line distance between the enumeration postcode and the workplace postcode.
