2021 Census Data for Carmarthenshire – Accommodation Type and persons in household

Analysis:

- 40.3% of households in Carmarthenshire live in a Detached property, a slight increase from the previous census (39.1%), this is far higher than in Wales with 28.5% or England and Wales with 23.2%, where the highest type of accommodation is semi-detached.
- 67.5% of Carmarthenshire households have only 1 (31%) or 2 (36.5%) people living in the property, this has increased from a combined total of 66.5% previously. This is slightly higher than in Wales (67%) and higher than in England and Wales of 64.3%, which has reduced slightly from 64.2% previously.

Definition:

Household

A household is:

- one person living alone: or
- a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address who share cooking facilities and share a living room or sitting room or dining area A household must have at least one usual resident at the address. A group of short-term residents living together or a group of visitors staying at an address is not classified as a household.

Accommodation type

This refers to the type of accommodation used or available for use by an individual household. Examples include the whole of a terraced house, or a flat in a purpose-built block of flats.
