1	Everyone, adult or child, can be given a voice – an opportunity – a right – to be heard as an individual, as a citizen, to shape the decisions that affect them. As part of the new Social Services and Well-Being Act, clients are asked whether they are satisfied with their care and support. The 2016/17 survey showed that 83.2% were satisfied. We shall do all we can to improve on this. (PAM024)	No target set
2	As part of the new Social Services and Well-Being Act, carers are asked whether they feel supported to continue in their caring role. The 2016/17 survey showed that 78.5% felt they were. We shall do all we can to improve on this. (PAM/026)	No target set
D	We do low cost adaptation works in private dwellings as quickly as possible.
