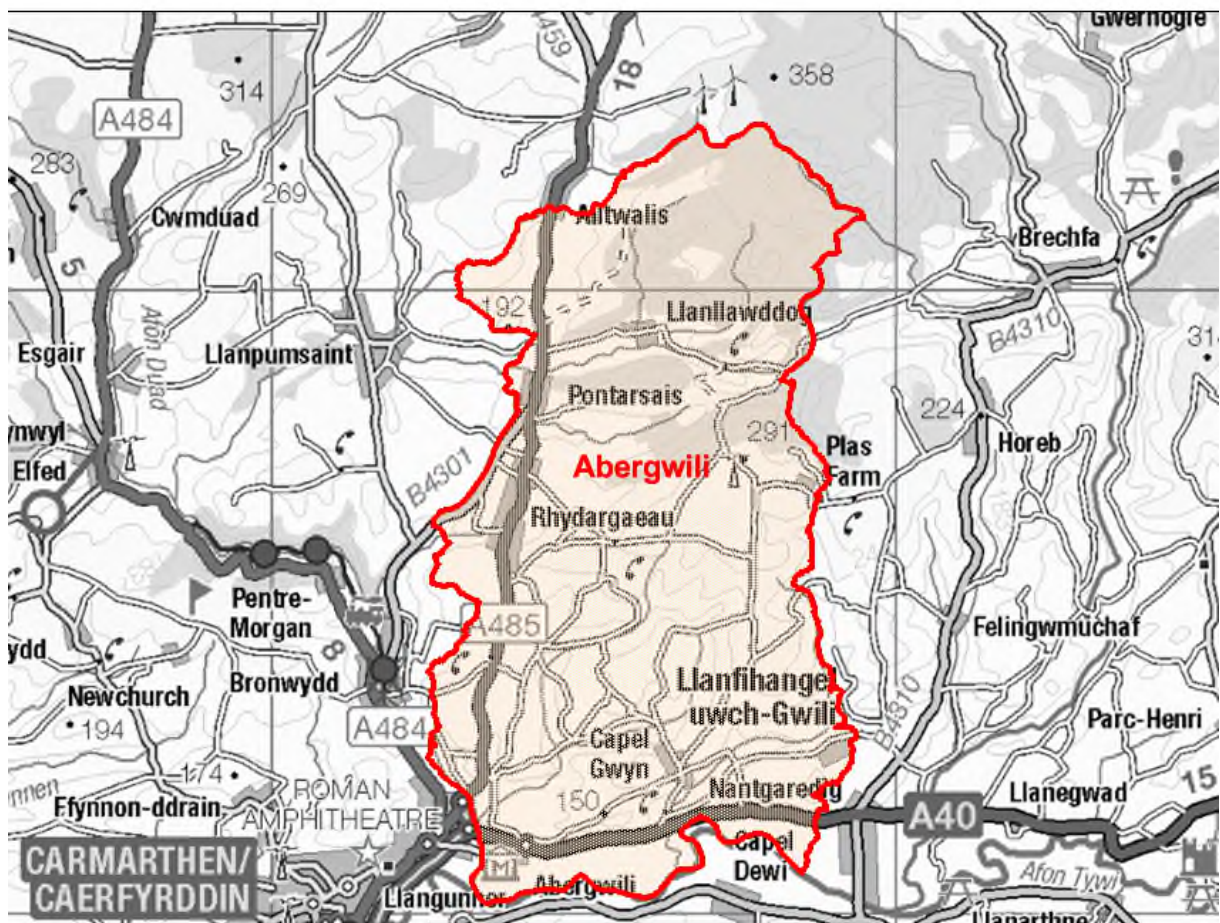

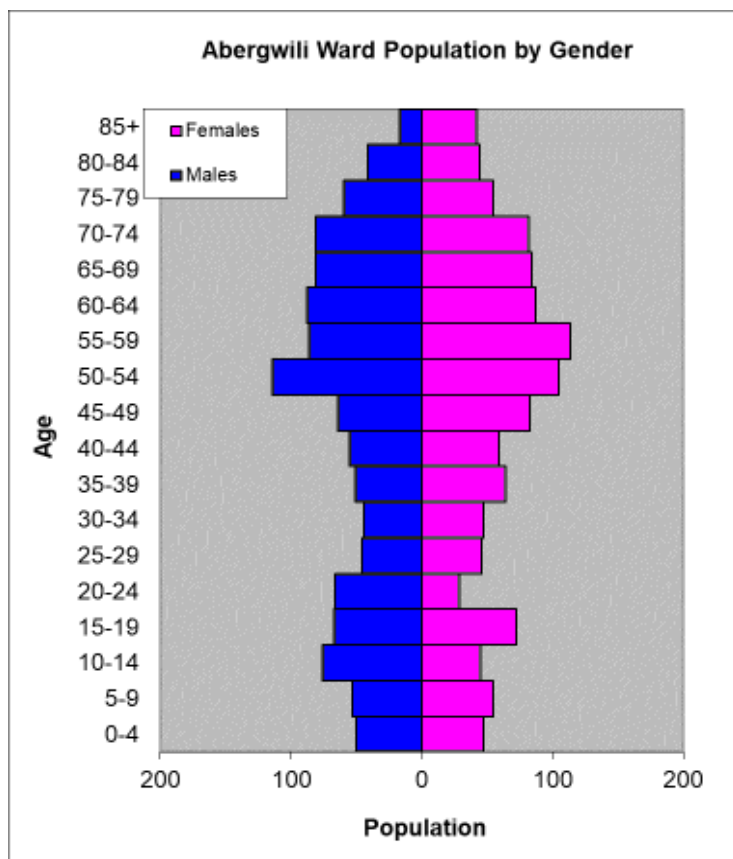
**Location: Approximately 4.0 km from Carmarthen Town**

- ⇒ 14<sup>th</sup> lowest ward population in Carmarthenshire, and 13<sup>th</sup> lowest population density.
- ⇒ Relatively high proportion of people aged over 45 compared to the Carmarthenshire Average, and a lower proportion of 0-4 and 25-44 age groups.
- ⇒ Higher proportion of people with higher level qualifications and able to speak Welsh than the Carmarthenshire average.

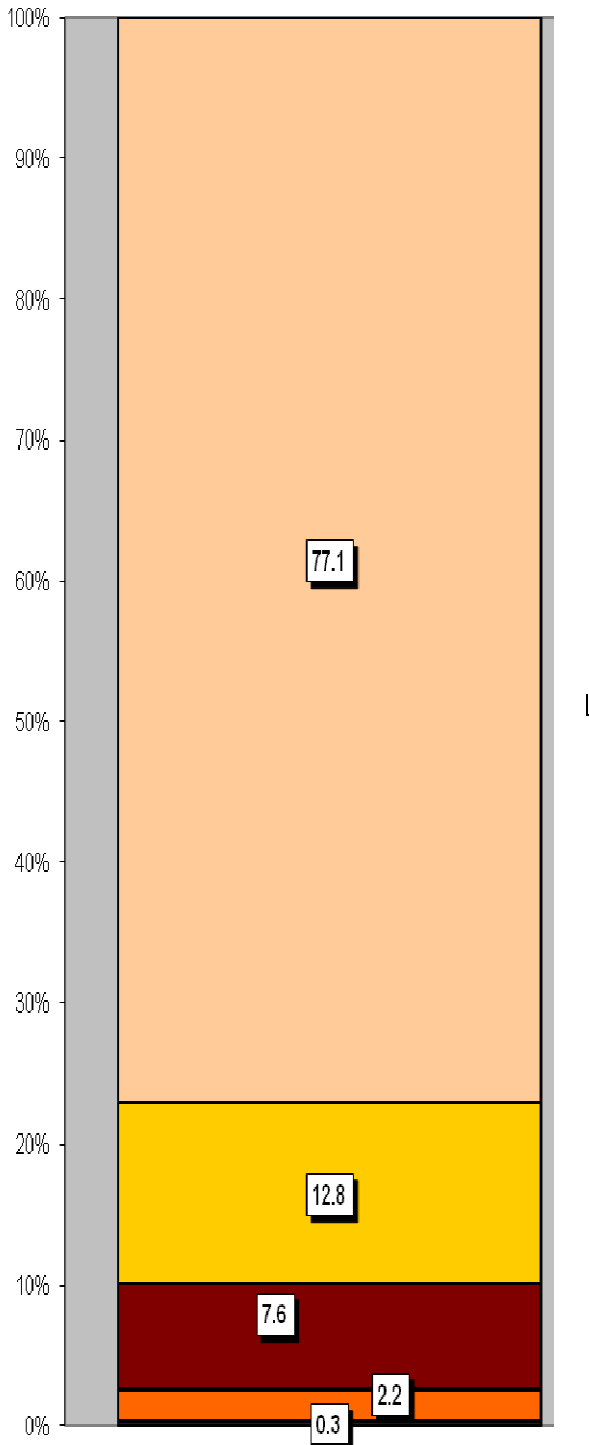

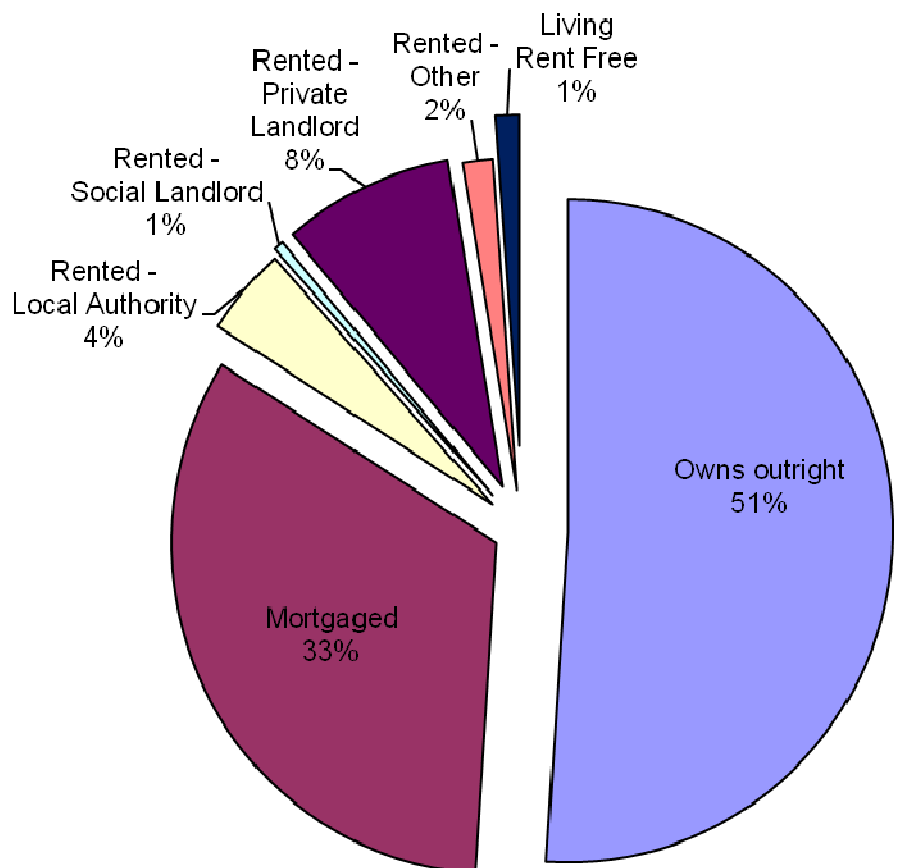
## HOUSING

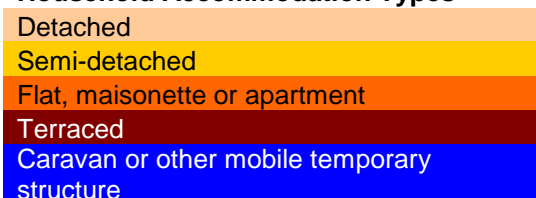

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Abergwili, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £33,901 which is the highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 24.8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a 14.5% higher than the County's average level of managerial and professionals (Levels 1-3) and a lower percentage of people who have never worked or are long term unemployed (Level 8).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Abergwili** ranks 106 out of the 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and ranks 1516 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Abergwili** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 23<sup>rd</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 171 in Wales for this domain.
