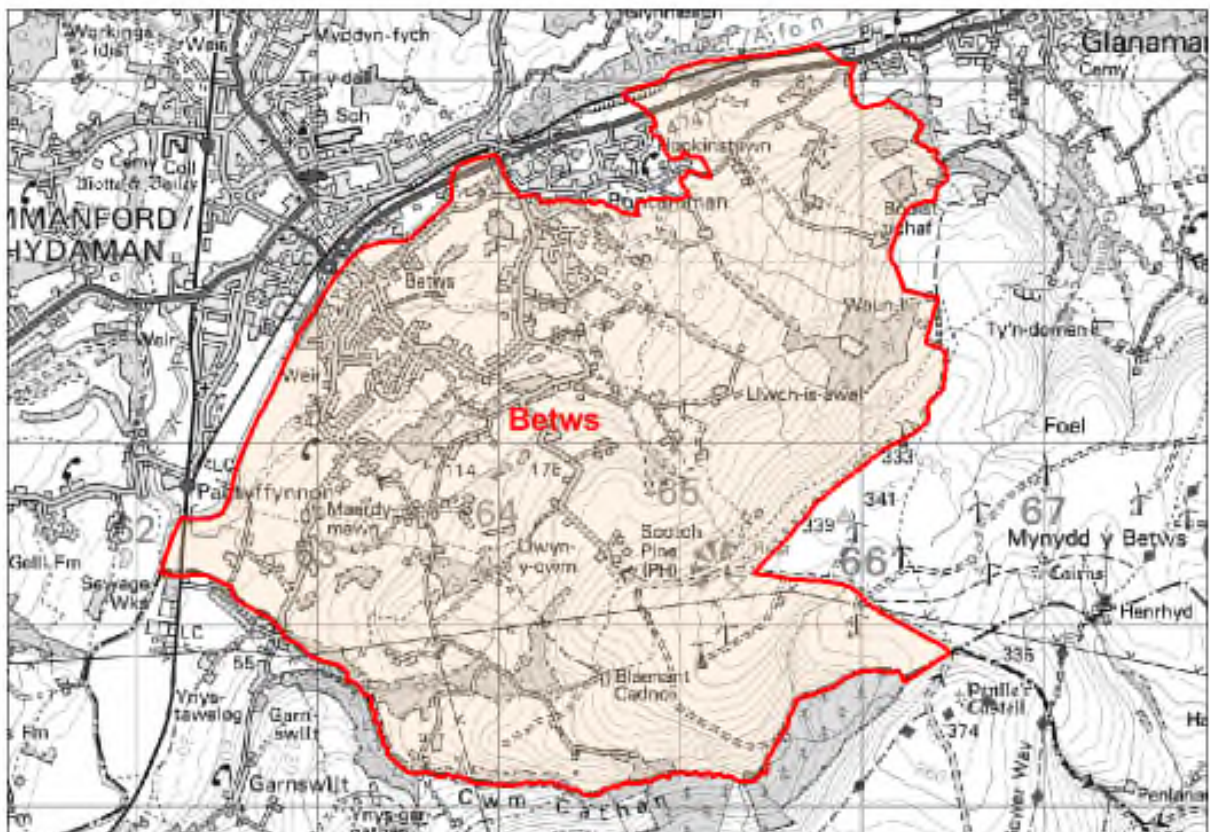

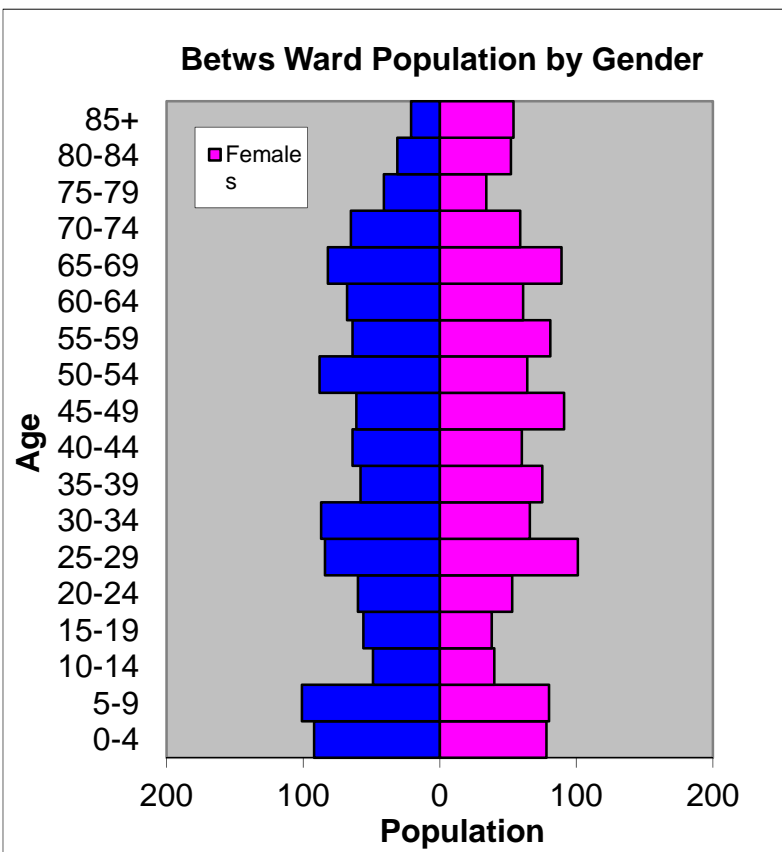
Location: Approximately 34km from Carmarthen Town

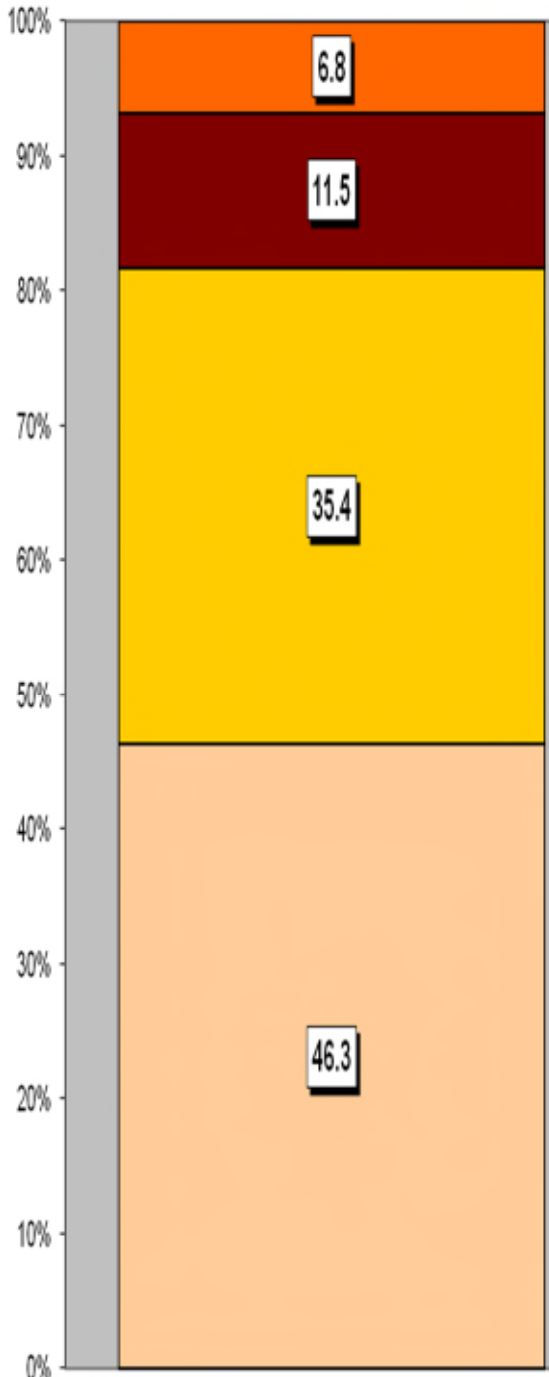

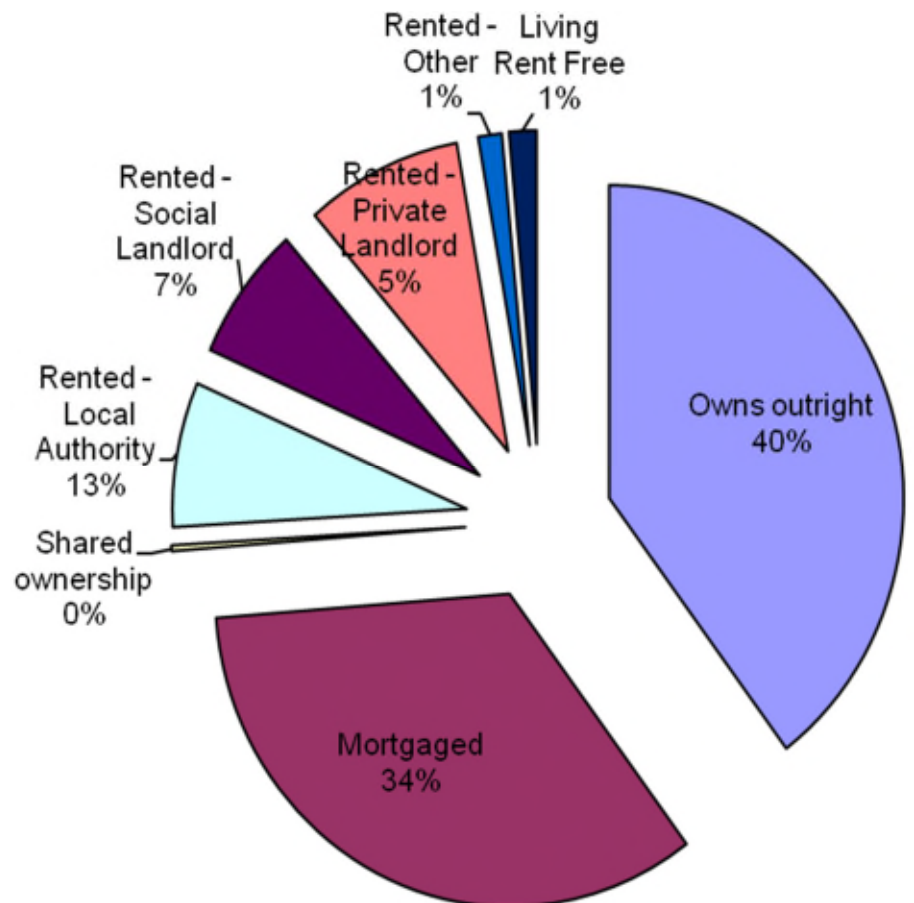
HOUSING

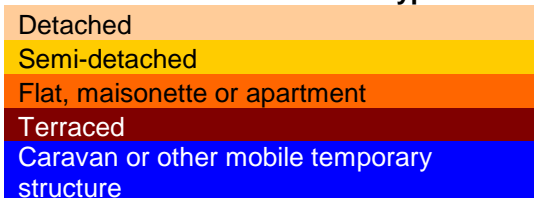

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Betws, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £27,671 which is the 18th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 8.3% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people that have never worked and long term unemployed (Level 8) and a higher than average number in lower managerial and professional administrative occupations (Level 2).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 is based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Betws** ranks 49 out of the 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and ranks 849 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Betws** is the Access to services domain, being ranked 37th in Carmarthenshire and 305th in Wales for this domain.
