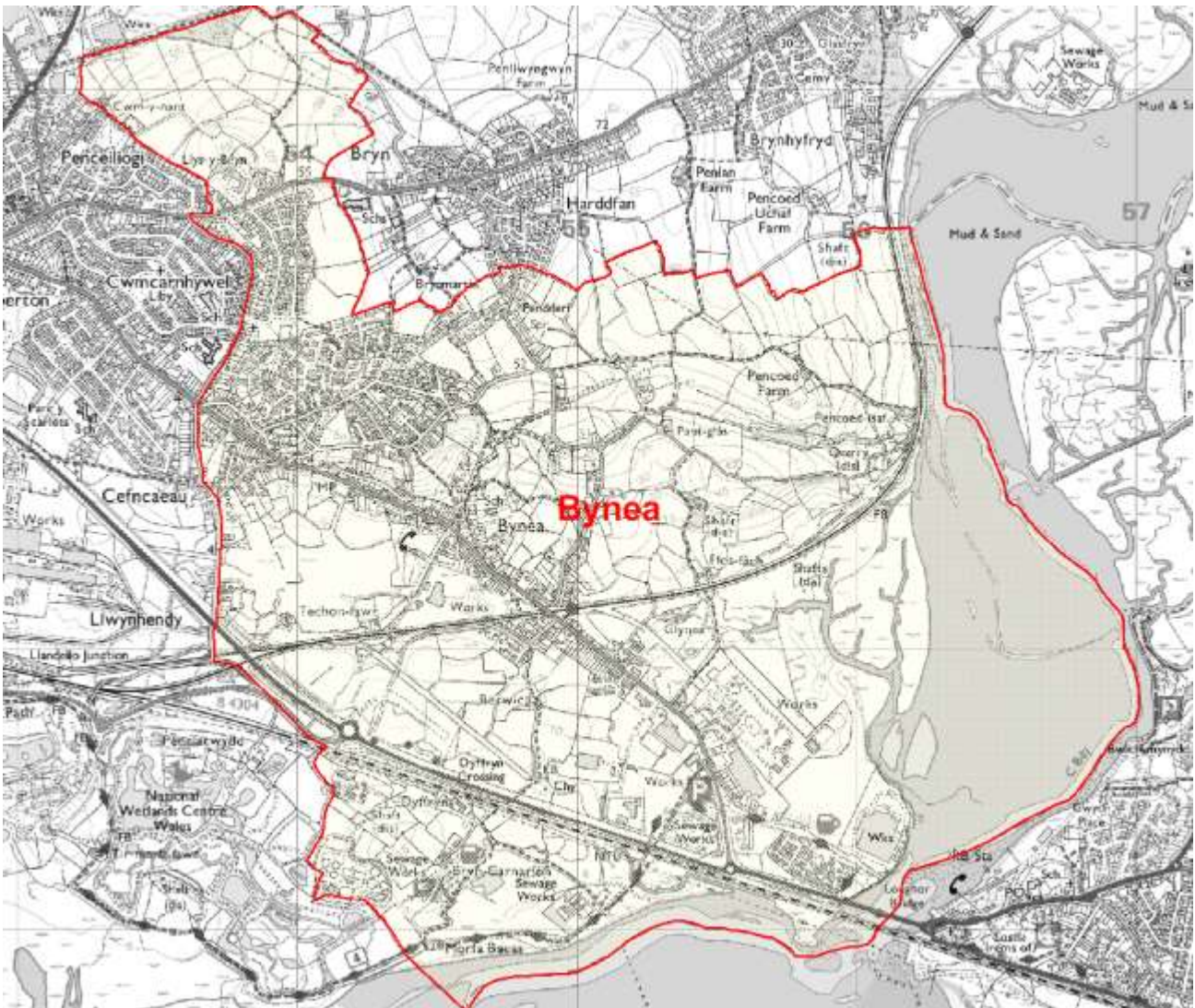

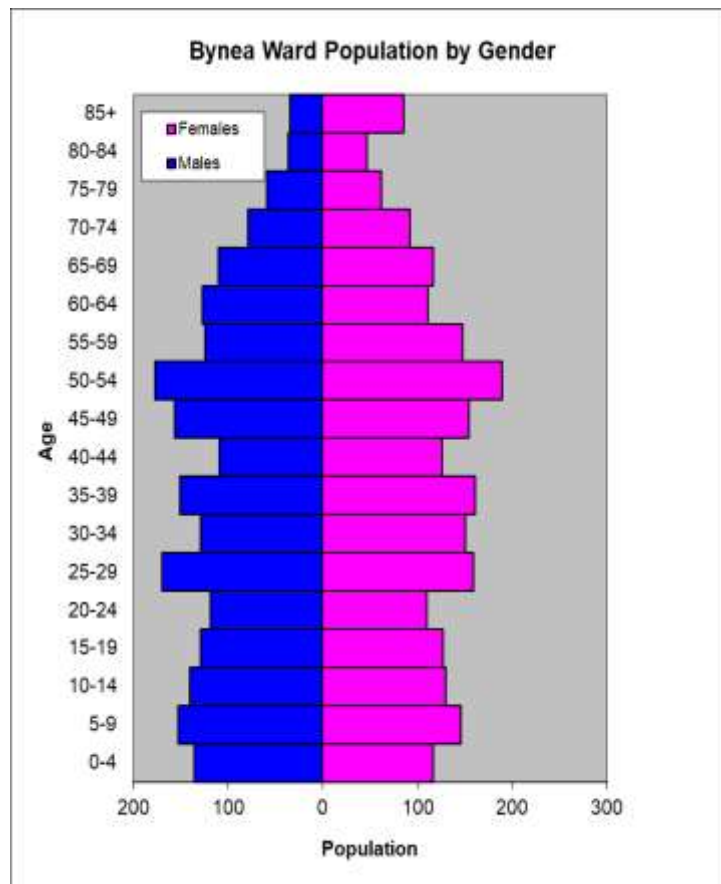

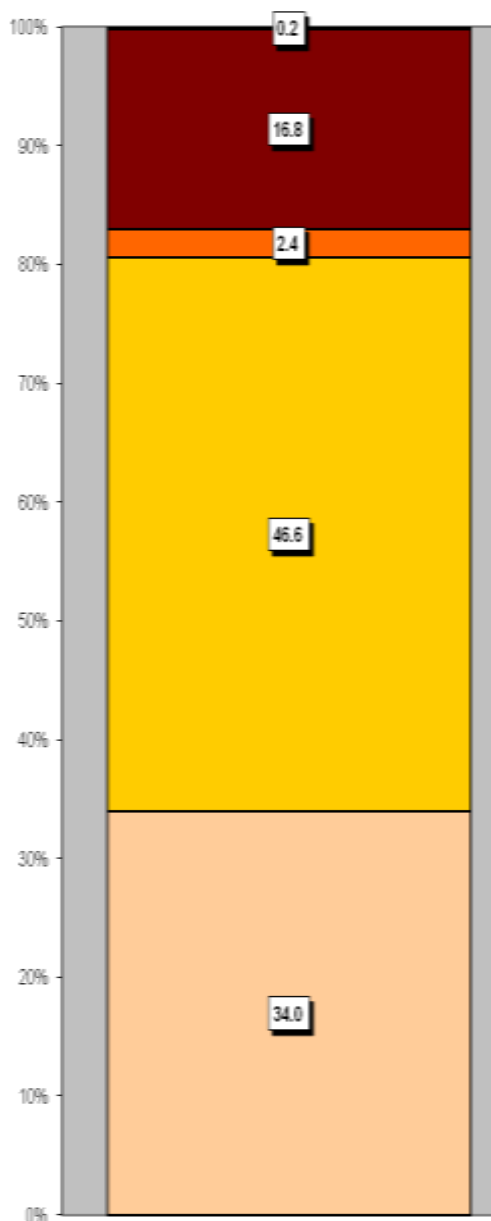

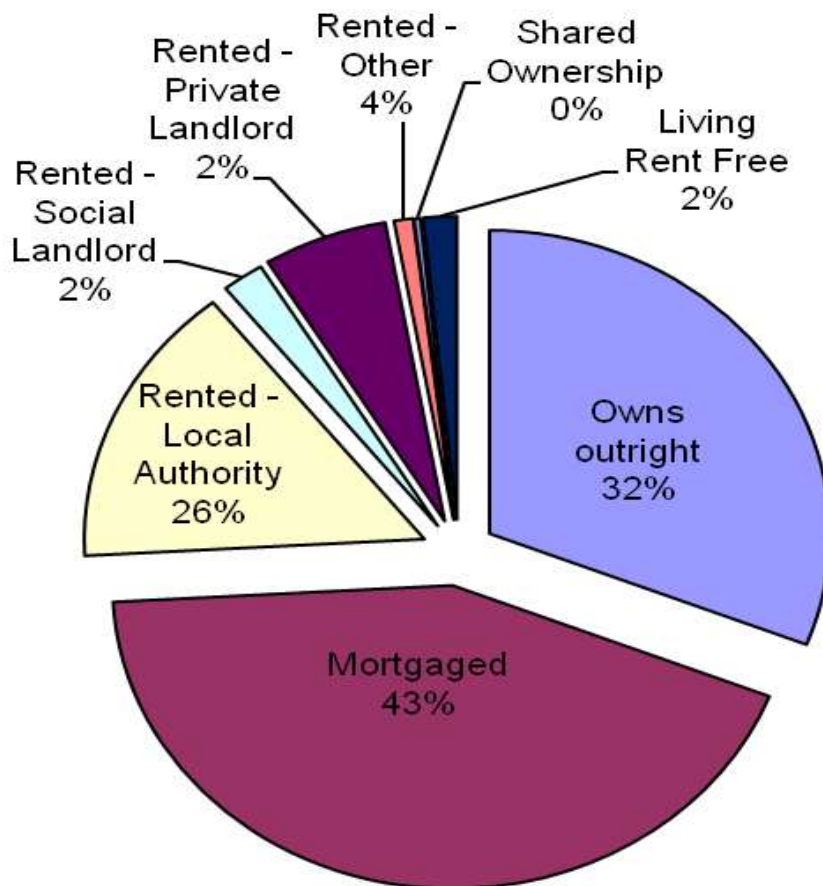
HOUSING

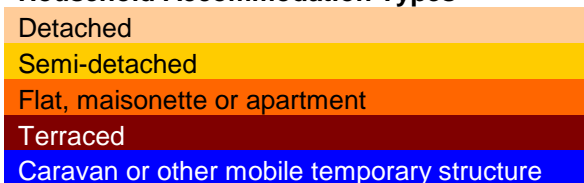

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Bynea, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £27,233 which is the 24th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 6.4% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in higher/lower managerial professional administrative and intermediate occupations (Levels 1-2).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Bynea 1** ranks 71 out of the 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and ranks 1072 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs, whilst **Bynea 2** ranks 34 out of the 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and ranks 673 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs,

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Bynea 1** is the Physical Environment, being ranked 4th in Carmarthenshire and 75th in Wales for this domain. In **Bynea 2** it's the Education domain that is the most prominent ranking 22nd in Carmarthenshire and 539 in Wales.
