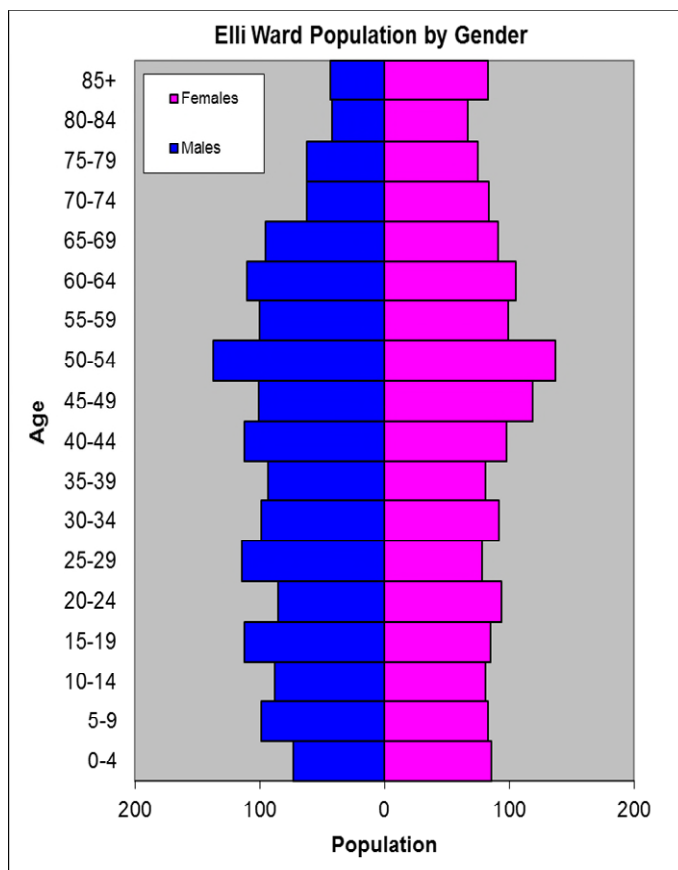

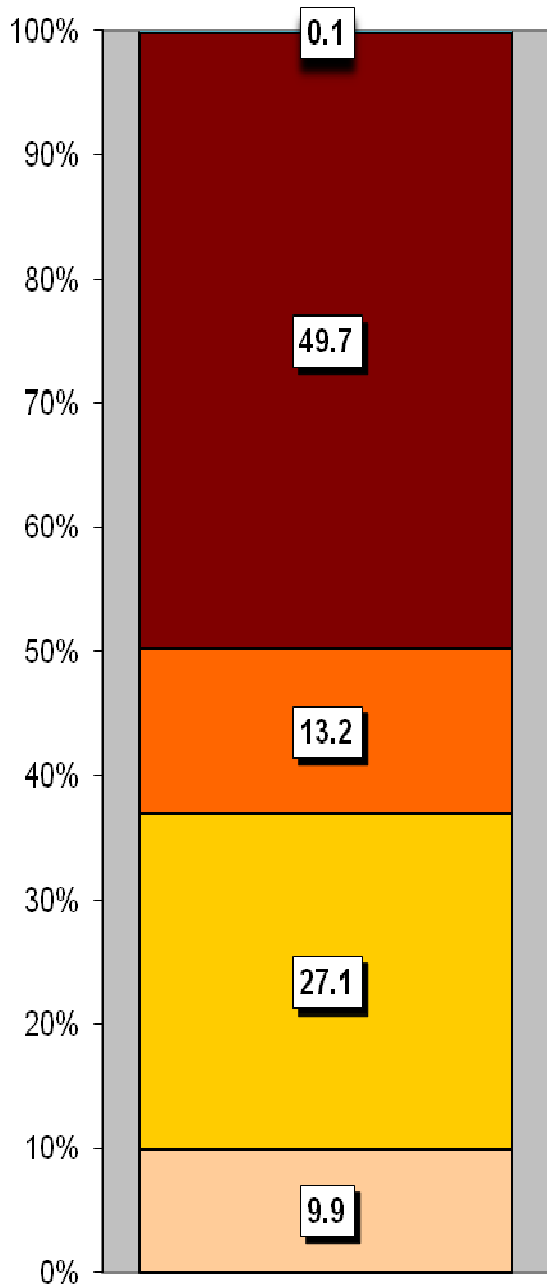

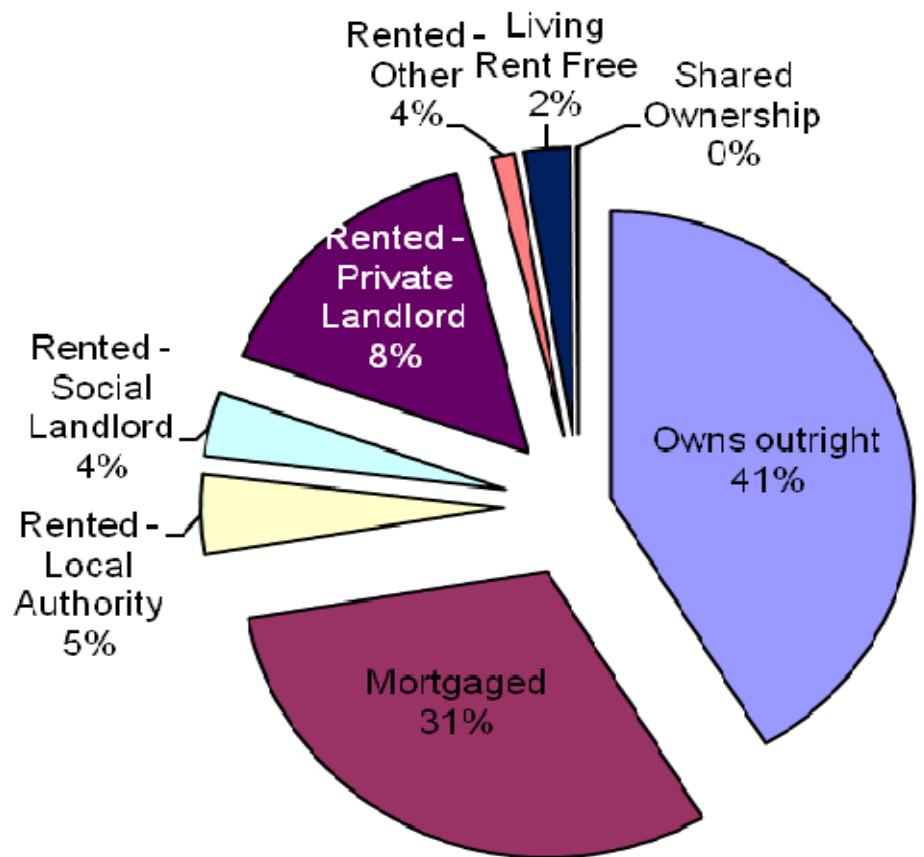
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of terraced houses, which makes up just under half the housing stock. The ward consists of 65 local authority owned properties and 52 Housing Association properties.

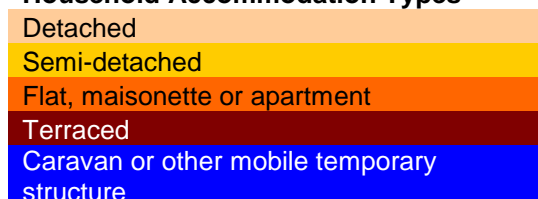

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Elli, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £24,871 which is the 22nd lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 2% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in intermediate occupations (Level 3) and a higher proportion of people who have never worked or are long term unemployed (Level 8).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Elli 1** ranks 79 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1113 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs, whilst **Elli 2** ranks 23 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and 543 from 1909 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Elli 1** is the Physical Environment domain, being ranked 15th in Carmarthenshire and 283rd in Wales for this domain. In **Elli 2** the Community Safety and Physical Environment domains are the most prominent ranking 3rd in Carmarthenshire and 21st and 72nd respectively in Wales.
