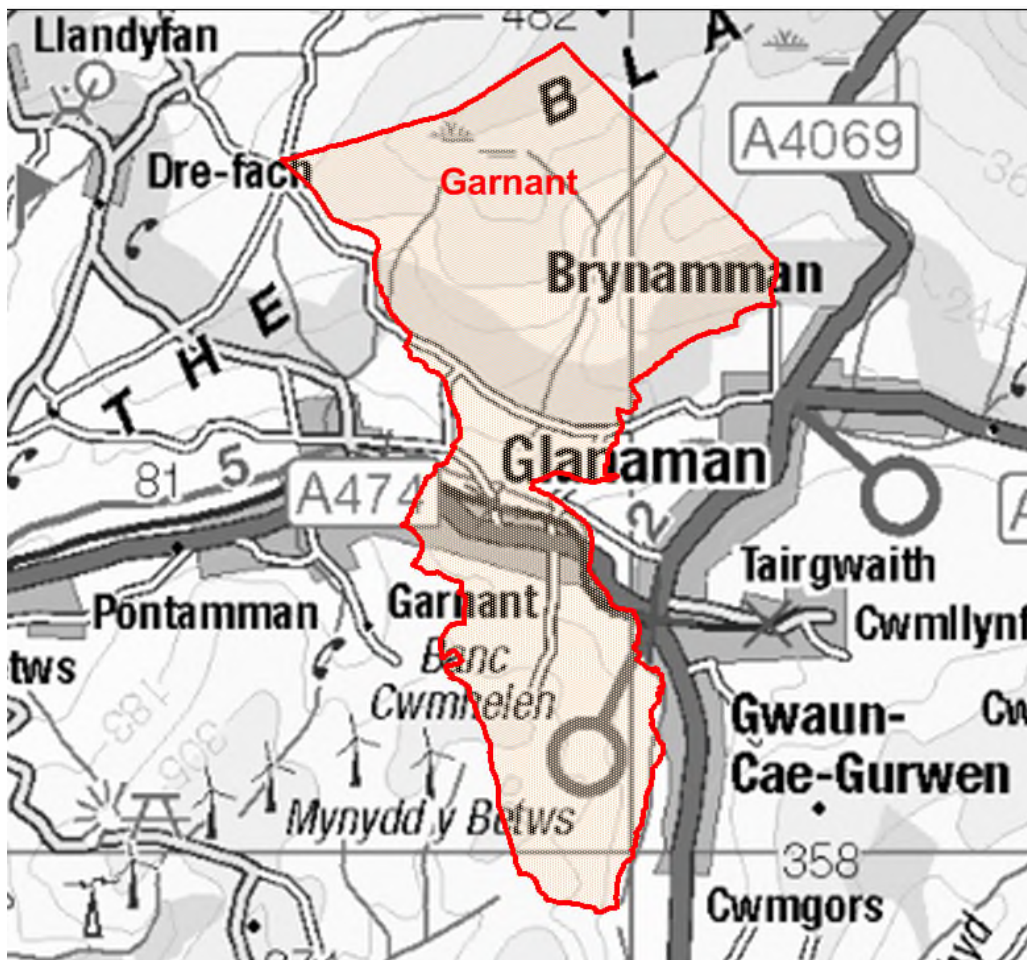

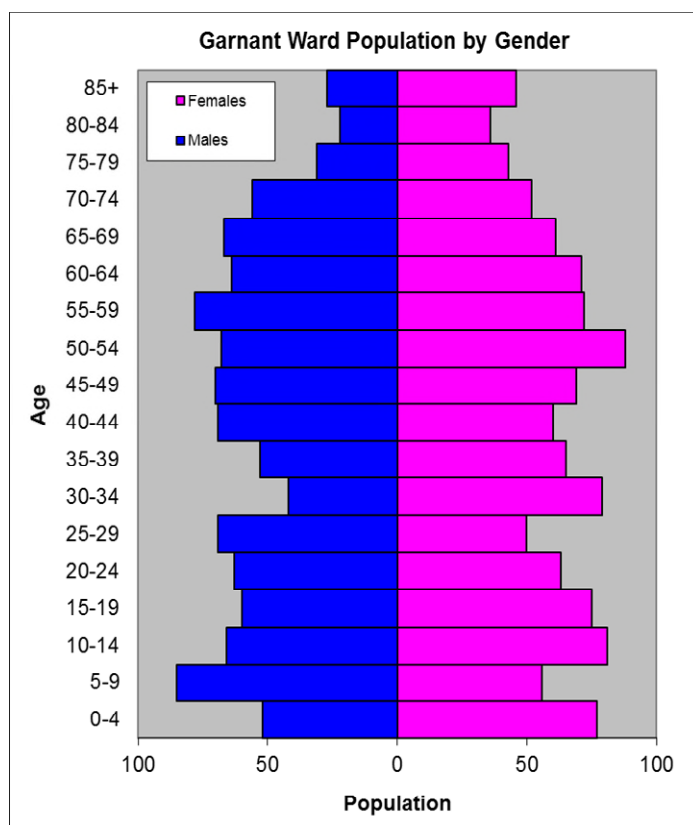
Location: Approximately 39km from Carmarthen Town

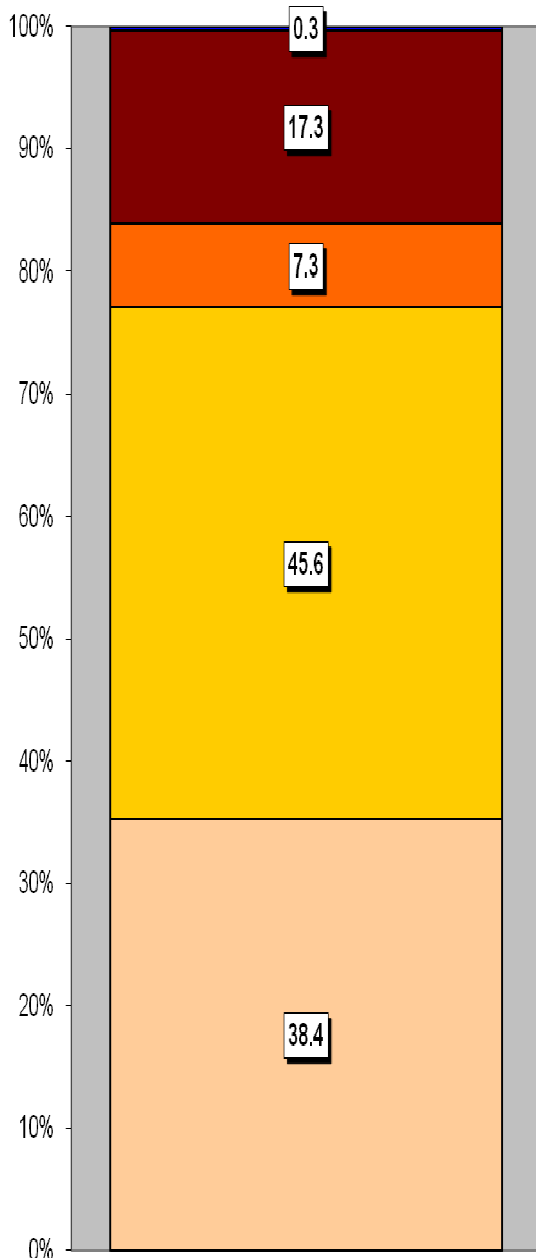

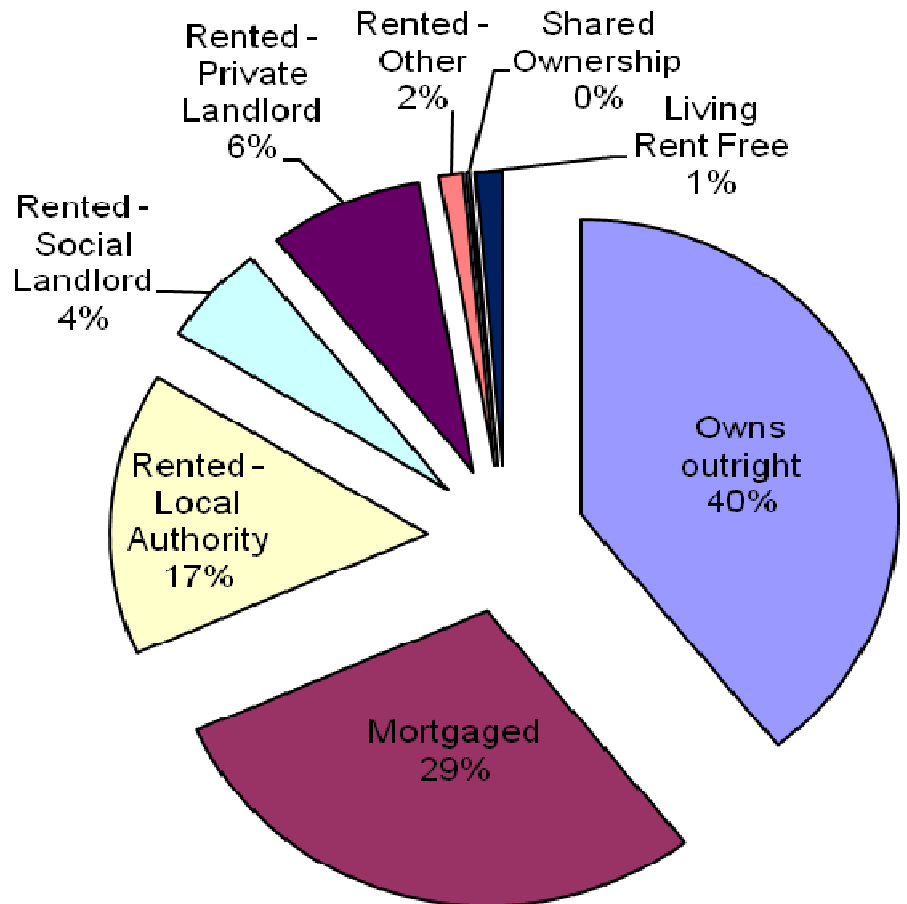
HOUSING

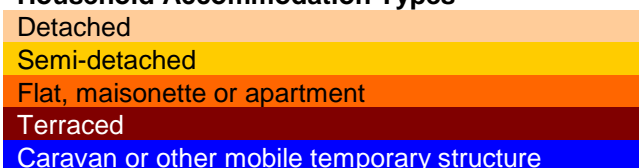

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Garnant, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £23,846 which is the 16th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 6.4% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates lower than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi-routine/routine occupations (Levels 5-7). The number of people that have never worked or been long term unemployed (Level 8) is slightly higher than the Carmarthenshire average.

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Garnant** ranks 32 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 666 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Garnant** is the Employment domain, being ranked 25th in Carmarthenshire and 519 in Wales for this domain.
