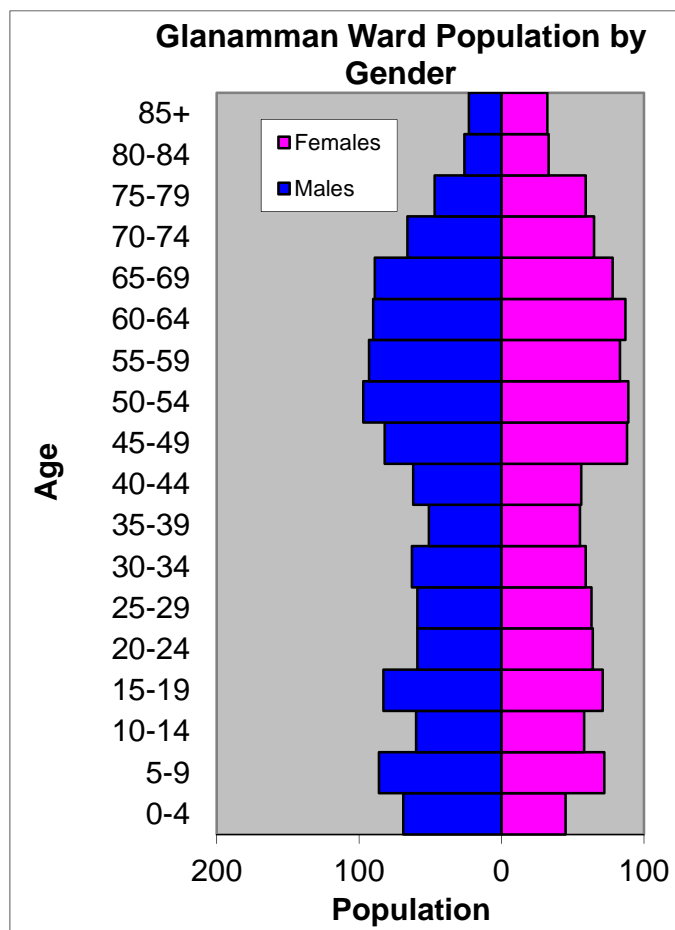

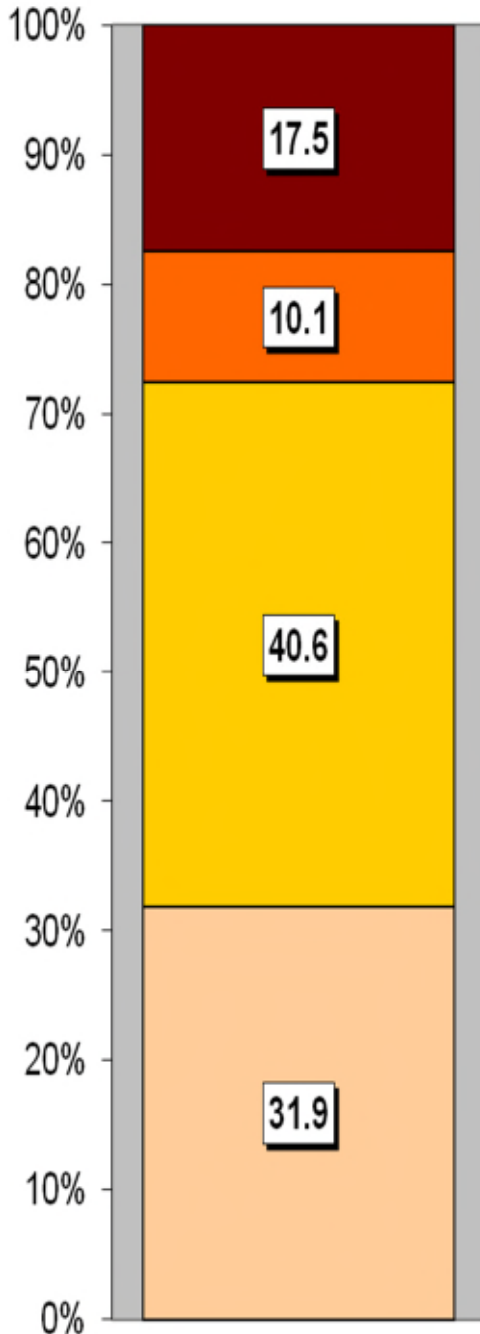

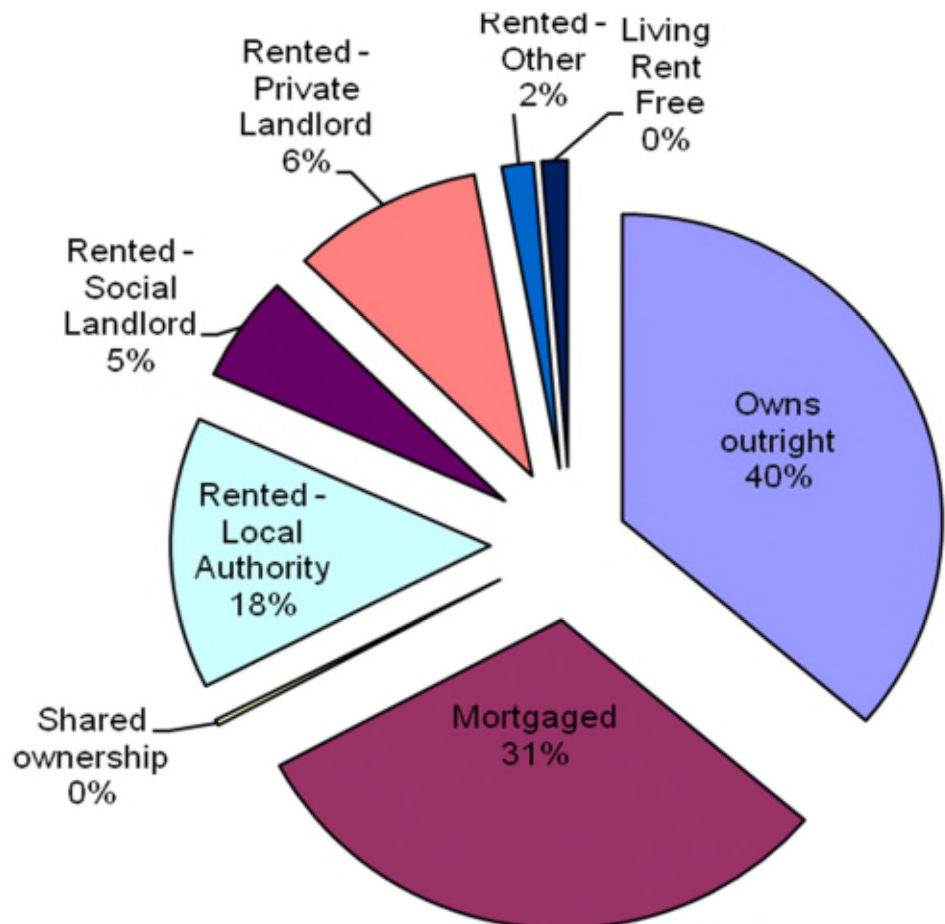
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of semi-detached houses. There is a larger proportion of detached properties than terraced. The smallest proportion of housing is attributed to the caravan or other mobile temporary structure category. The ward consists of 150 local authority owned properties and 59 Housing Association properties.

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Glanamman, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £22,881 which is the 12th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 10.9% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in semi-routine/routine occupations (Levels 6-7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived **Glanamman 1** ranks 18 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 478 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Glanamman 2** ranks 22 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 539 from in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Glanamman 1** is the Health domain, being ranked 13th in Carmarthenshire and 345th in Wales for this domain. In **Glanamman 2** the Employment and Physical Environment domains are the most prominent ranking 14th in Carmarthenshire and 341 and 258 in Wales.
