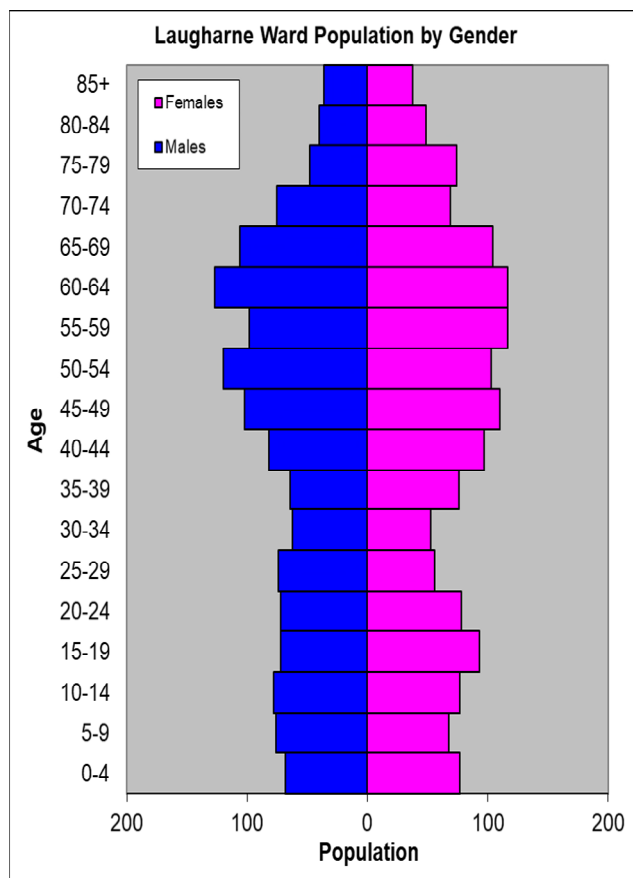

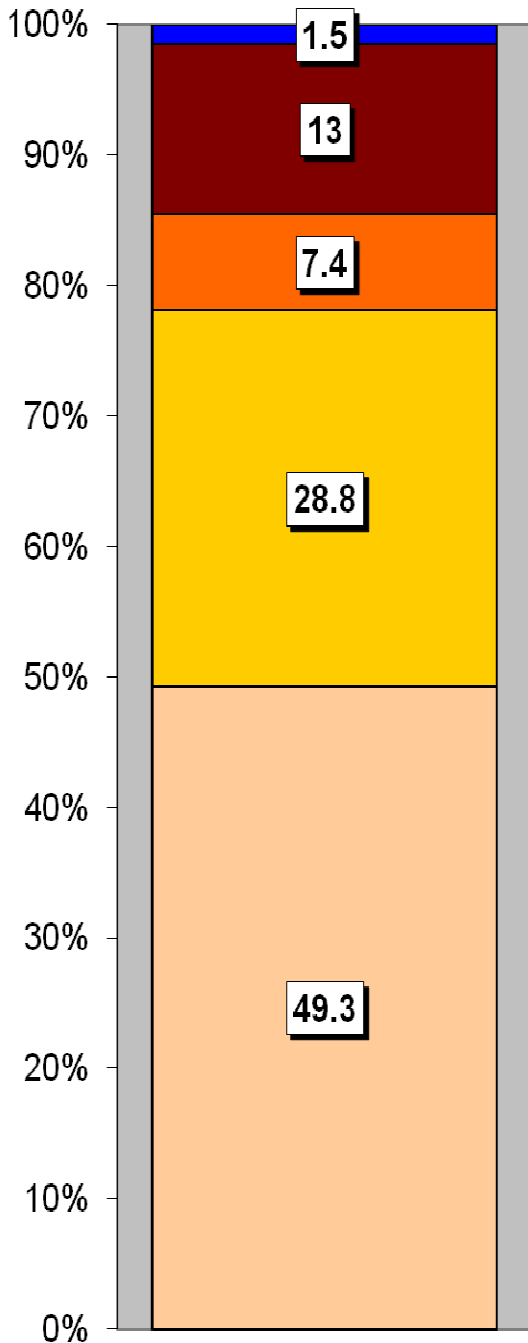

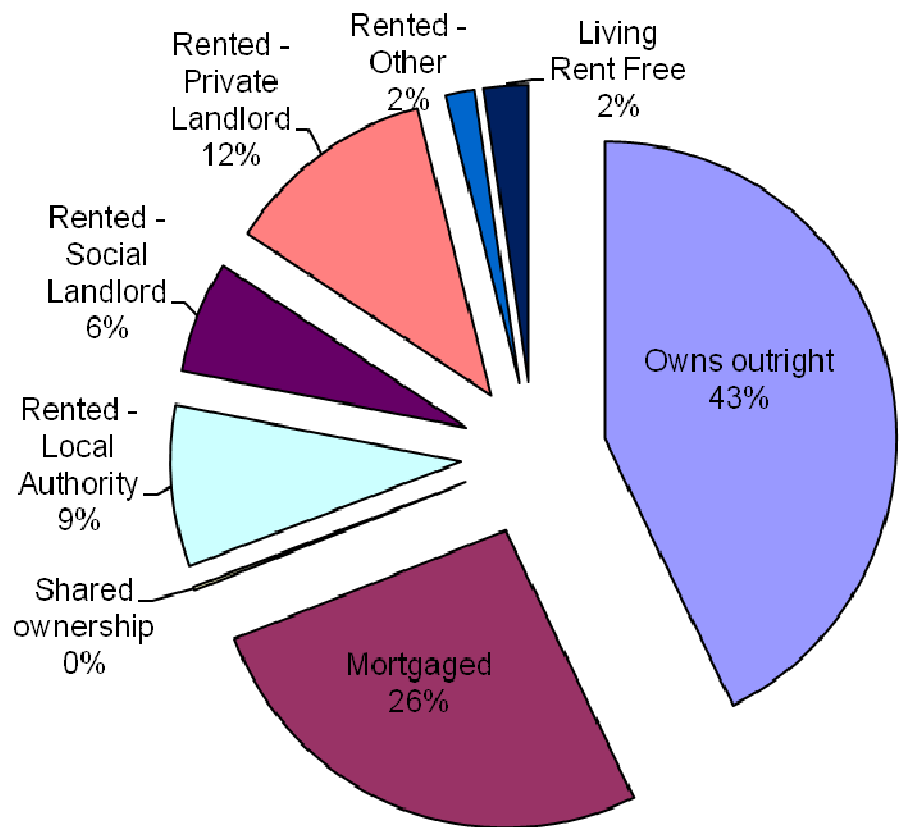
HOUSING

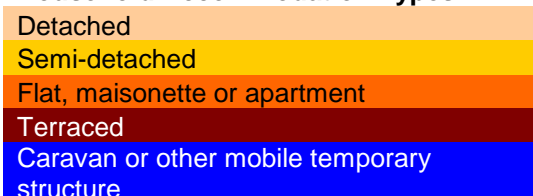

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Laugharne, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £27,634 which is the 19th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 7.8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people who are small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Laugharne 1** ranks 38 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 729 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

Laugharne 2 ranks 81 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1096 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Laugharne 1** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 8th in Carmarthenshire and 40th in Wales for this domain. In **Laugharne 2** the Access to Services domain is also the most prominent, ranking 31st in Carmarthenshire and 257th in Wales.
