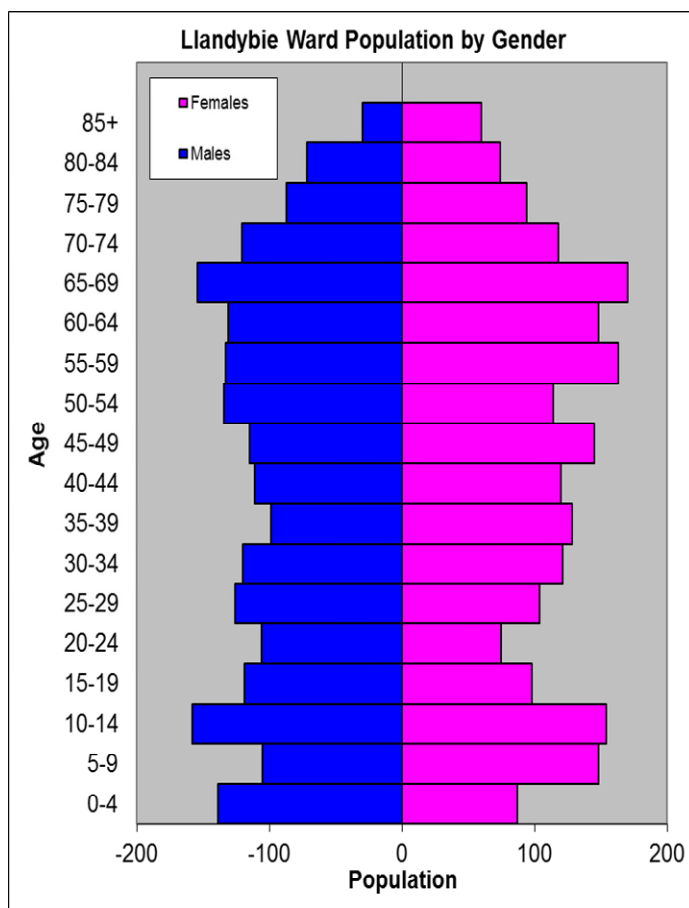

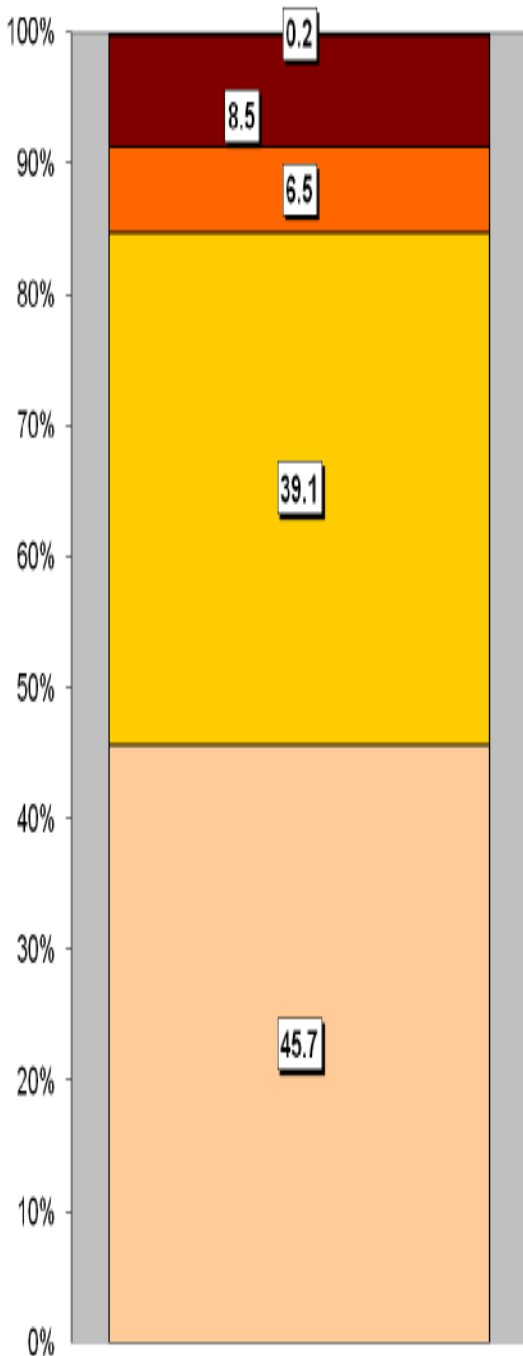

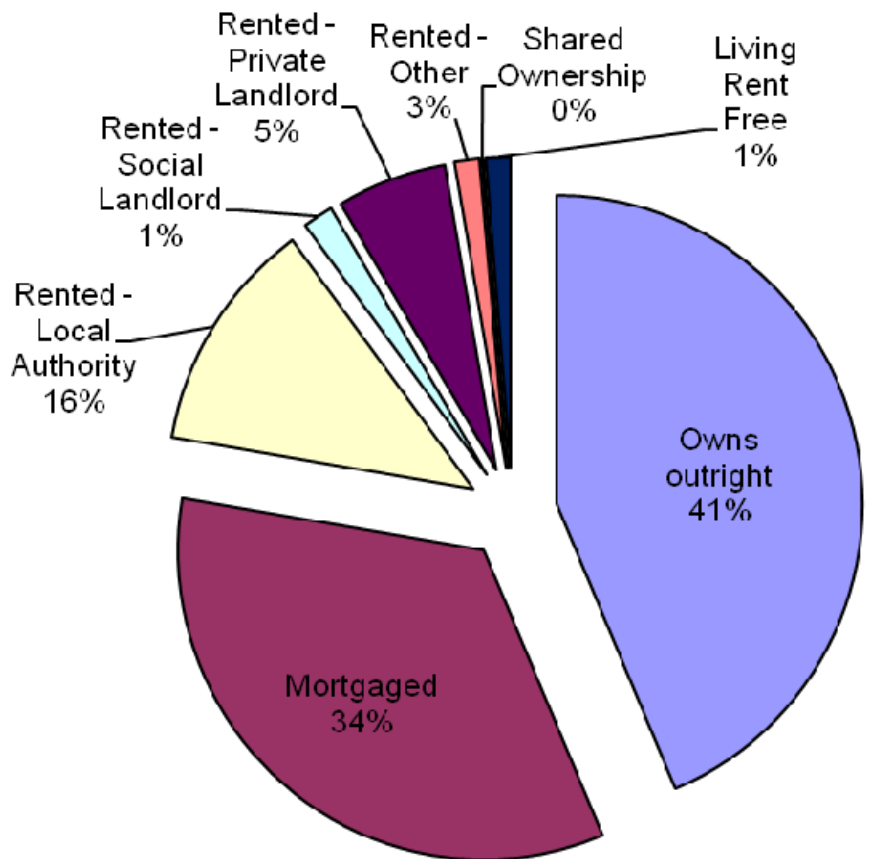
## HOUSING

The area's housing consists mainly of two types, semi-detached and detached. The ward consists of 208 local authority owned properties and 28 Housing Association properties.

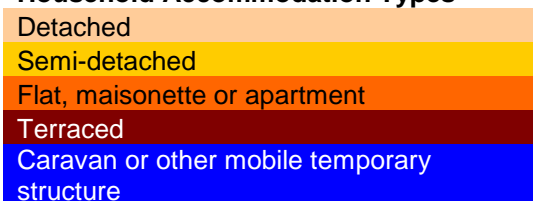

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llandybie, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £27,578 which is the 19<sup>th</sup> highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a marginally higher than average level of people in higher/lower managerial and professional administrative occupation (Levels 1-2).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llandybie 1** ranks 104 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1440 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Llandybie 2** ranks as the 30<sup>th</sup> most deprived area in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 6467 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llandybie 1** is the Physical Environment domain, being ranked 20<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 361 in Wales for this domain. In **Llandybie 2** Employment is the most prominent domain ranking 23<sup>rd</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 504 in Wales.
