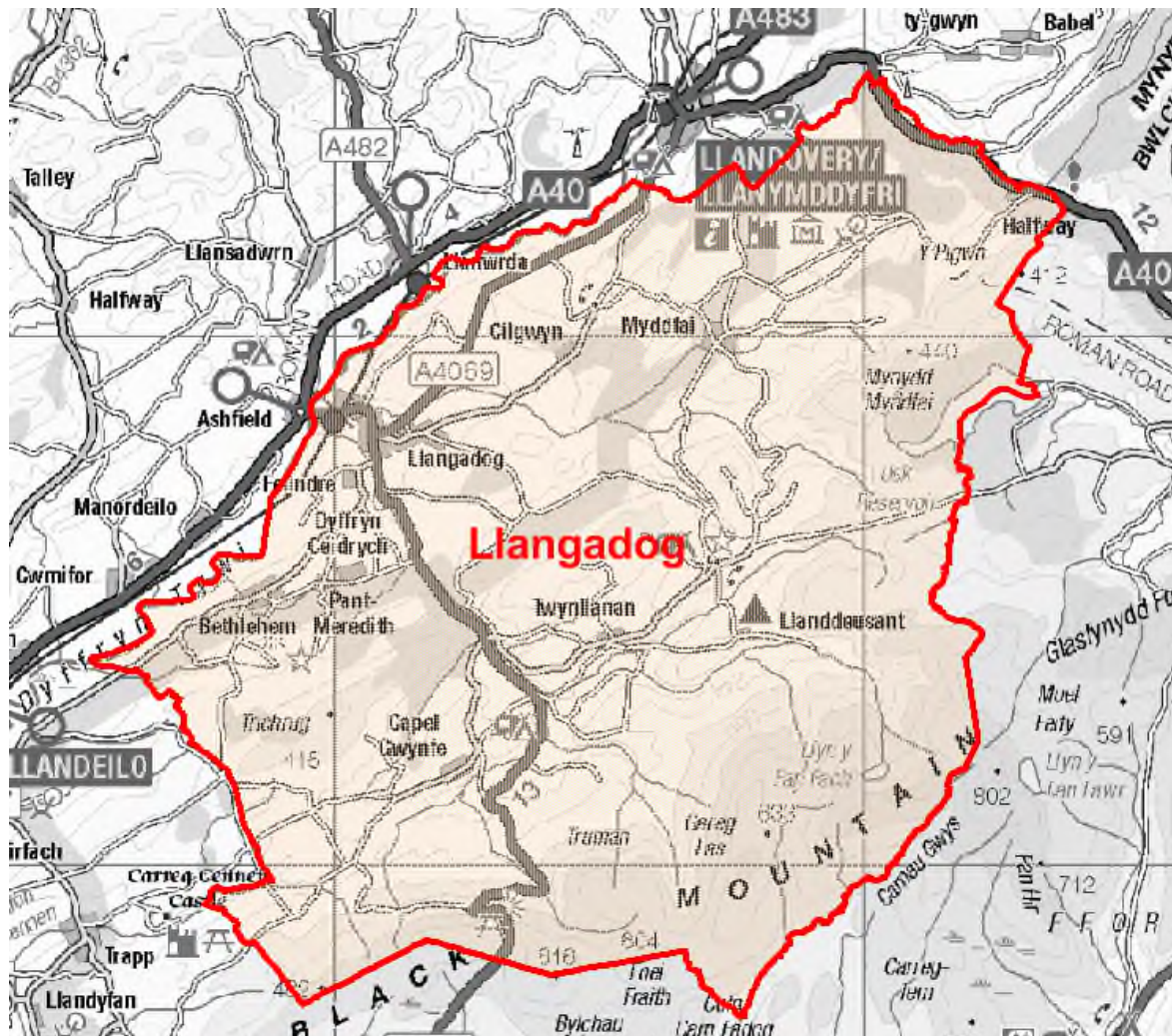

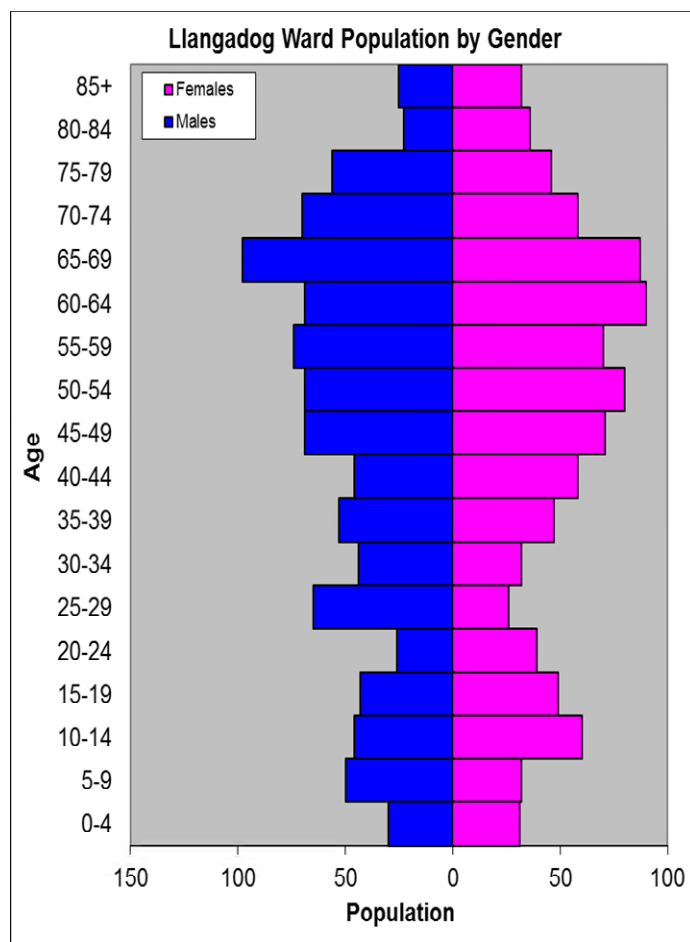
Location: Approximately 34km from Carmarthen Town

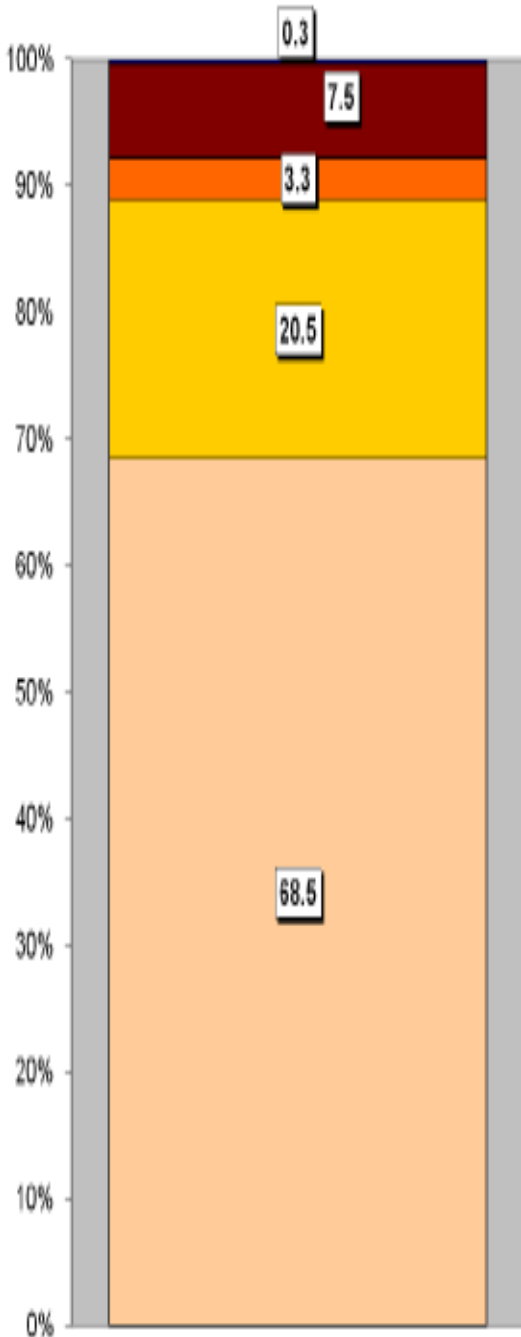

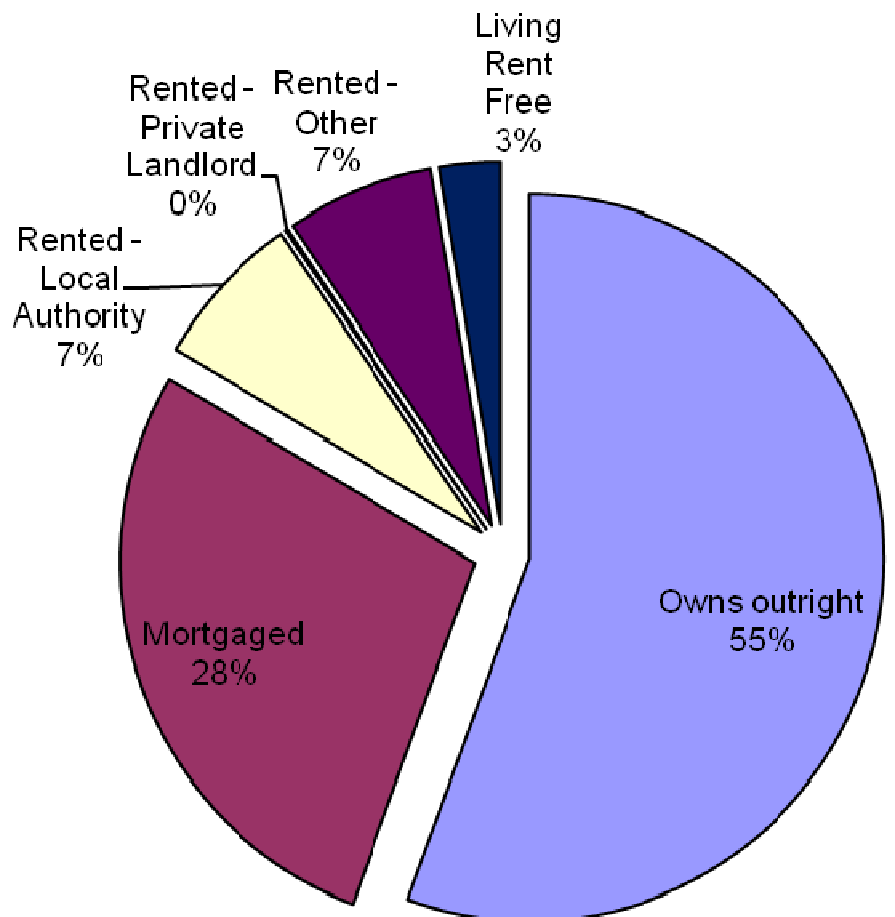
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of detached houses and a higher proportion of semi-detached housing in comparison to the number of terraced houses, flat, maisonette or apartment and caravan or other mobile temporary structure combined. The ward consists of 56 local authority owned properties and 1 Housing Association properties.

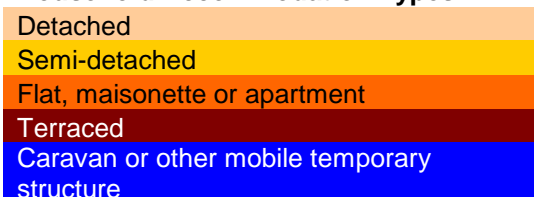

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llangadog, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £28,694 which is the 13th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 11.6% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a lower than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi/routine occupations (Levels 5-7) and a higher than average proportion of small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llangadog** ranks 60 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 960 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llangadog** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 7th in Carmarthenshire and 30th in Wales for this domain.
