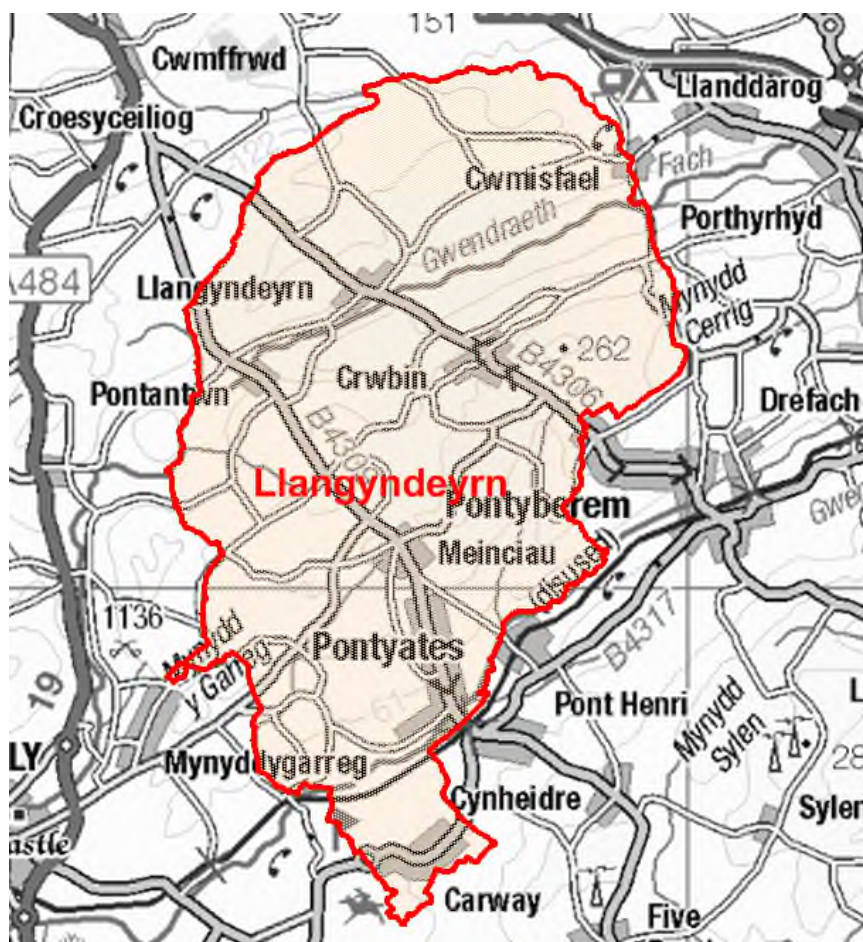

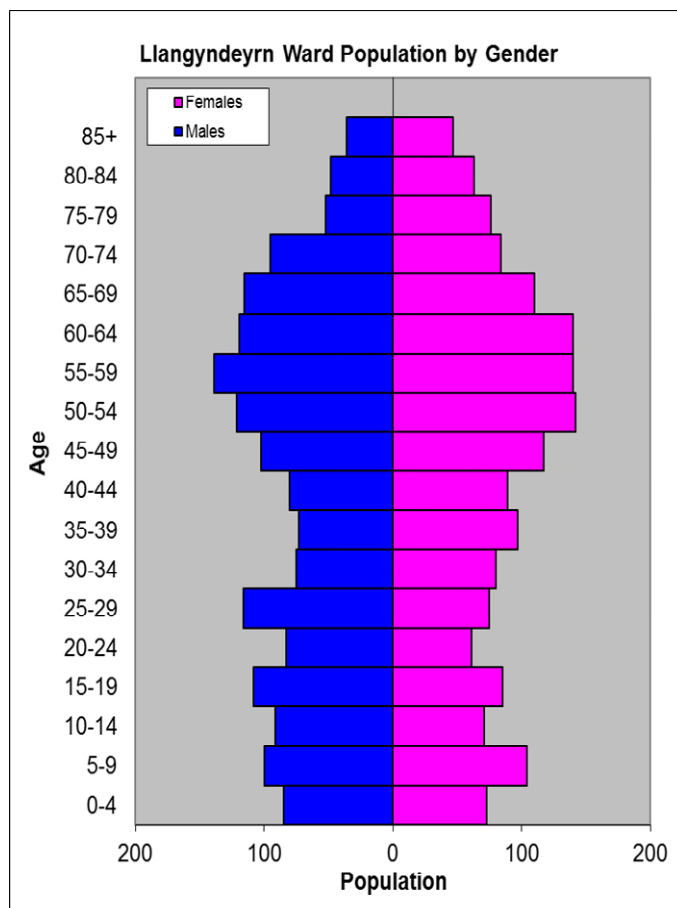

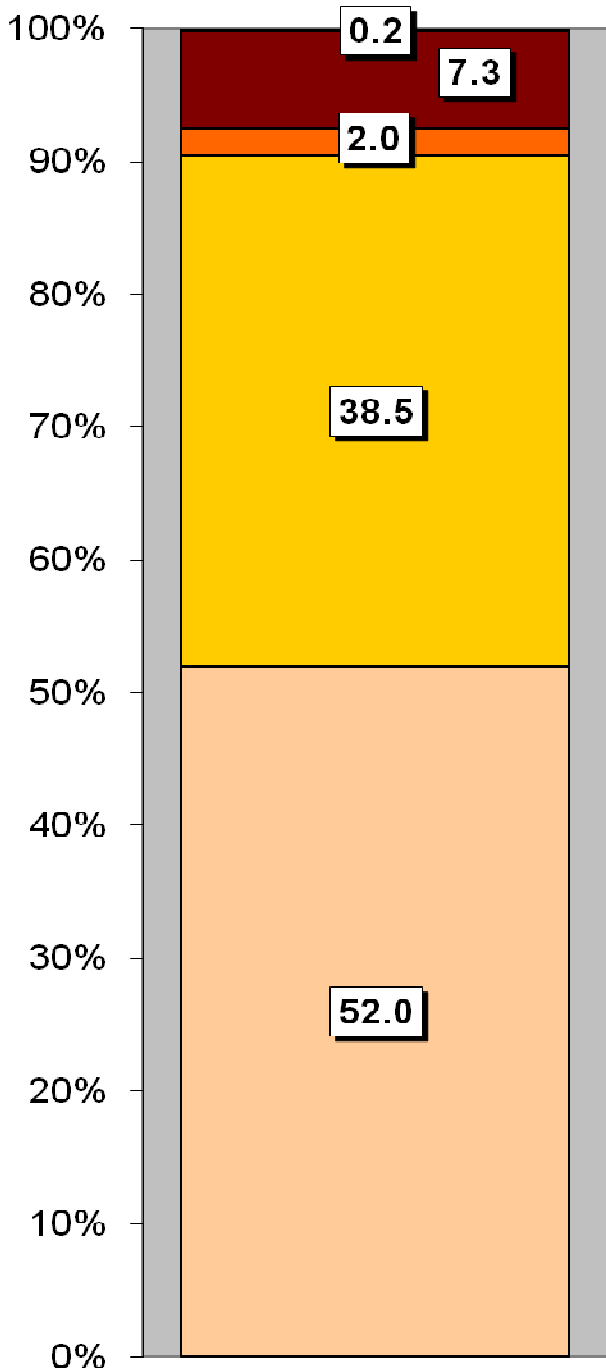

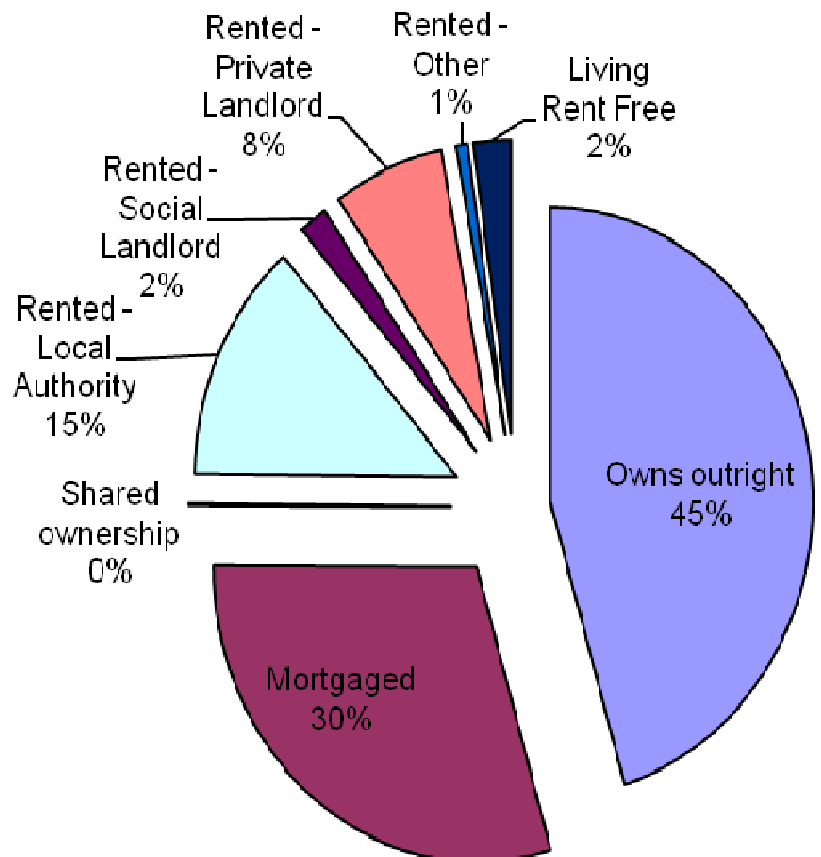
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of detached and semi-detached houses, which combined makes up just over 90% of the houses in Llangyndeyrn. There is a higher proportion of terraced houses compared to flat, maisonette and apartments. The ward consists of 179 local authority owned properties and 23 Housing Association properties.

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llangydeyrn, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £25,420 which is the 26th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 0.2% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a slightly higher than average level of people in lower managerial and professional administrative occupations (Level 2) as well as a slightly higher than average small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llangydeyrn 1** ranks as the 25th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 560 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Llangydeyrn 2** ranks 52nd in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 883 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llangydeyrn 1** is the Health and Education domains, being ranked 20th in Carmarthenshire and 429 and 480 respectively in Wales for these domains. In **Llangydeyrn 2** the Access to Services domain is the most prominent ranking 29th in Carmarthenshire and 226th in Wales.
