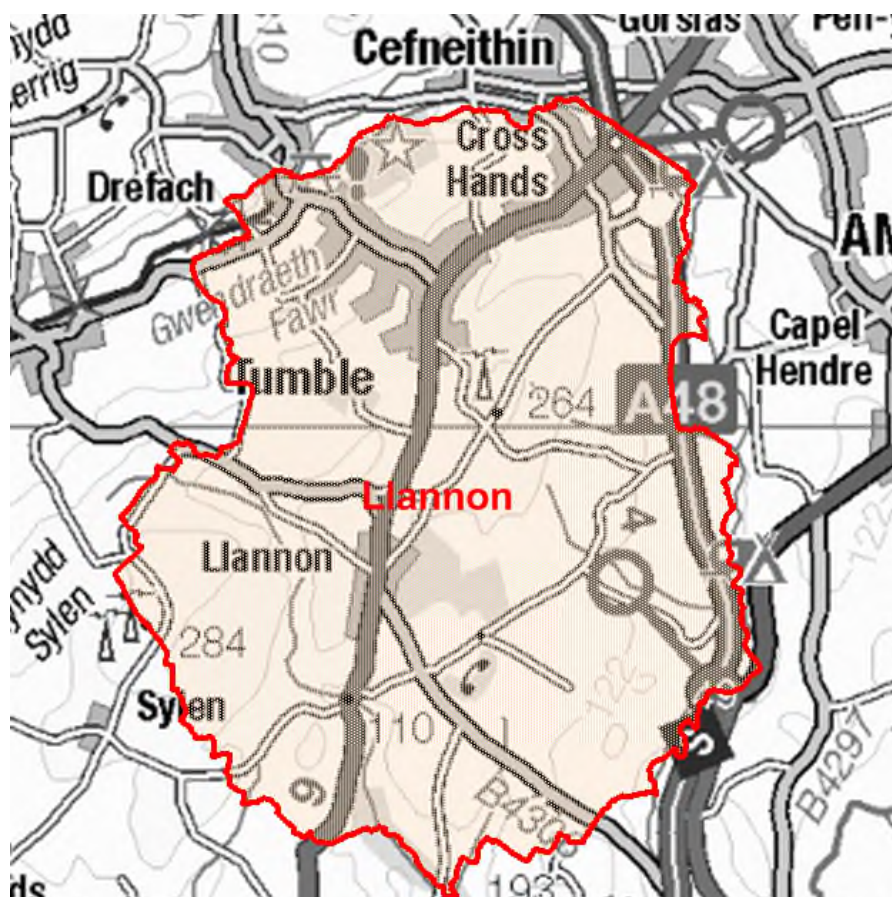

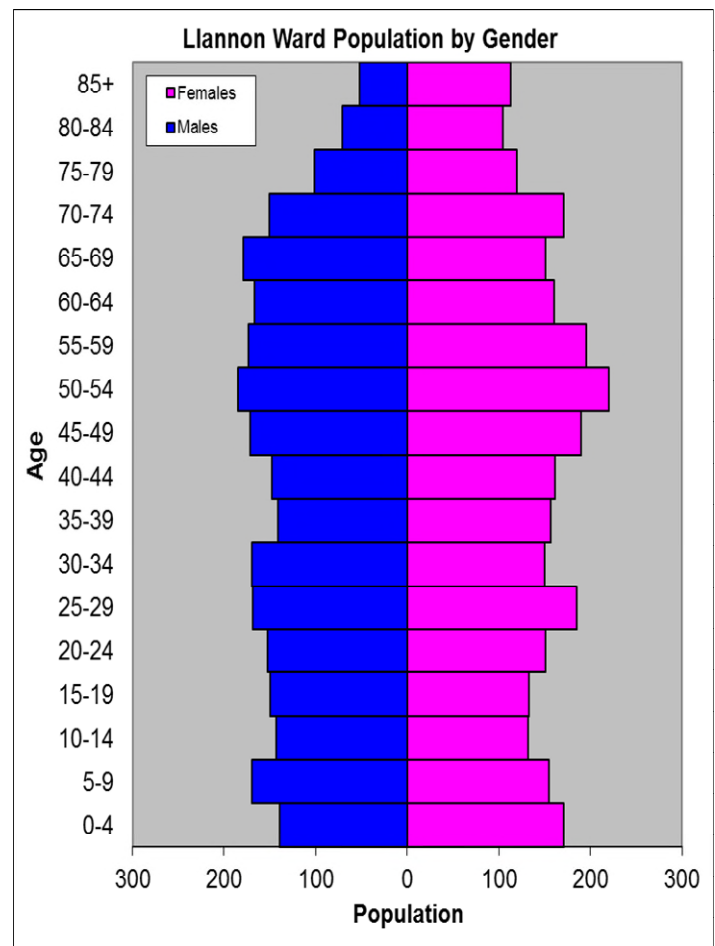

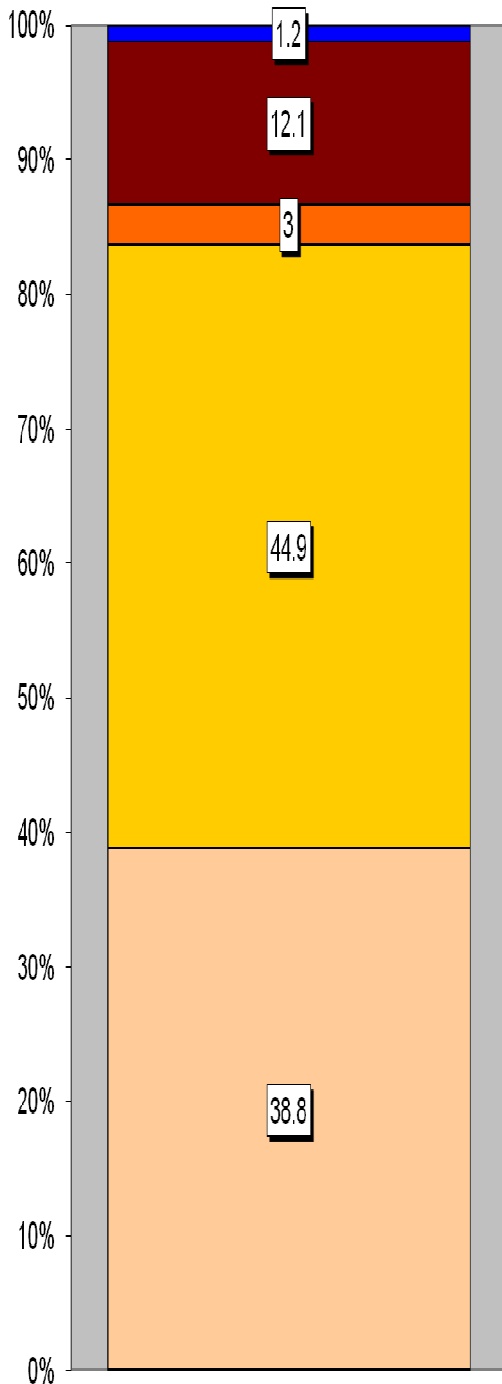

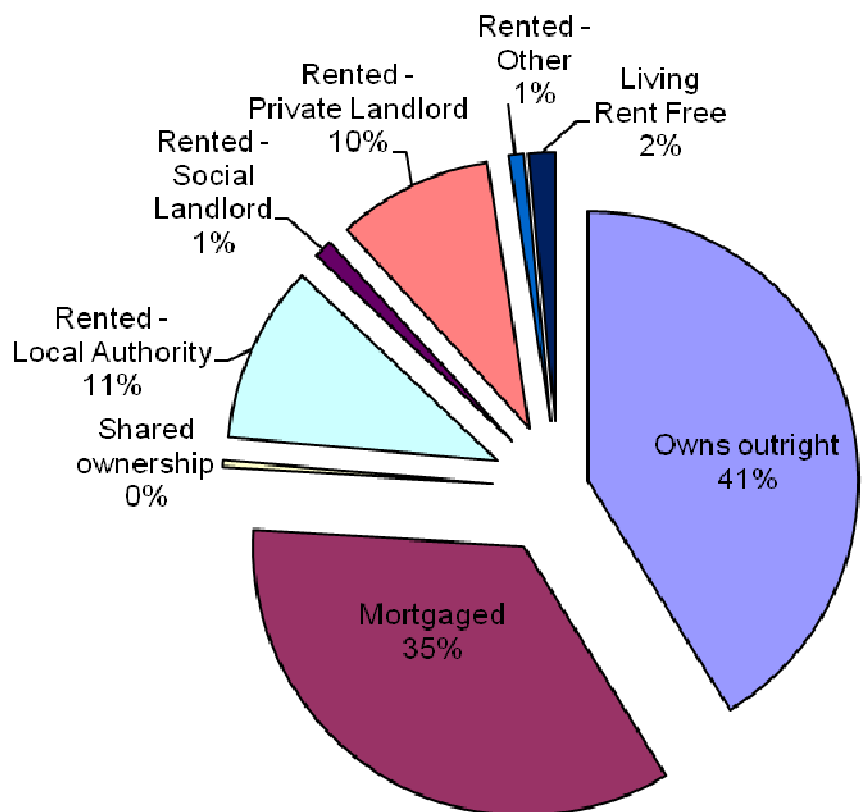
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of semi-detached houses and a higher proportion of detached accommodation in comparison to the number of terraced housing. The smallest proportion of housing type is the caravan or other mobile temporary structure. The ward consists of 232 local authority owned properties and 24 Housing Association properties.

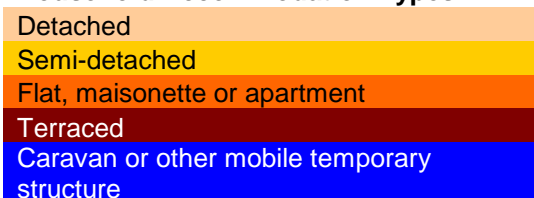

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llannon, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £26,341 which is the 29th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 3.7% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a slightly higher than average number of people lower supervisory and technical occupations (Level 5) and in routine occupations (Level 7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llannon 1** ranks as the 35th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 693 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Llannon 2** ranks 44 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 788 in Wales, whilst **Llannon 3** ranks 95th in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1337 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llannon 1** is the Education domain, being ranked 17th in Carmarthenshire and 432nd in Wales for this domain. In **Llannon 2** the Income domain is the most prominent ranking 35th in Carmarthenshire and 735 in Wales. In **Llannon 3** the Access to Services domain is the most prominent ranking 25th in Carmarthenshire and 184 in Wales.
