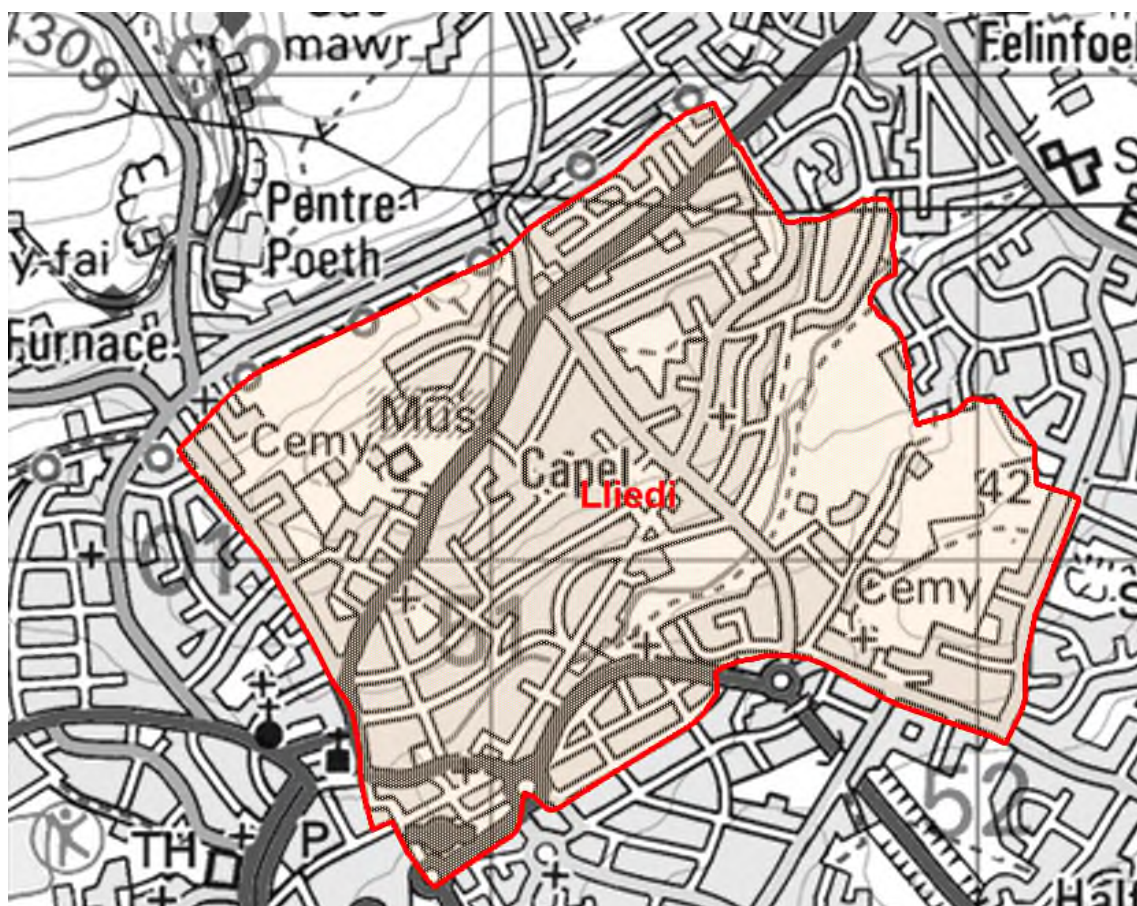

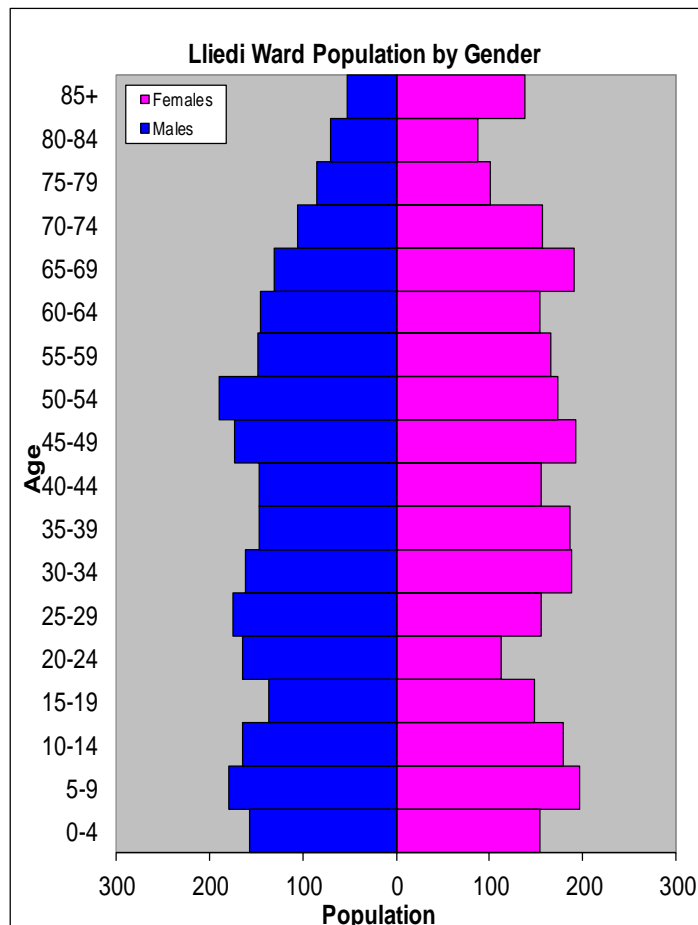

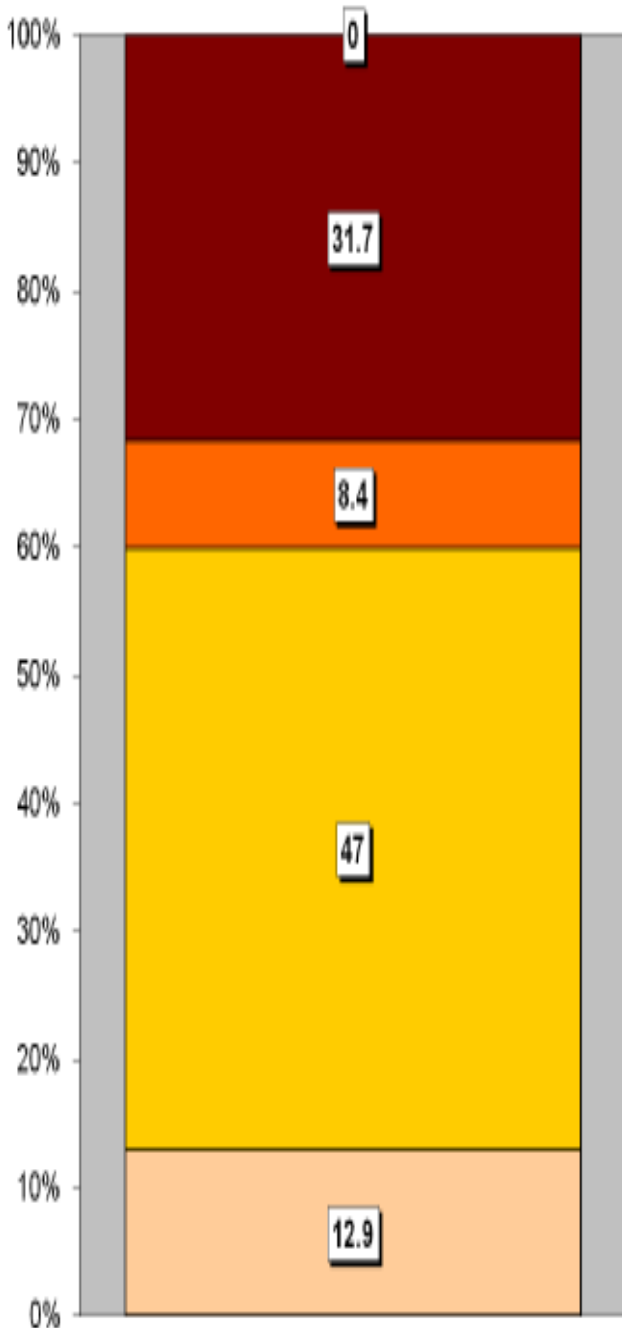

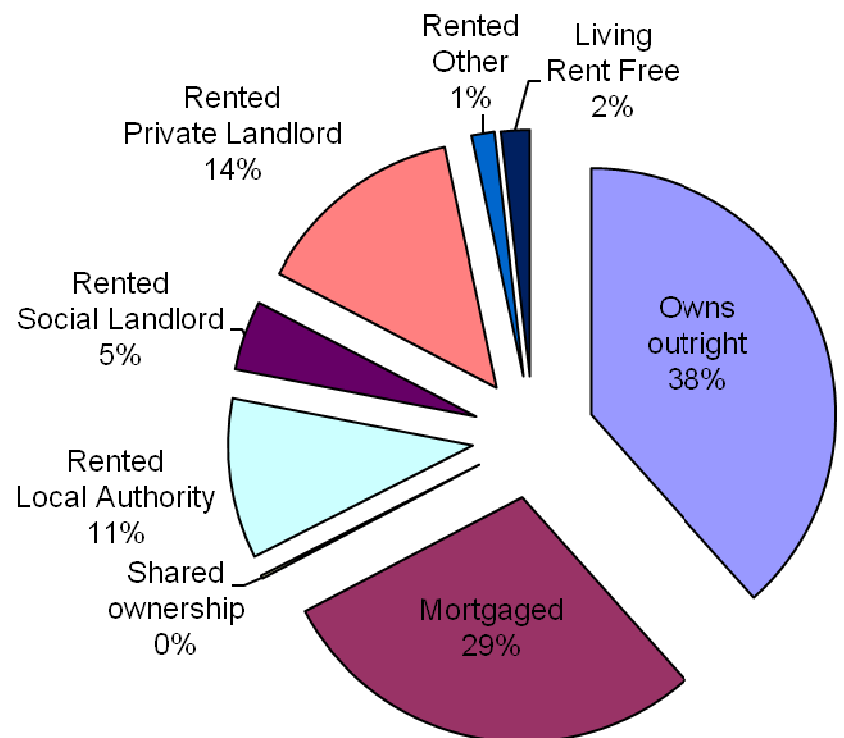
HOUSING

There is a smaller proportion of flat, maisonette and apartment accommodation compared to detached. The ward consists of 252 local authority owned properties and 108 Housing Association properties.

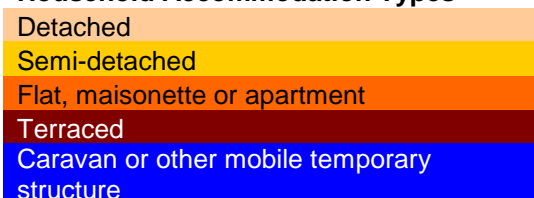

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Lliedi, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £22,923 which is the 13th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 11.2% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people who have never worked and long term unemployed (Level 8) and a higher than average number of people in semi-routine occupations (Level 6).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Lliedi 1** ranks 28 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 609 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Lliedi 2** ranks 98 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1373 in Wales, whilst **Lliedi 3** ranks as the 12th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 358 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Lliedi 1** and **Lliedi 2** is the Community Safety domain, being ranked 6th and 55th in Carmarthenshire and 120 and 1307 in Wales for this domain. In **Lliedi 3** the Health domain that is the most prominent, ranking 2nd in Carmarthenshire and 121st in Wales.
