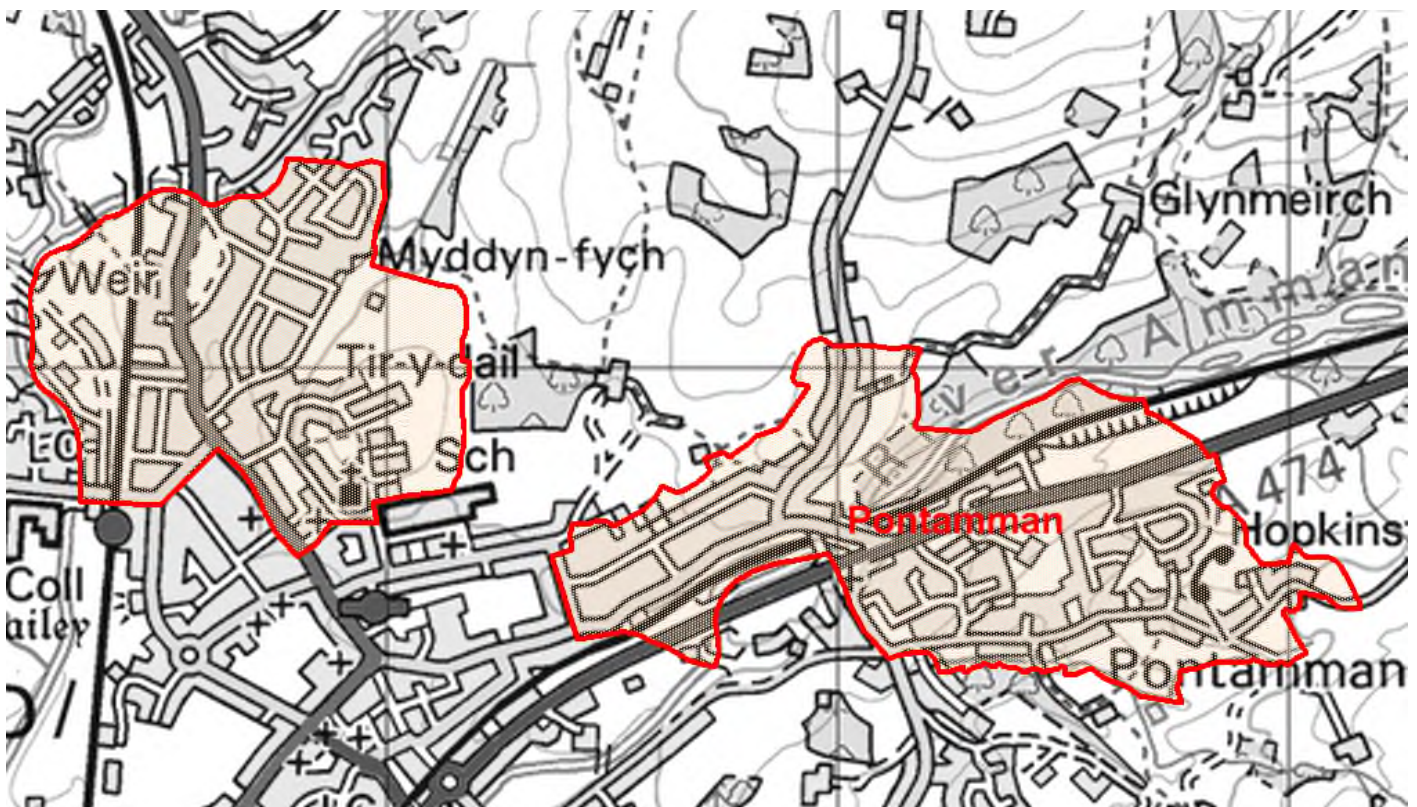

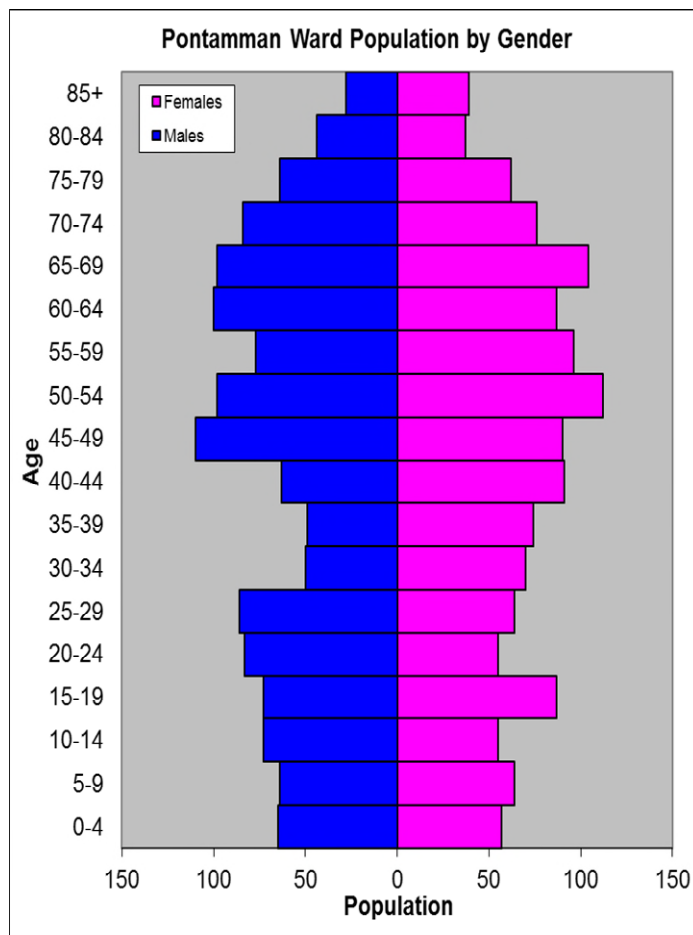
Location: Approximately 35km from Carmarthen Town

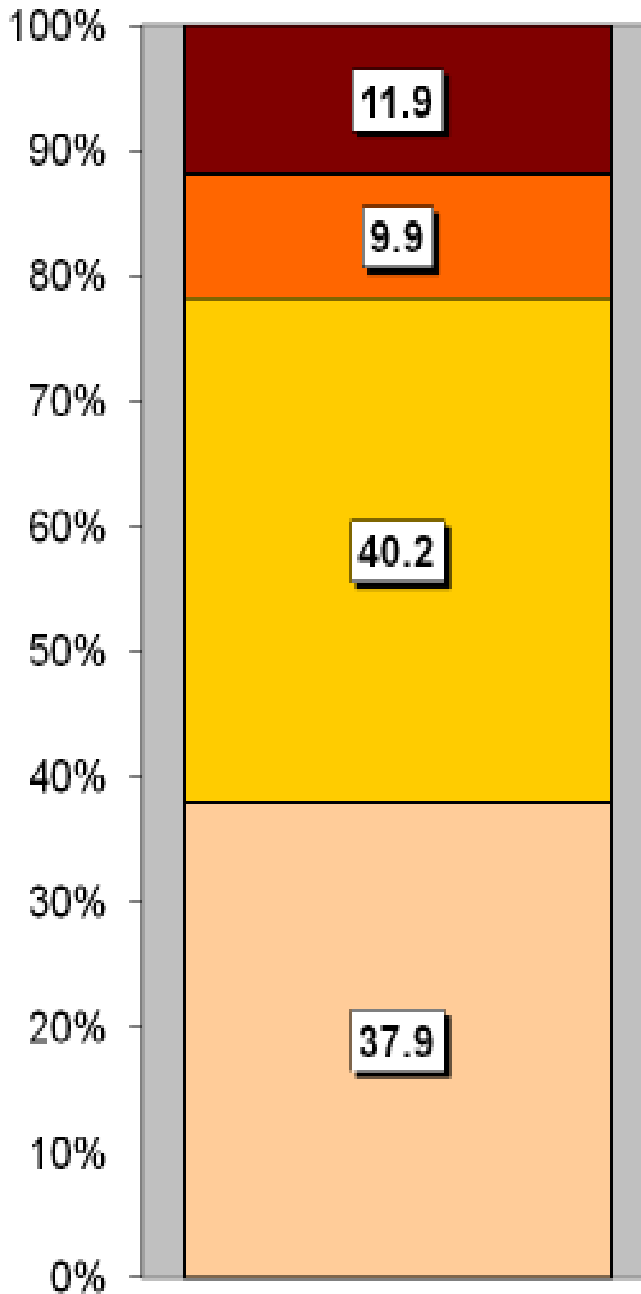

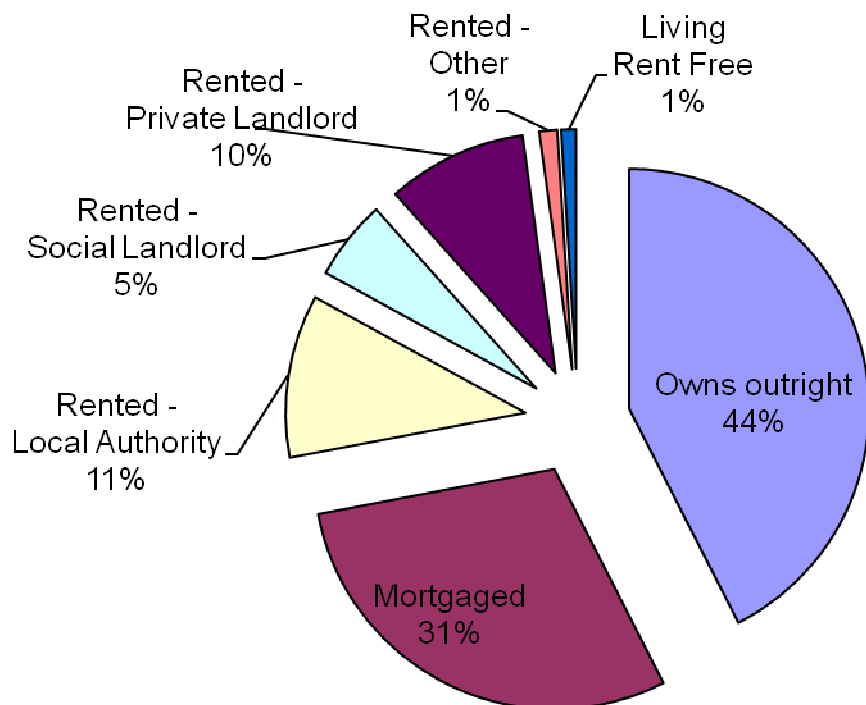
HOUSING

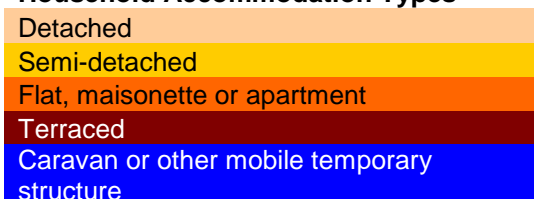

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Pontamman, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £25,072 which is the 23rd lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 1.2% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi/routine occupations (Levels 5-7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Pontamman 1** ranks as the 24th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 554 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Pontamman 2** ranks 107 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1521 from 1909 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Pontamman 1** is the Health domain, being ranked 10th in Carmarthenshire and 323rd in Wales for this domain. In **Pontamman 2** the Access to Services domain is the most prominent ranking 62nd in Carmarthenshire and 626th in Wales.
