


## **HOUSING**

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Saron, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £25,636 which is the 21<sup>st</sup> lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 0.6% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in lower managerial and professional administrative occupations and intermediate occupations (Levels 2-3) and a lower than average number of small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

# WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Saron 1** ranks as the 36<sup>th</sup> most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 694 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Saron 2** ranks as the 54<sup>th</sup> most deprived in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 899 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Saron 1** is the Health domain, being ranked 17<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 416 in Wales for this domain. In **Saron 2** the Physical Environment domain is the most prominent ranking 30<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 507 in Wales.
