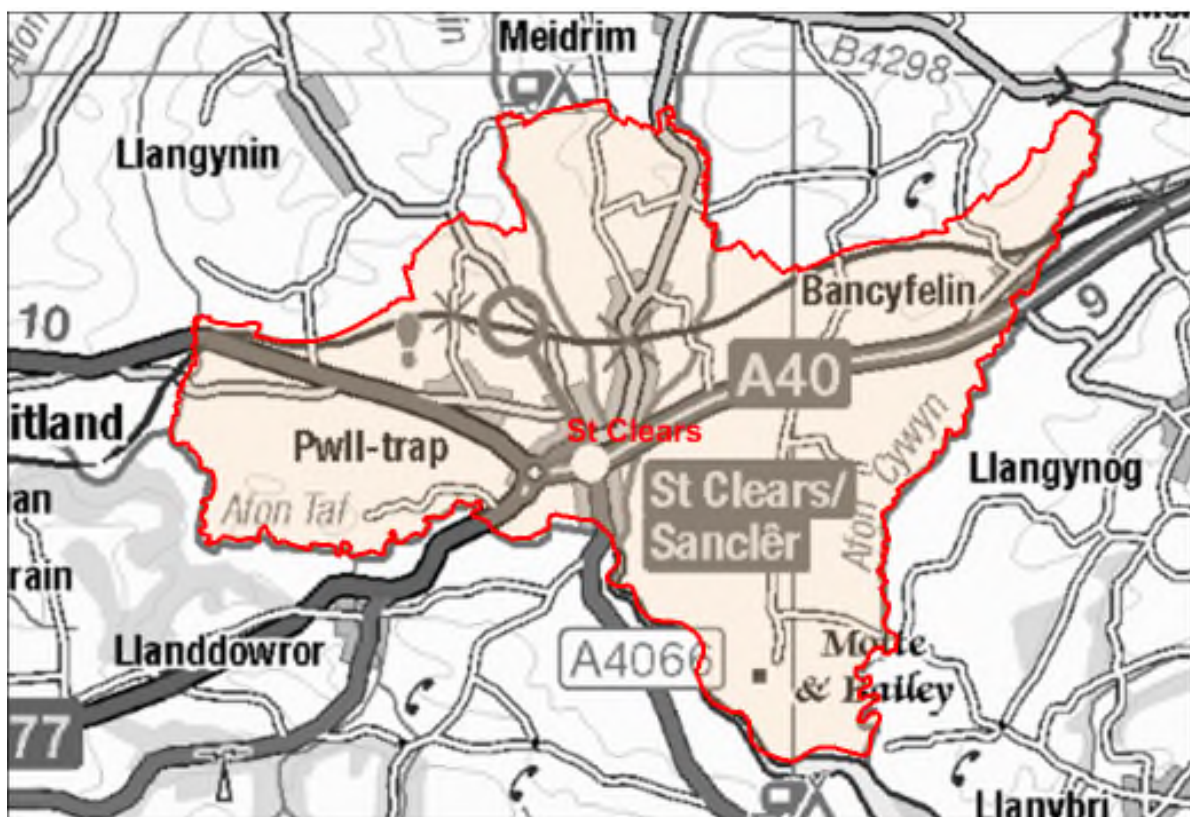

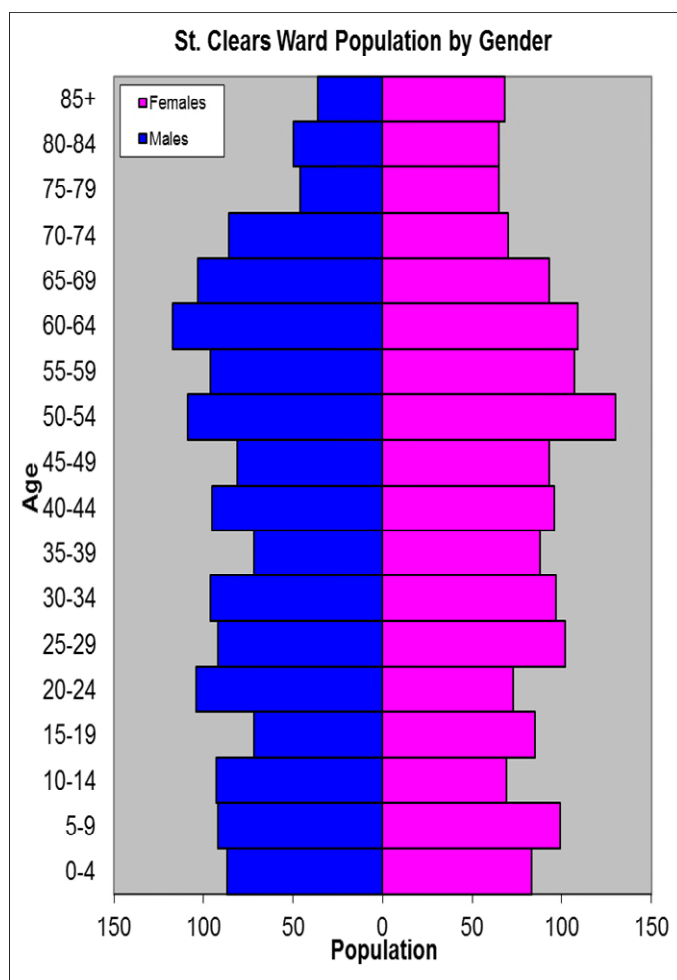

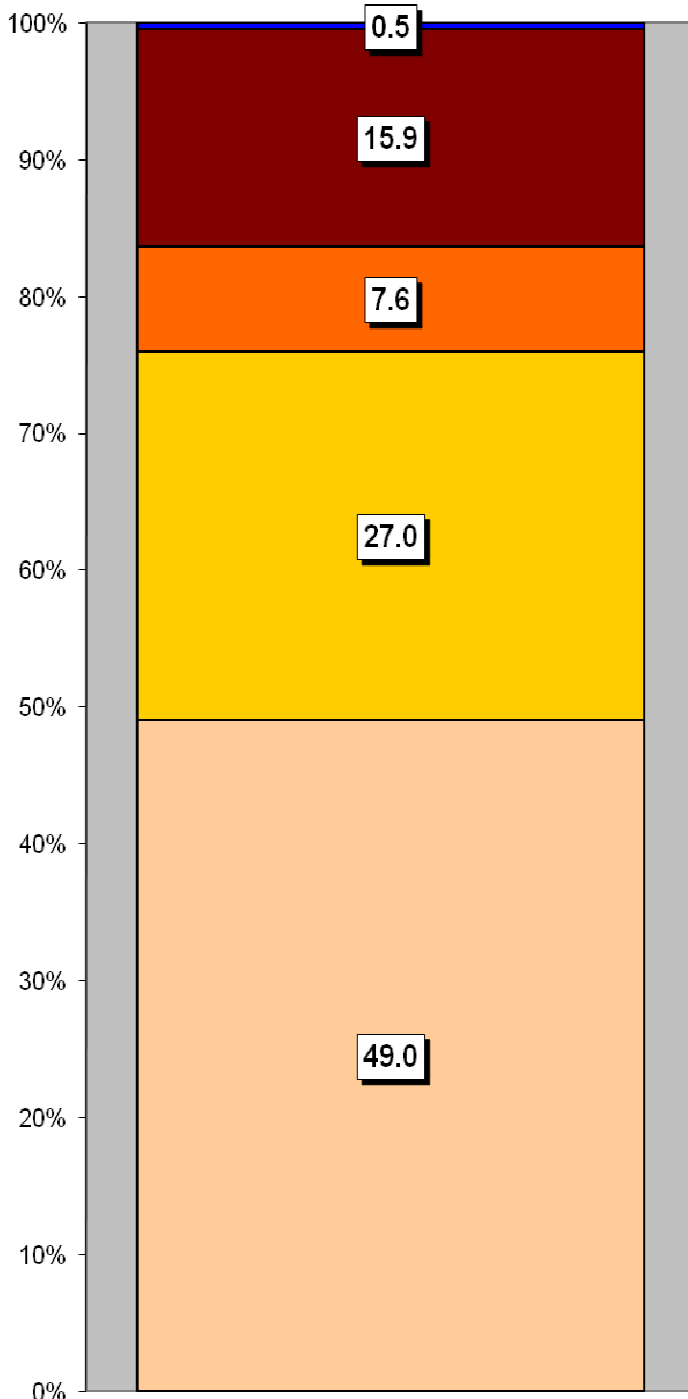

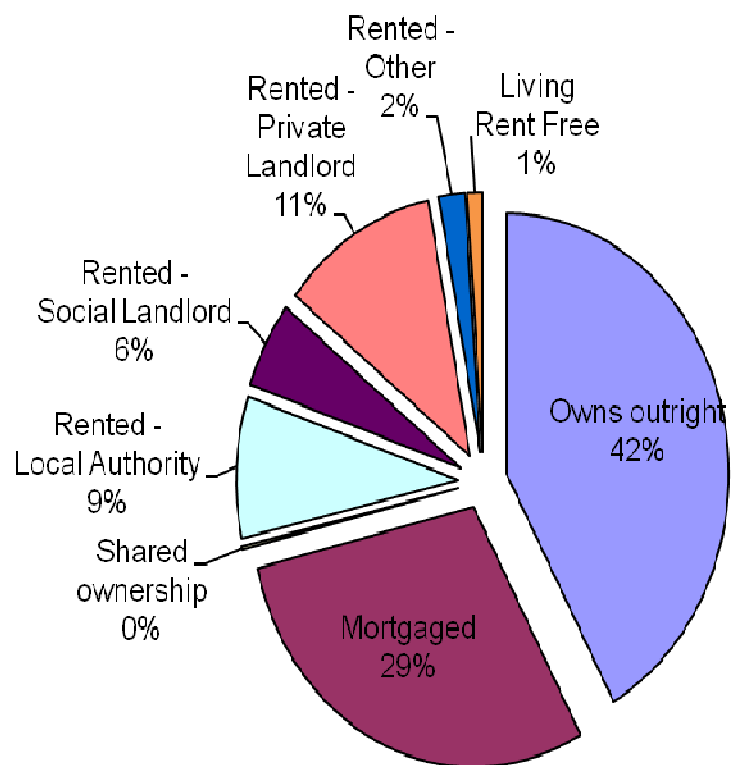
HOUSING

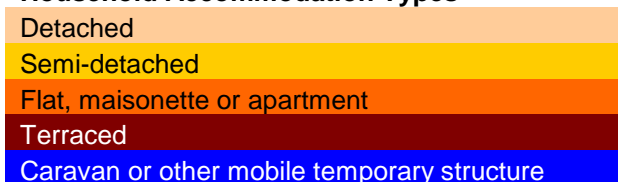

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for St. Clears, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £27,899 which is the 16th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 9.1% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of small employers and own account workers (Level 4) and a lower proportion of people in routine occupations (Level 7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **St. Clears 1** ranks 80 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1127 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **St. Clears 2** ranks as the 81st most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1138 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **St. Clears 1** is the Community Safety domain, being ranked 36th in Carmarthenshire and 1056th in Wales for this domain. In **St. Clears 2** the Access to Services domain is the most prominent ranking 40th in Carmarthenshire and 333rd in Wales.
