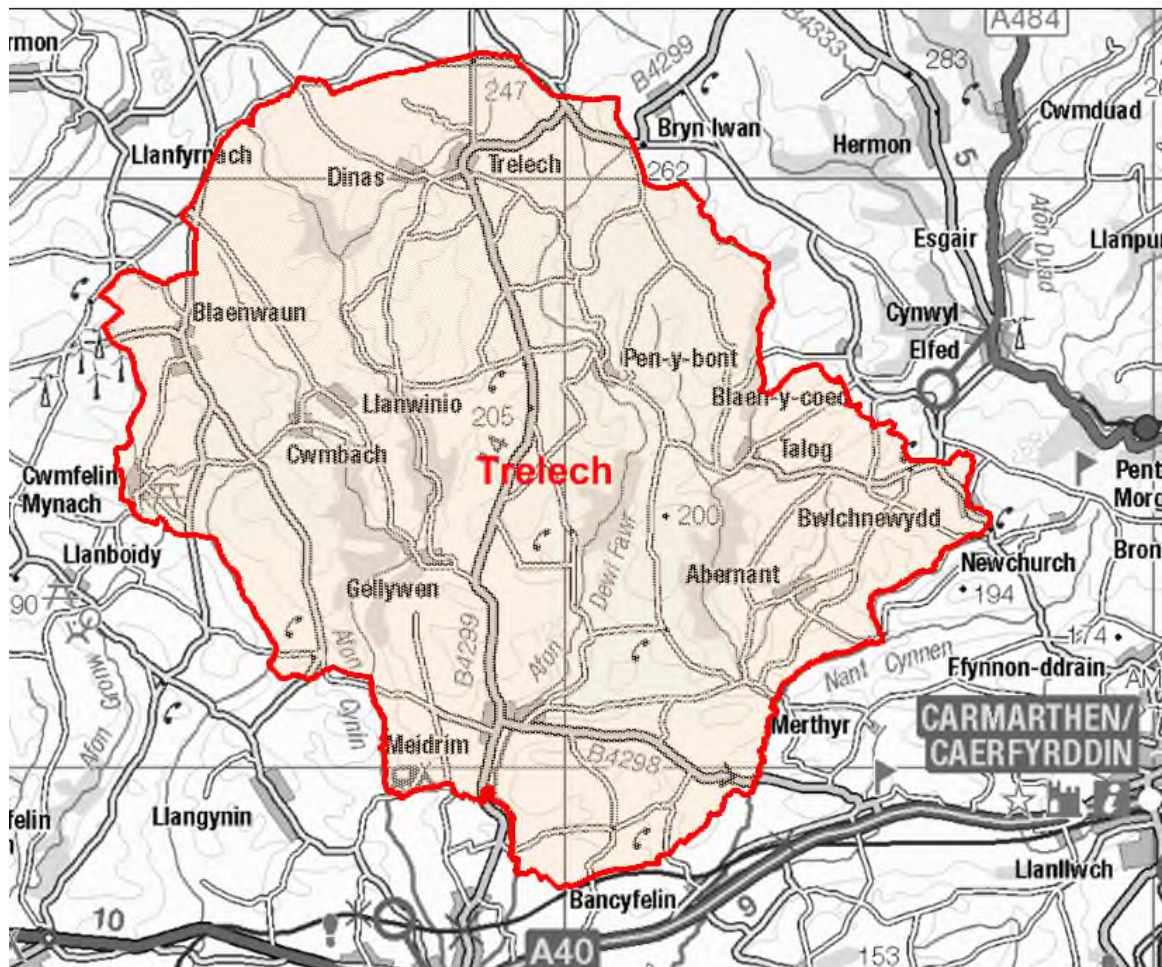

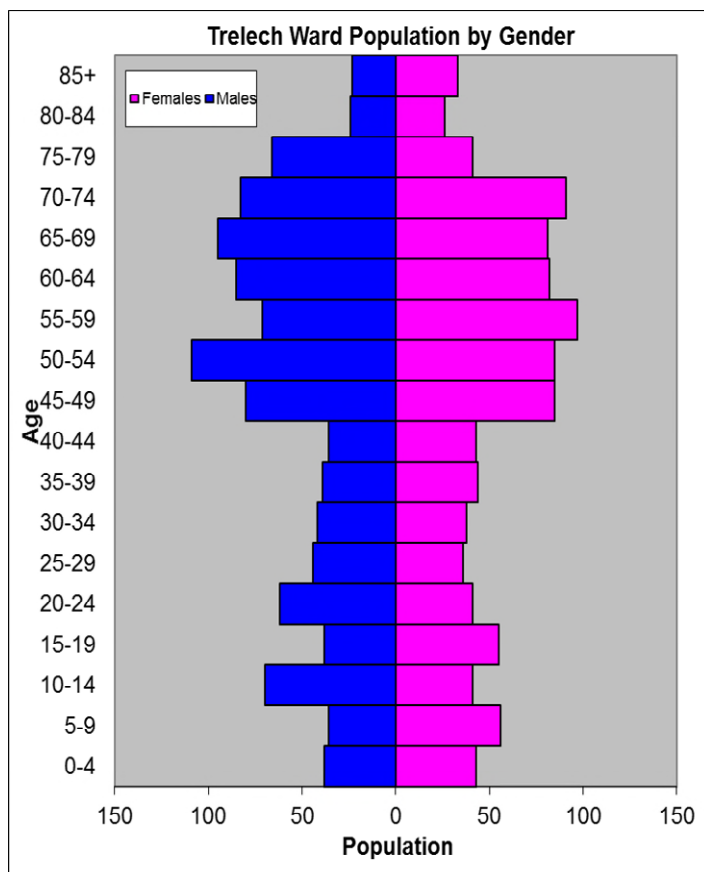
Location: Approximately 24km from Carmarthen Town

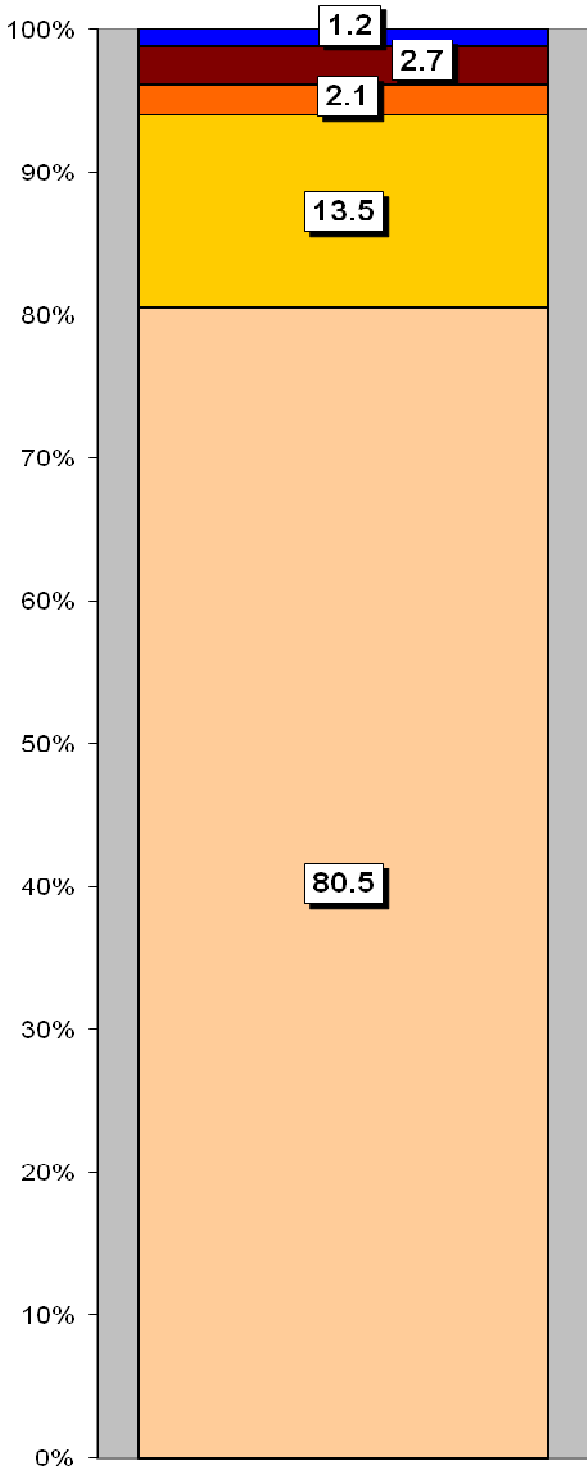

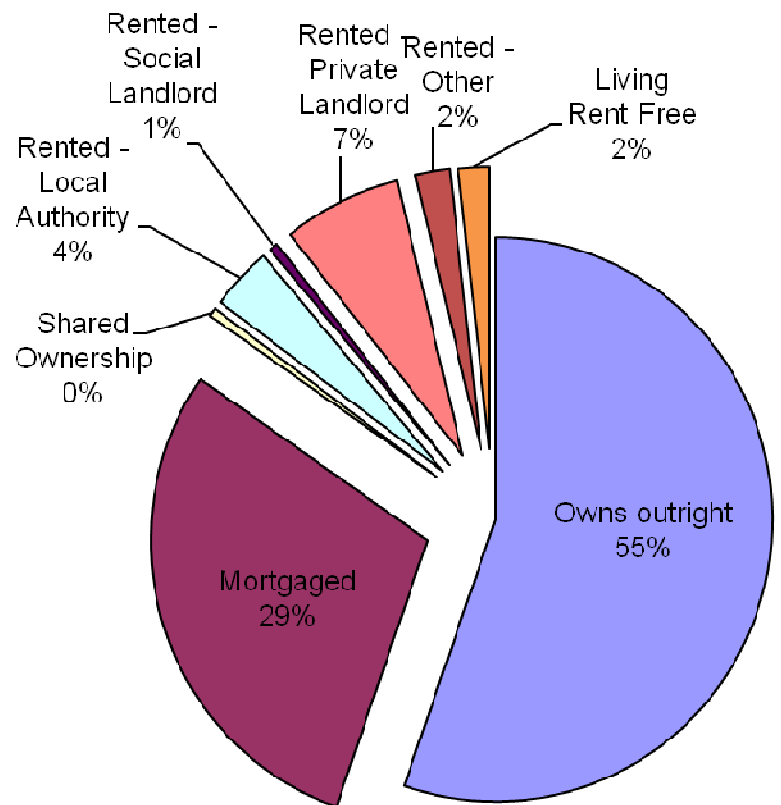
HOUSING

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Trelech, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £26,765 which is the 25th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 5.2% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of small employers and own account workers (Level 4) with a low proportion of people in routine occupations (Level 7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Trelech** ranks as the 53rd most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 884 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Trelech** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 3rd in Carmarthenshire and 5th in Wales for this domain.
