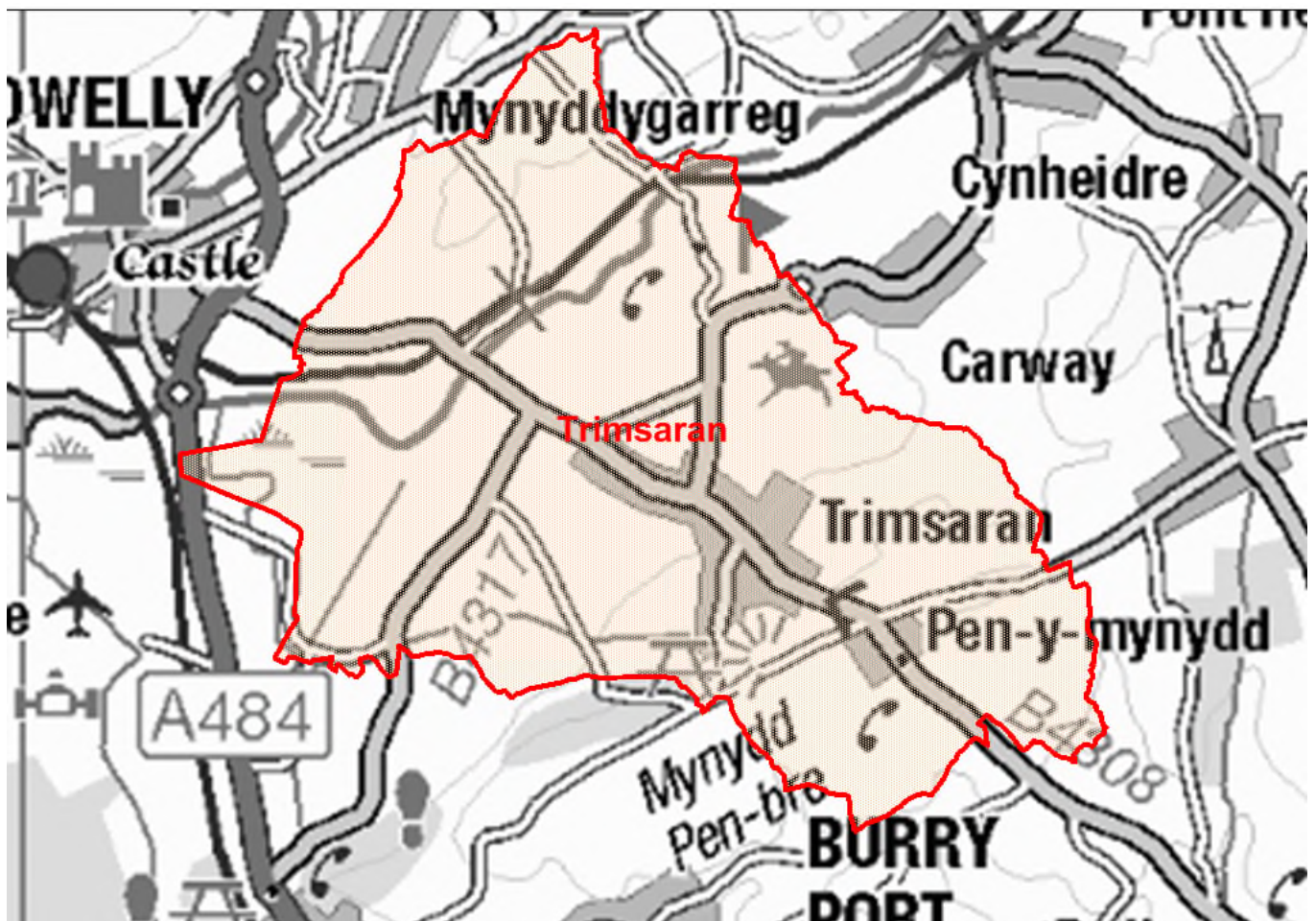

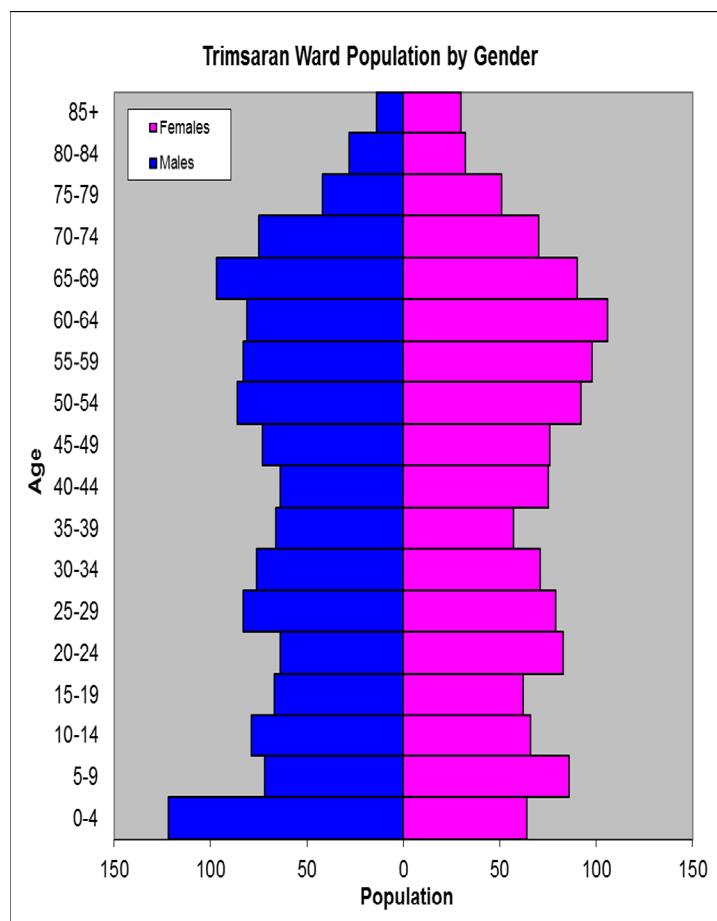

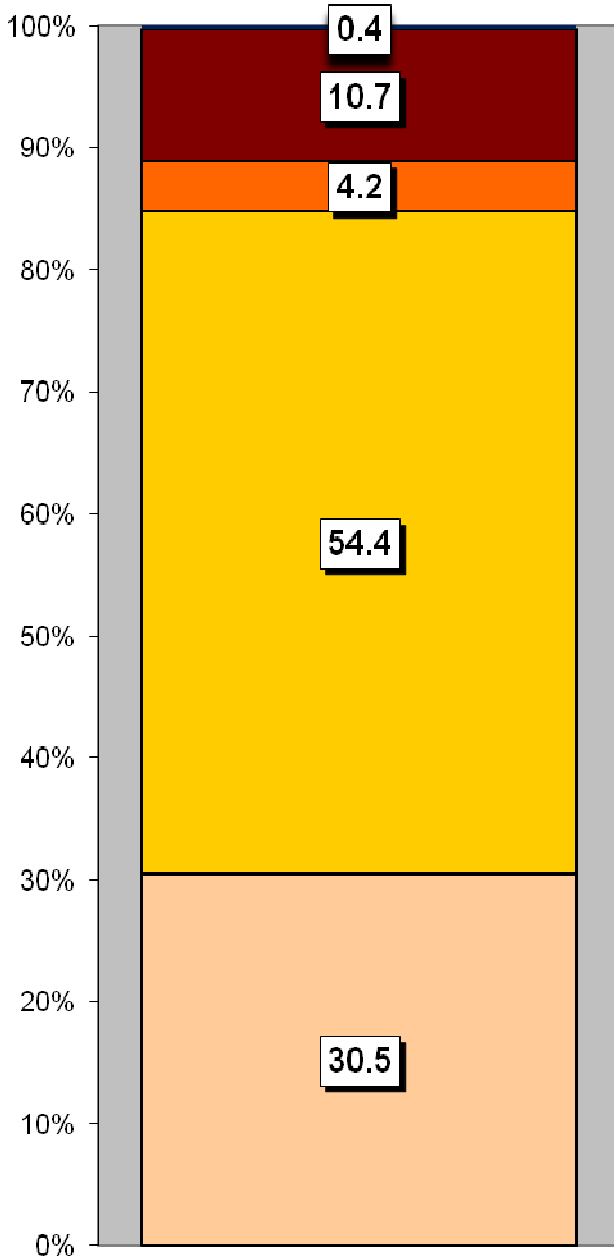

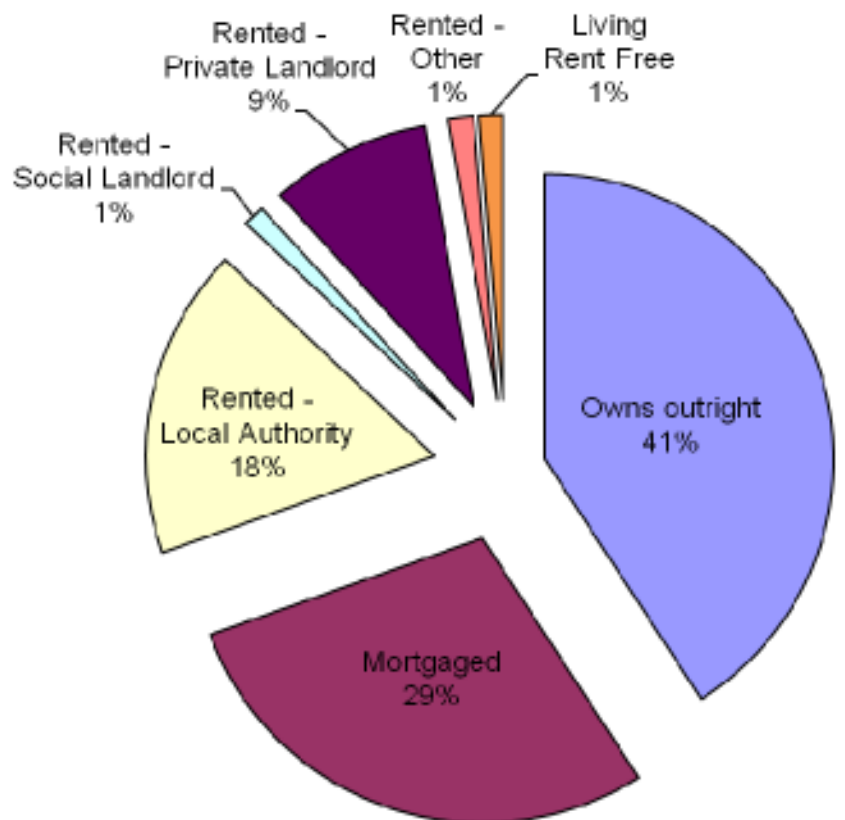
HOUSING

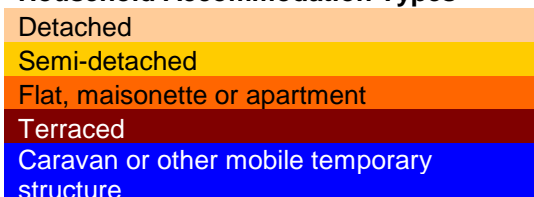

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Trimsaran, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £21,813 which is the 6th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 16.3% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi/routine occupations (Levels 5-7) as well as people who have never worked and long term unemployed (Level 8).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Trimsaran 1** ranks as the 10th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 320 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Trimsaran 2** ranks as the 27th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 594 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Trimsaran 1** is the Health domain, being ranked 7th in Carmarthenshire and 296th in Wales for this domain. In **Trimsaran 2** the Housing domain is the most prominent ranking 17th in Carmarthenshire and 490th in Wales.
