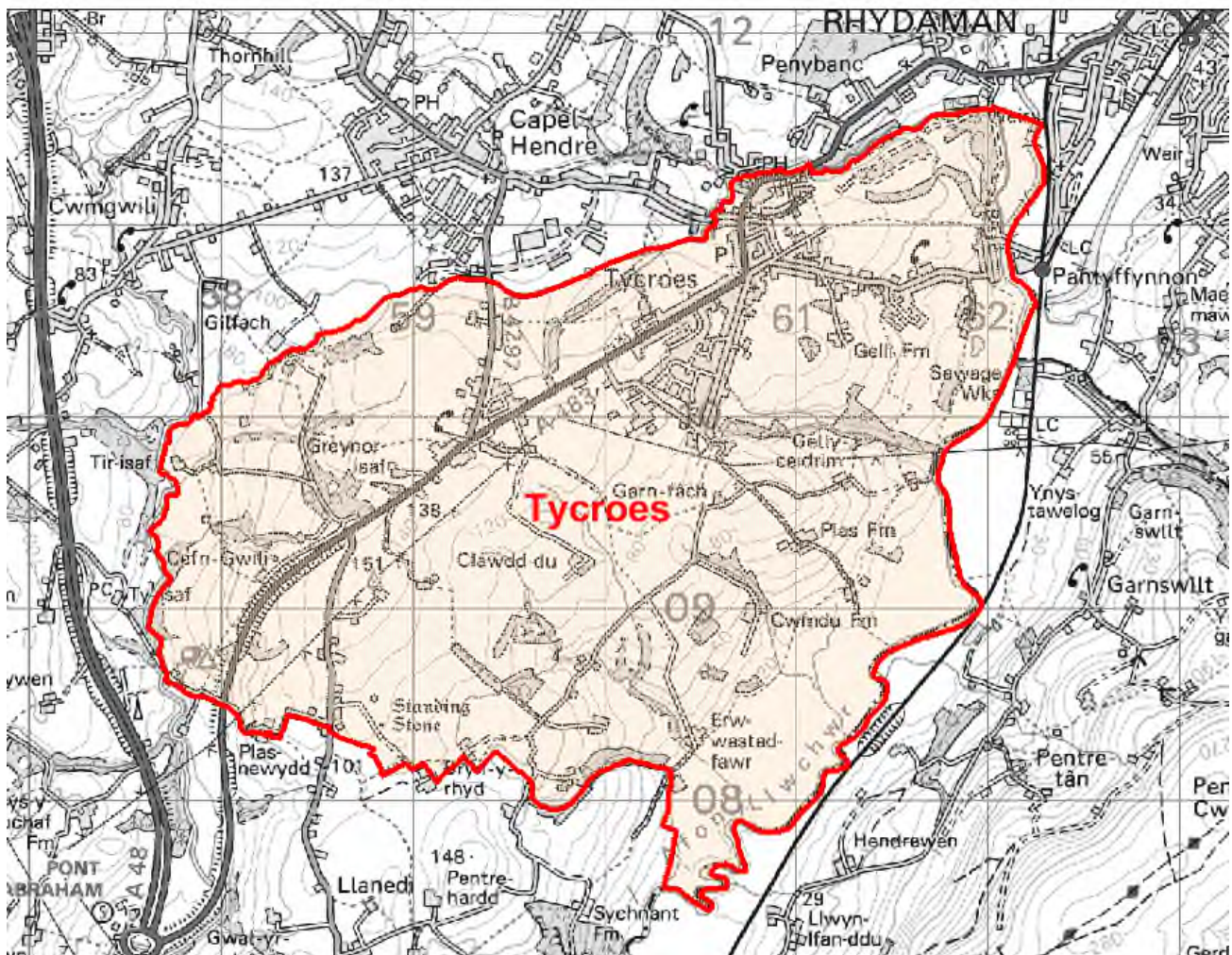

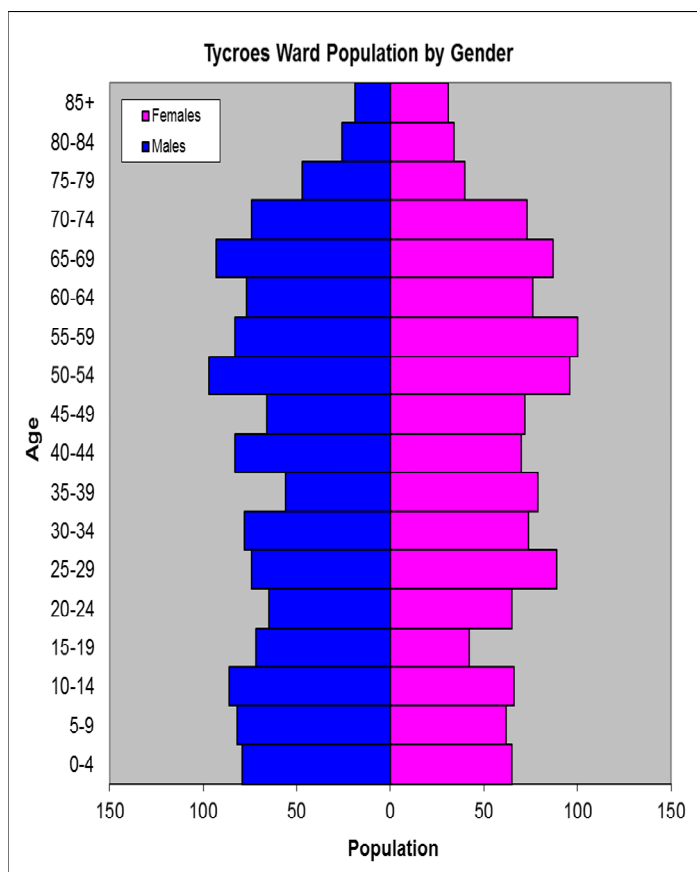
Location: Approximately 30km from Carmarthen Town

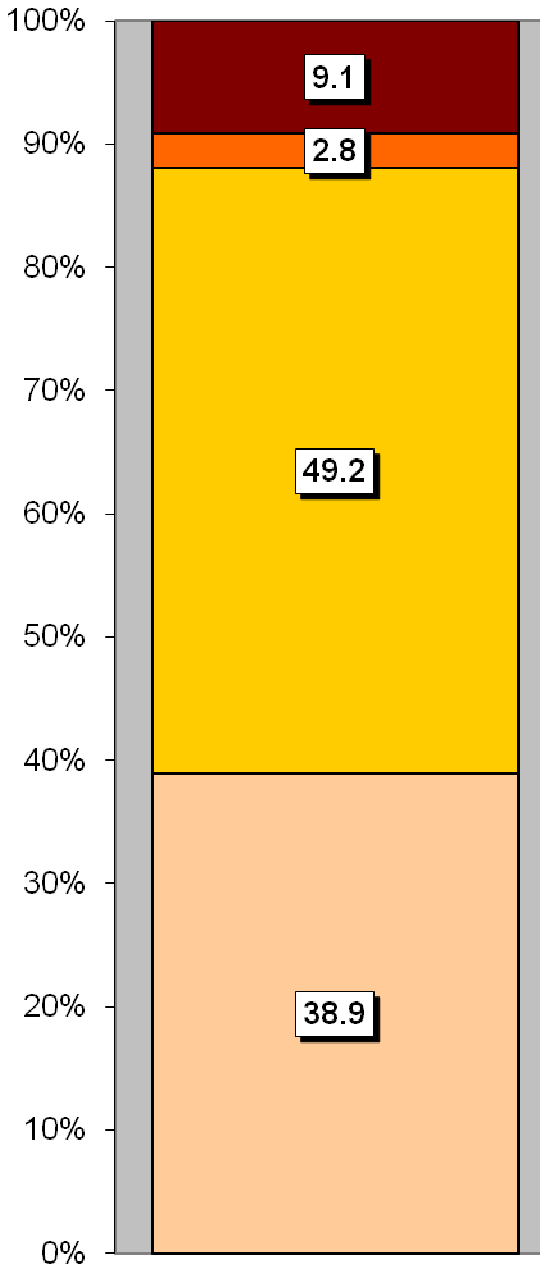

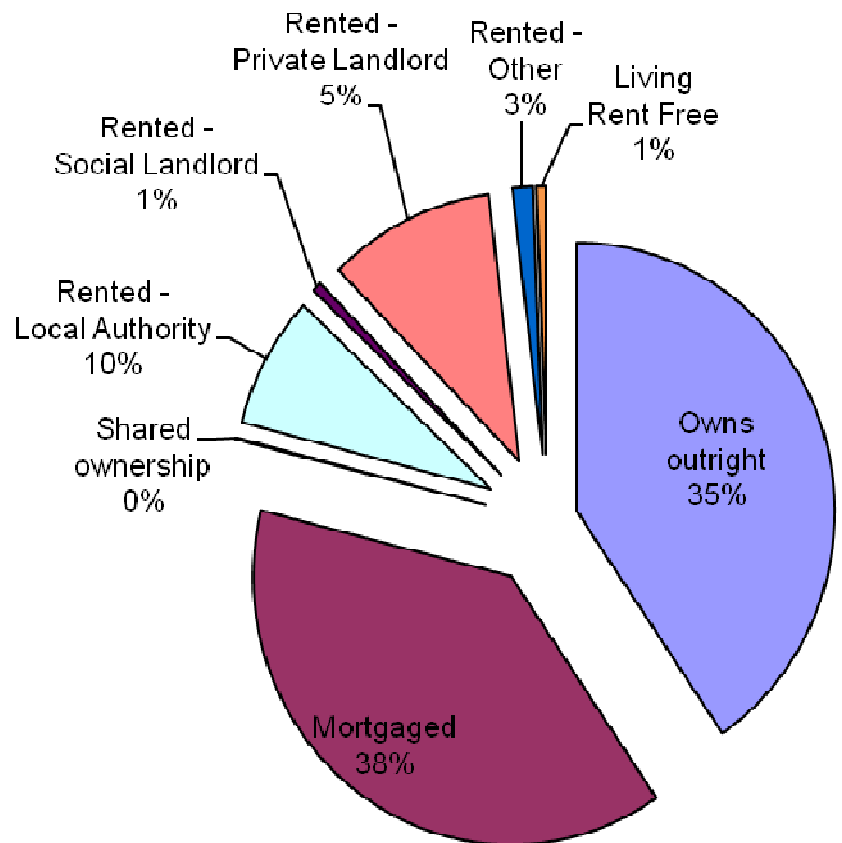
HOUSING

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Tycroes, based on CACI's 2017 'PayCheck' data, is £27,819 which is the 17th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 8.8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £25,365.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a high level of people in lower managerial and professional administrative occupations (Level 2) and intermediate occupations (Level 3) and a lower proportion of higher managerial and professional occupations (Level 1).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Tycroes** ranks as the 84th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1198 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Tycroes** is the Access to Services and Health domains, being ranked 59th in Carmarthenshire and 579 and 932 respectively in Wales for these domains.
