Secondary - Based on the pupil numbers as per January 2018 PLASC and forecasted pupil numbers for September 2018. The amount allocated is the total budget for secondary schools after all of the supplements have been deducted. This amount is then divided by pupil numbers to give a standard allocation per pupil.

METHOD

Nursery & Primary - Funding is based on statementing cost per pupil statemented before 1 April 2014.

Secondary Pre 16 - Contribution towards the costs of supporting pre-16 statemented pupils who were statemented before 1 April 2014. The level of need for each child is individually assessed and a number of units based on specific categories is allocated. Funding is allocated based on a standard unit value.

Secondary Post 16 - Contribution towards the costs of supporting post-16 statemented pupils. The level of need for each child is individually assessed and a number of units based on specific categories is allocated. Available funds are then apportioned by the number of units at each school.
