Active Travel Update

Since the introduction of our counter network in 2017 we have seen a large rise in the numbers of walking and cycling journeys recorded around Carmarthenshire. While this increase in users across the network is also influenced by additional counters being implemented and failure of older counters, the sharp rise in 2020 reflects an increase in Active Travel journeys during the Coronavirus lockdown period. We have recently been awarded over £1.7 million of Sustainable Transport funding from Welsh Government to improve walking and cycling infrastructure and lock in the positive behavioural changes people have made. This funding will be used across the county to maximise the feasibility of Active Travel modes while maintaining Social Distancing.
