

THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (LLANELLI) (WAITING RESTRICTION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION (EXPERIMENTAL VARIATION No. 37)

ORDER 2020

THE CARMARTHENSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The County of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli) (Waiting Restriction And Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 ("the Consolidation Order") as subsequently varied is hereby further modified by the attachment thereto of the plans attached to this Order which have the effect of varying the existing provisions by imposing on such parts of the highway identified on the plan attached to this Order limited waiting periods as more particularly specified thereon in accordance with the provisions of the Consolidation Order (as varied) and which said plan shall prevail during the duration of this Order
2. To suspend the provisions of The County Of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli)(Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places) Consolidation (Variation No.11) Order 2011 between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. only on all days in so far as it relates to the northwest side of Murray Street from a point 26 metres southwest of the centre of its junction with Cowell Street for a distance of 30 metres in a general south westerly direction.
3. The Order shall come into operation on the third day of August Two Thousand and Twenty and may be cited as The County of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli) (Waiting Restriction And Street Parking Places) Consolidation (Experimental Variation No.37) Order 2020
