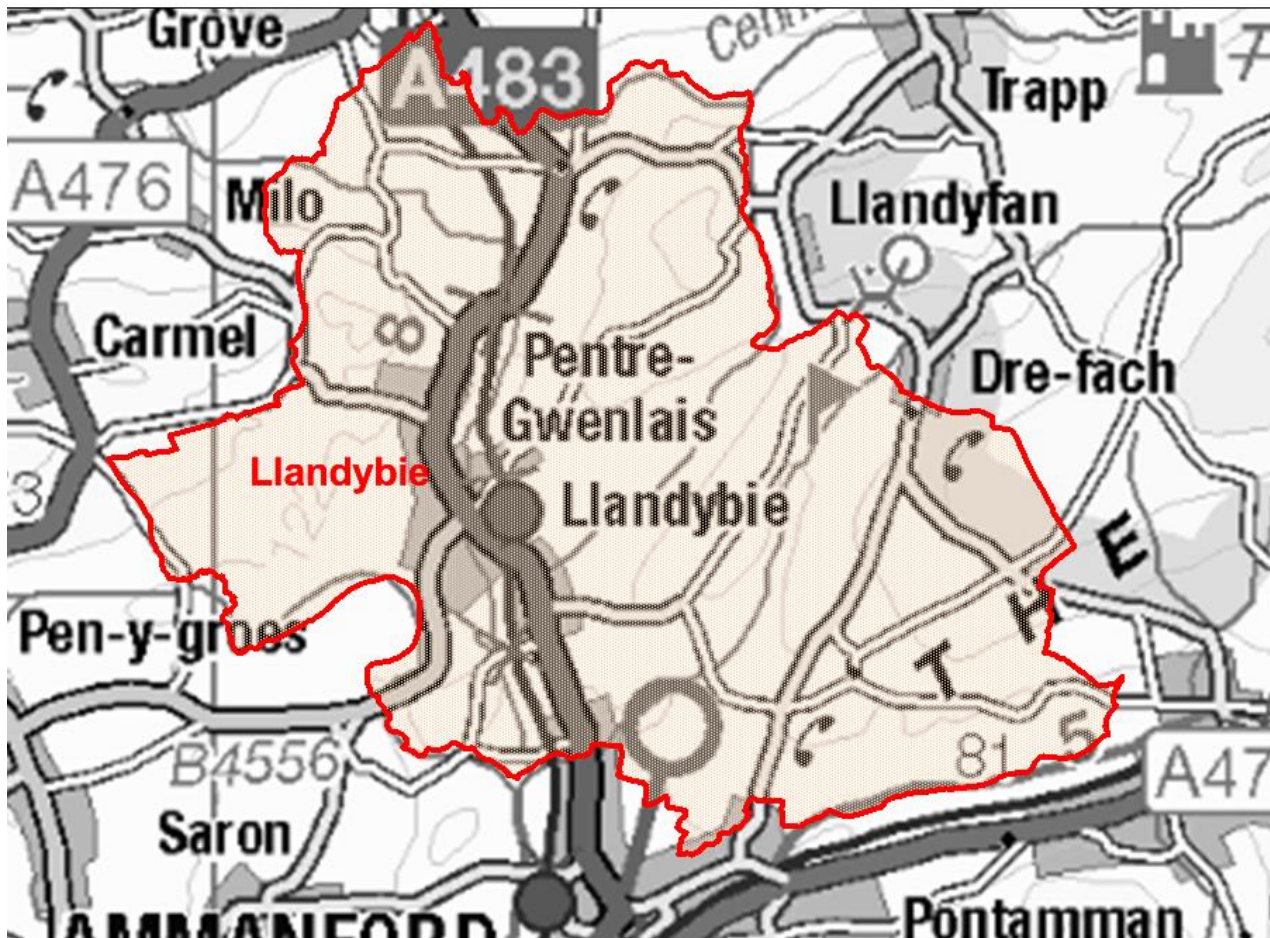

Location: Approximately 26km from Carmarthen Town

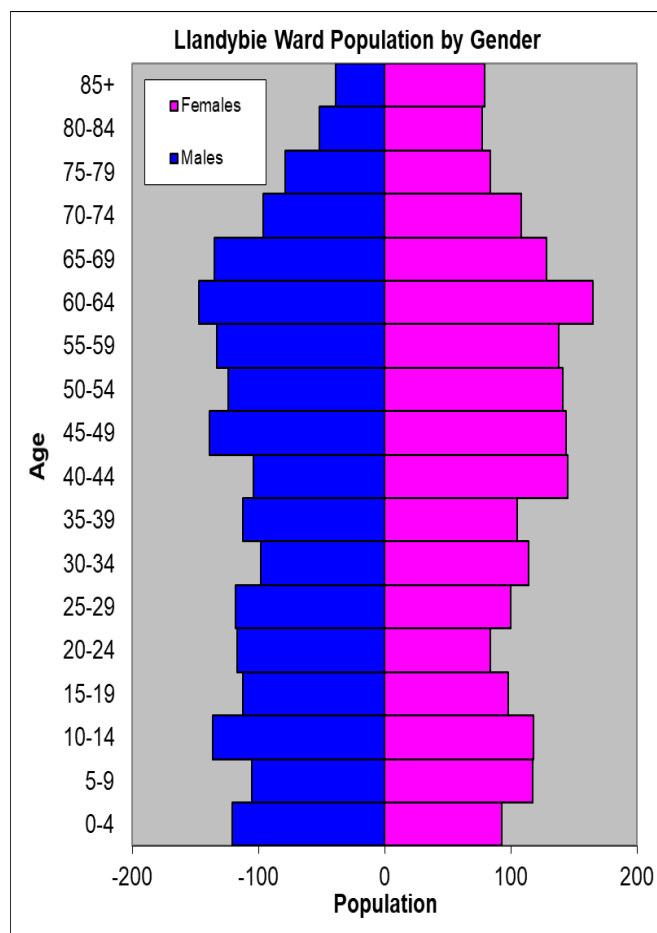

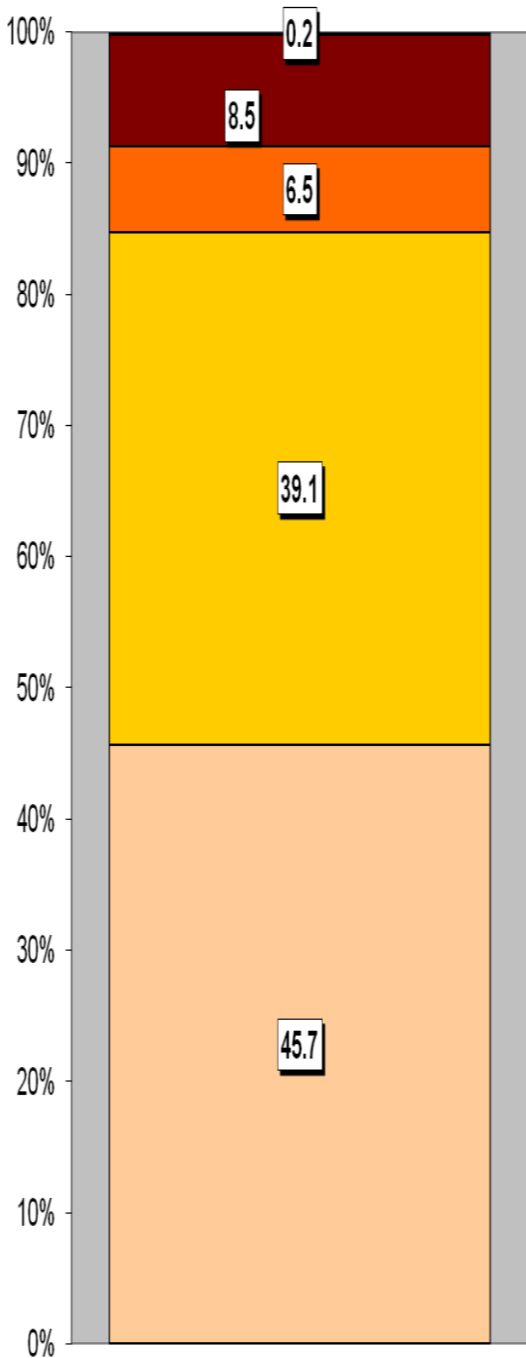

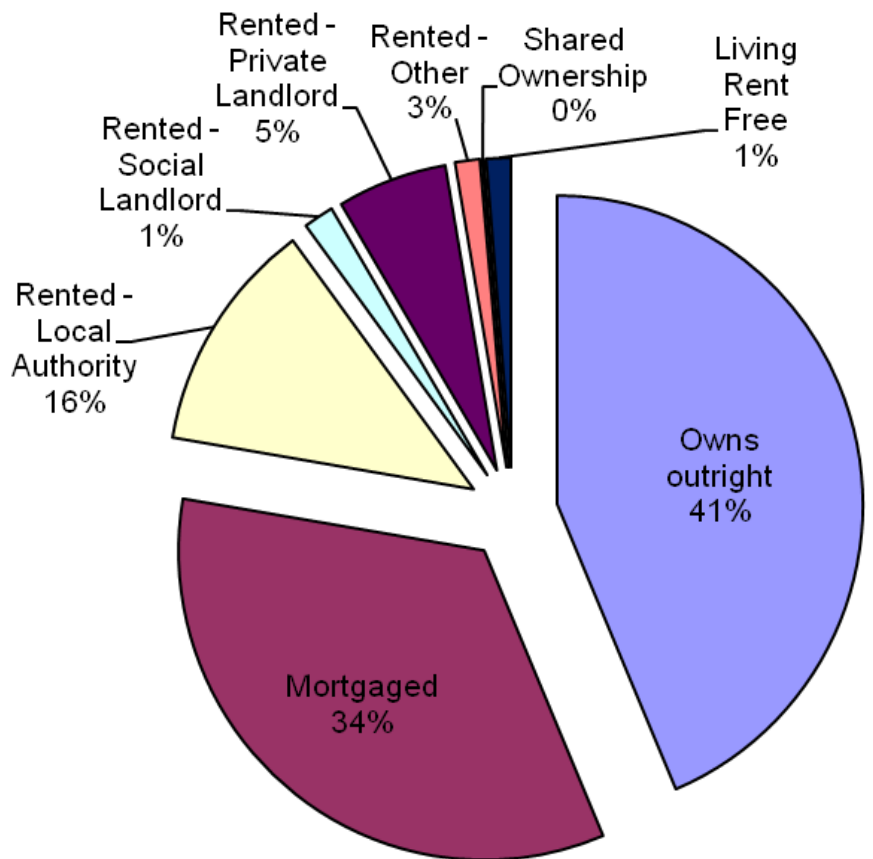
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mainly of two types, semi-detached and detached. The ward consists of 208 local authority owned properties and 28 Housing Association properties.

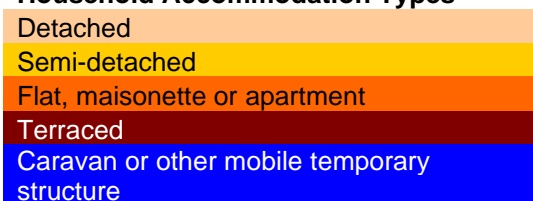

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llandybie, based on CACI's 2019 'PayCheck' data, is £28,523 which is the 27th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 4.8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £27,148.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a marginally higher than average level of people in higher/lower managerial and professional administrative occupation (Levels 1-2).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llandybie 1** ranks 96 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1330 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Llandybie 2** ranks as the 21st most deprived area in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 491 from 1909 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llandybie 1** is the Physical Environment domain, being ranked 3rd in Carmarthenshire and 139 in Wales for this domain. In **Llandybie 2** Physical Environment is also the most prominent domain ranking 4th in Carmarthenshire and 180 in Wales.
