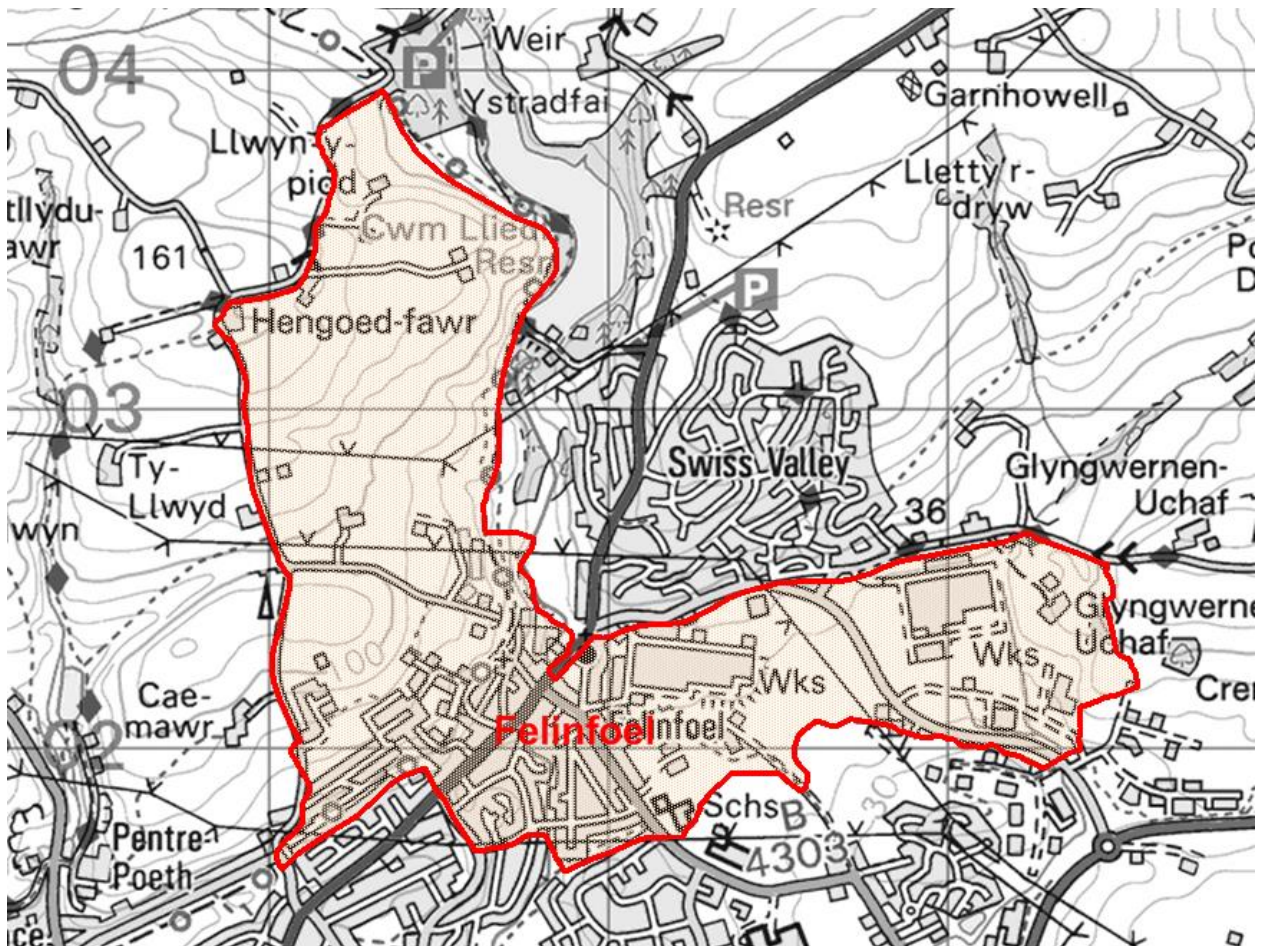

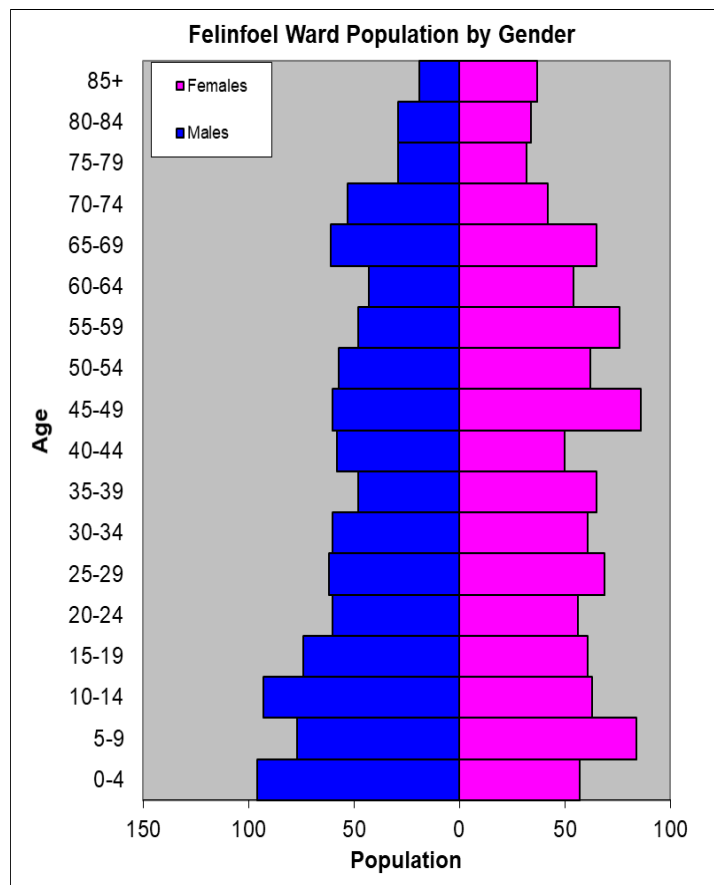

- ⇒ Highest proportion of people aged under 45, proportion aged 65-74 is lower than the Carmarthenshire average.
- ⇒ Higher proportion of people with no qualifications and slightly higher number of people with limiting long-term illness
- ⇒ Lower proportion of Welsh Speakers than the Carmarthenshire average.

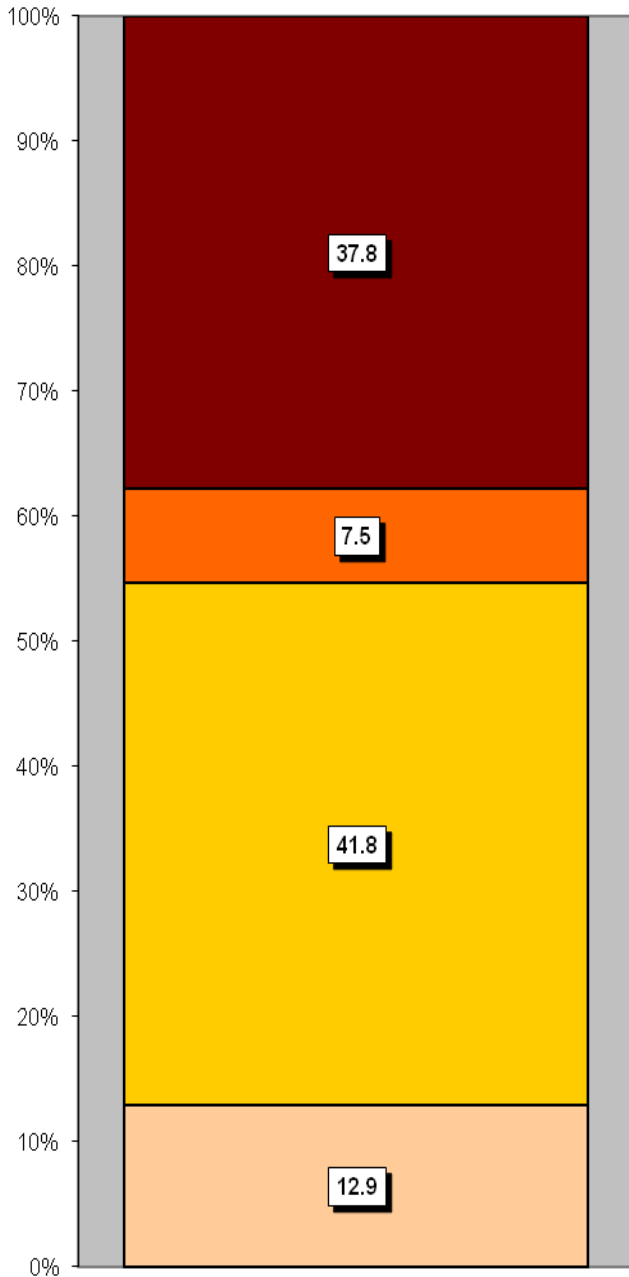

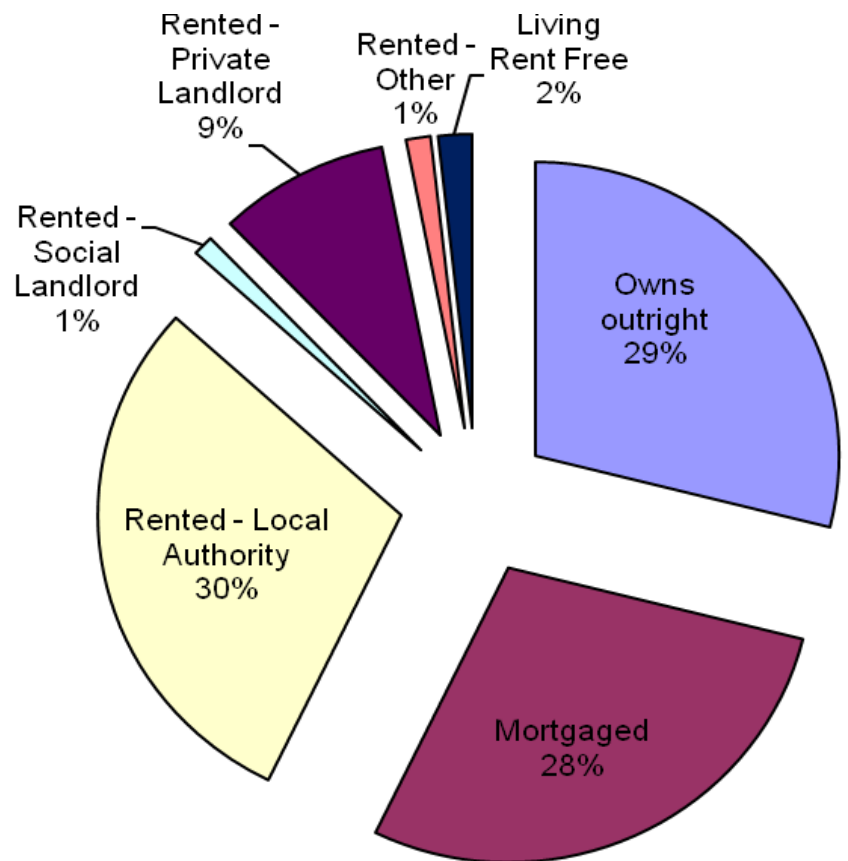
## HOUSING

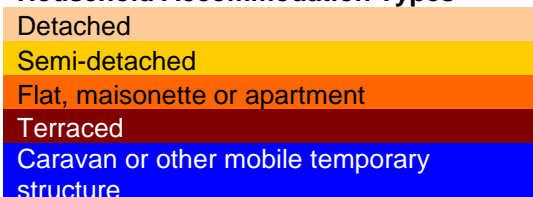

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Felinfoel, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £22,010 which is the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 28.1% below the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in semi-routine/routine occupations (Levels 6-7) and a higher than average that have never worked or been long term unemployed (Level 8).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Felinfoel** ranks 11 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 360 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Felinfoel** is the Income domain, being ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 282 in Wales for this domain.
