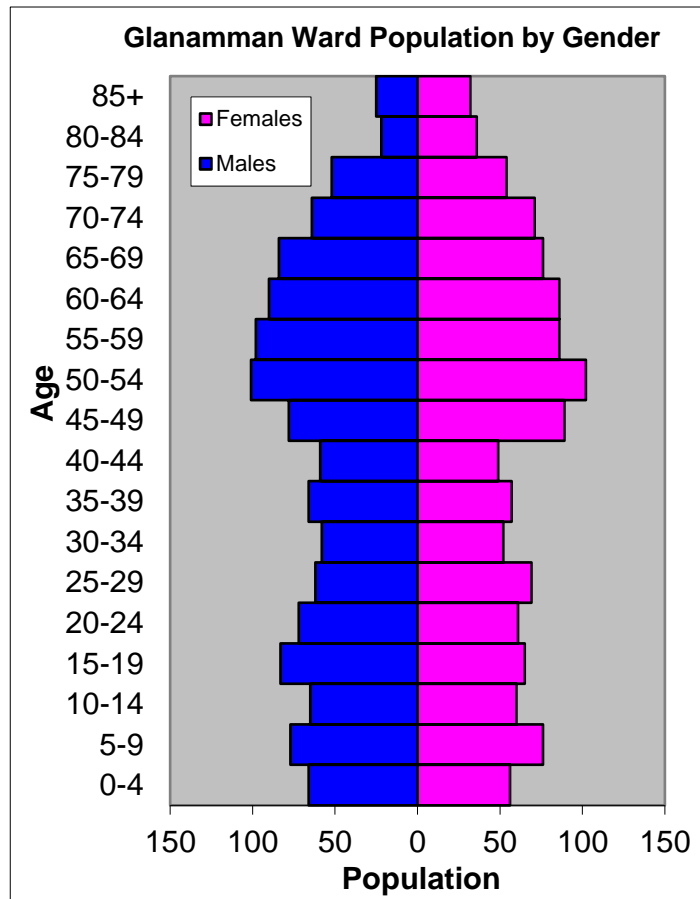

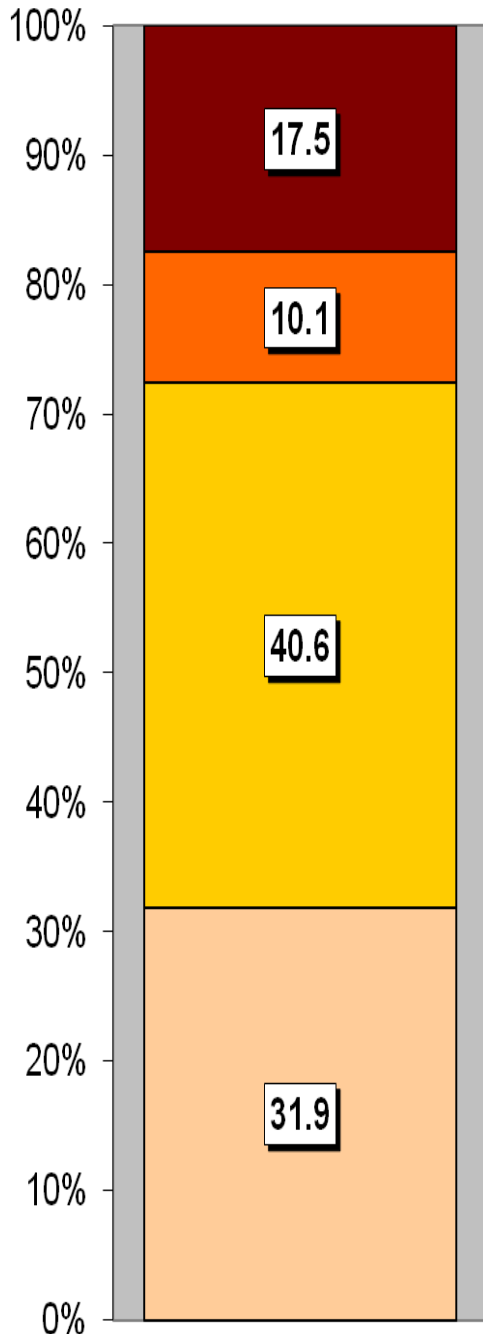

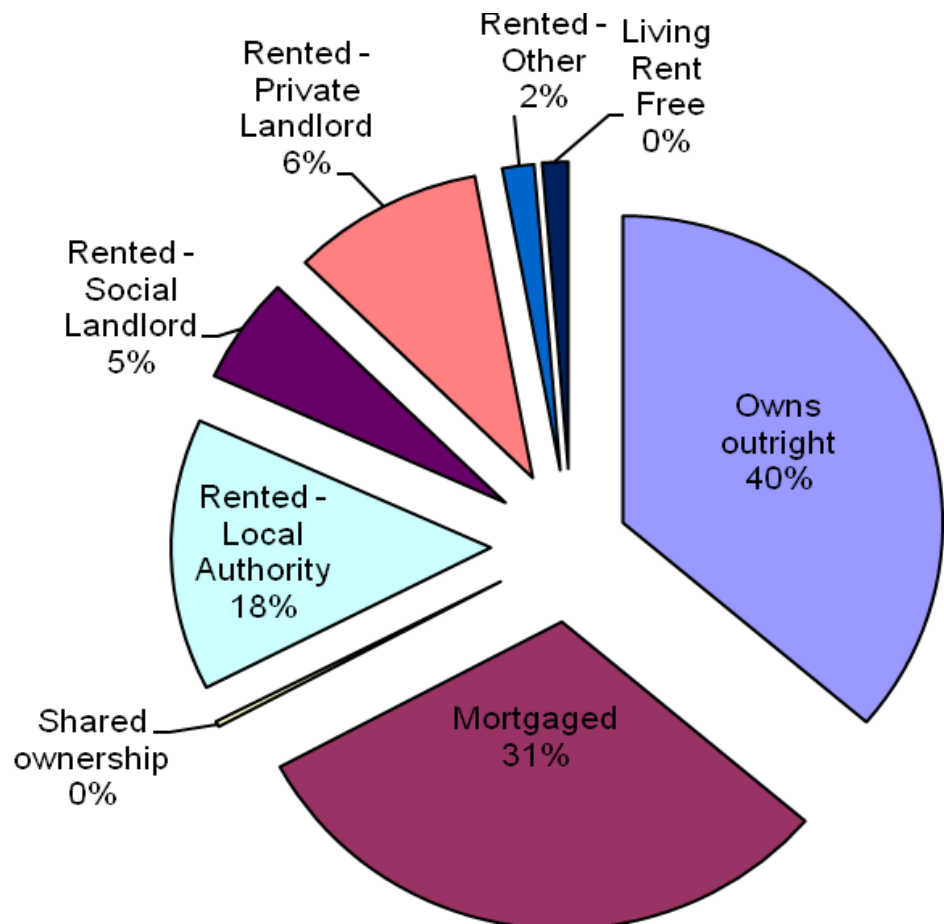
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of semi-detached houses. There is a larger proportion of detached properties than terraced. The smallest proportion of housing is attributed to the caravan or other mobile temporary structure category. The ward consists of 150 local authority owned properties and 59 Housing Association properties.

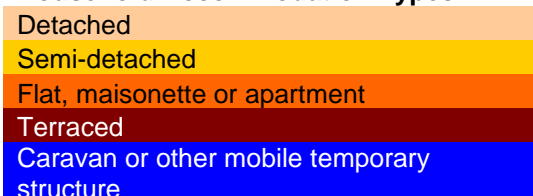

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Glanamman, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £25,664 which is the 13th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 9.8% below the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in semi-routine/routine occupations (Levels 6-7).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived **Glanamman 1** ranks 30 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 557 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Glanamman 2** ranks 25 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 525 from in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Glanamman 1** is the Income domain, being ranked 17th in Carmarthenshire and 486 in Wales for this domain. In **Glanamman 2** the Physical Environment domain is the most prominent ranking 9th in Carmarthenshire and 212 in Wales.
