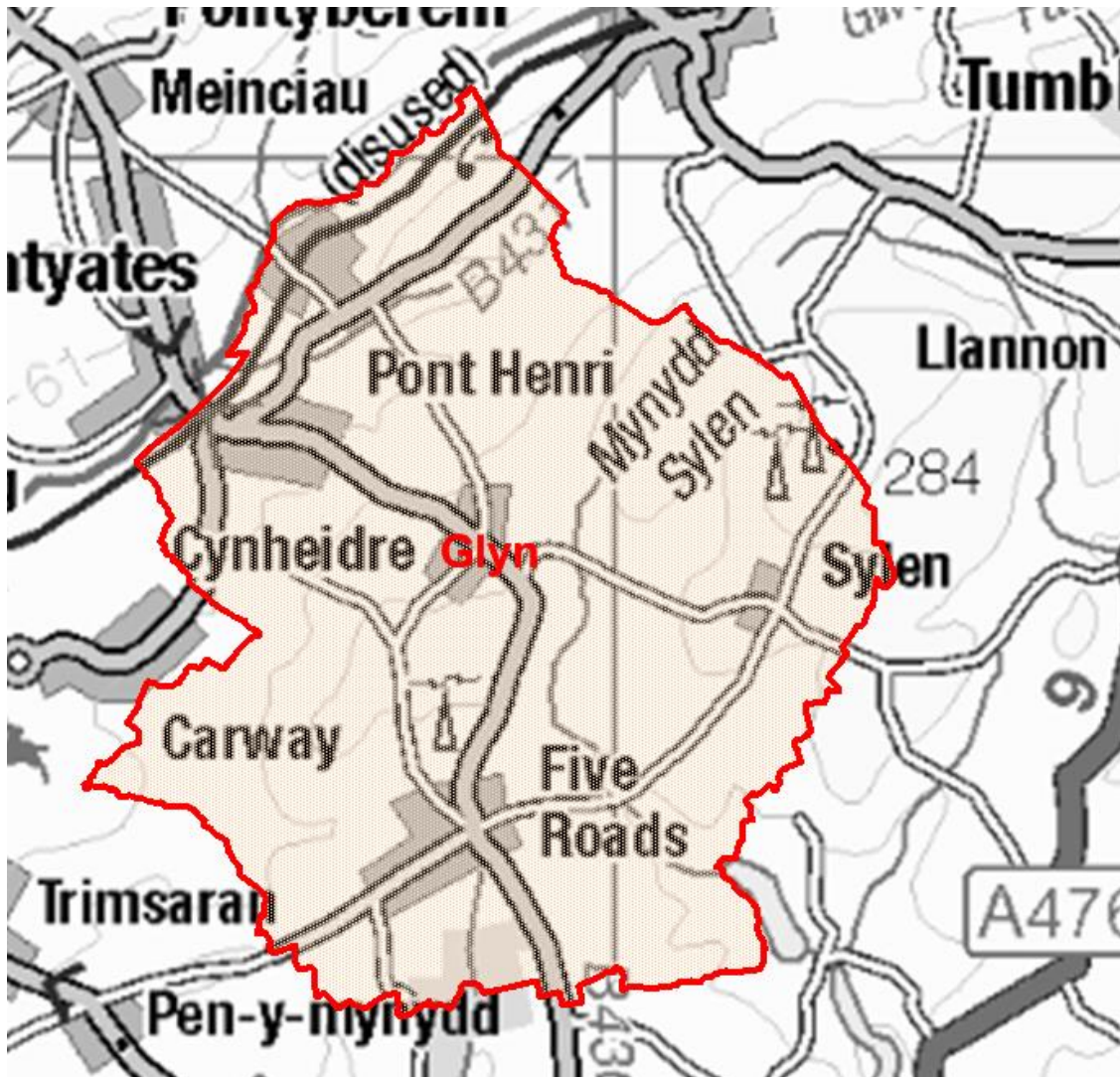

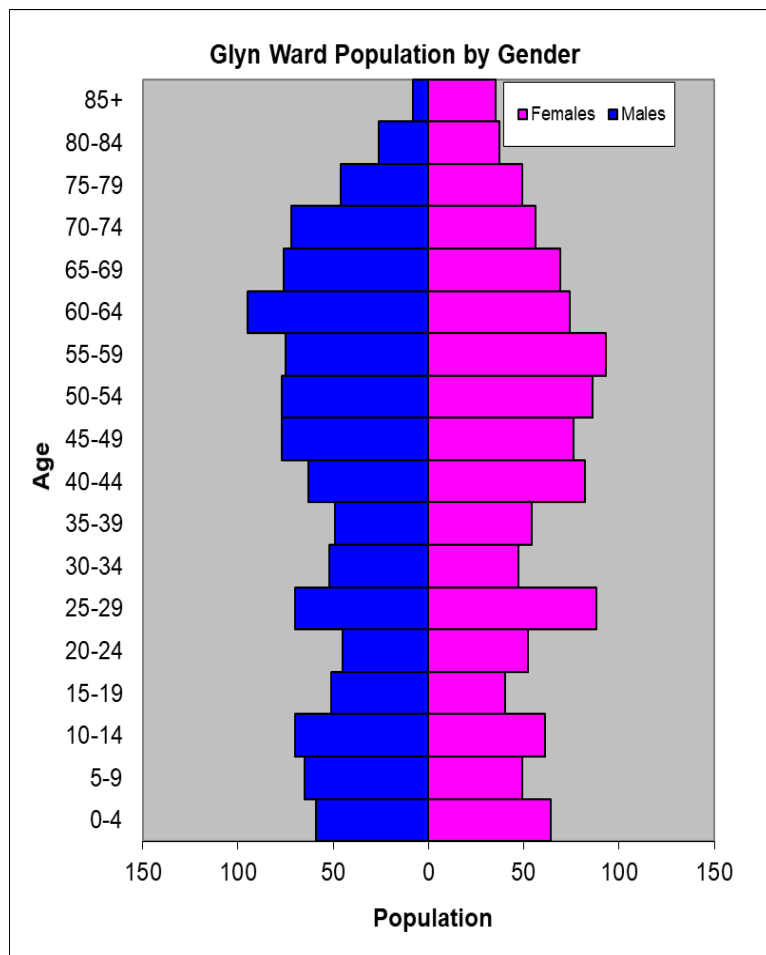

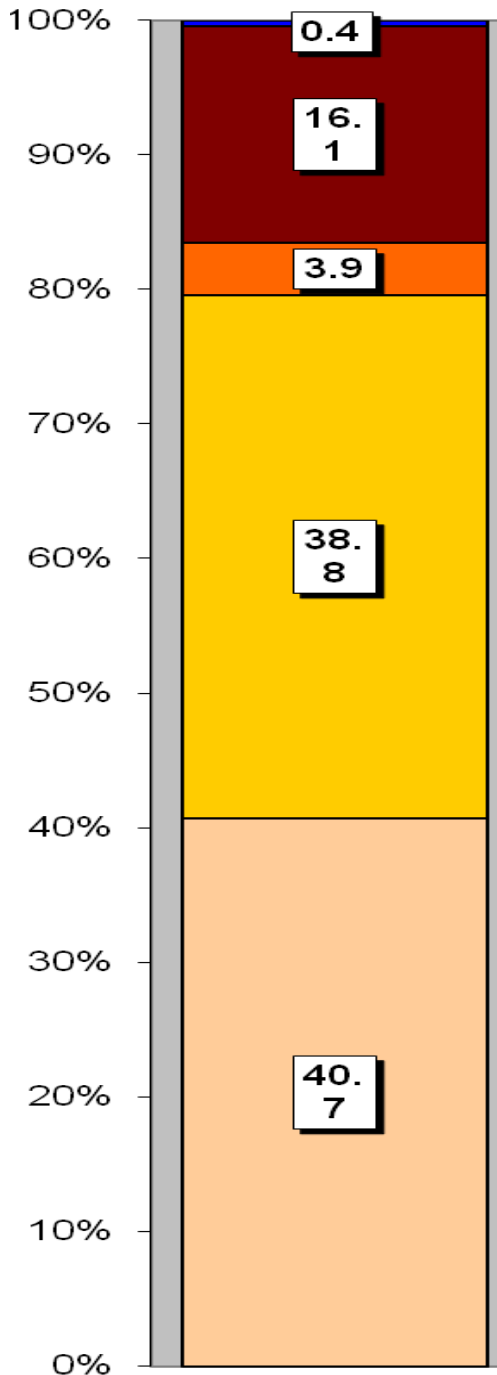

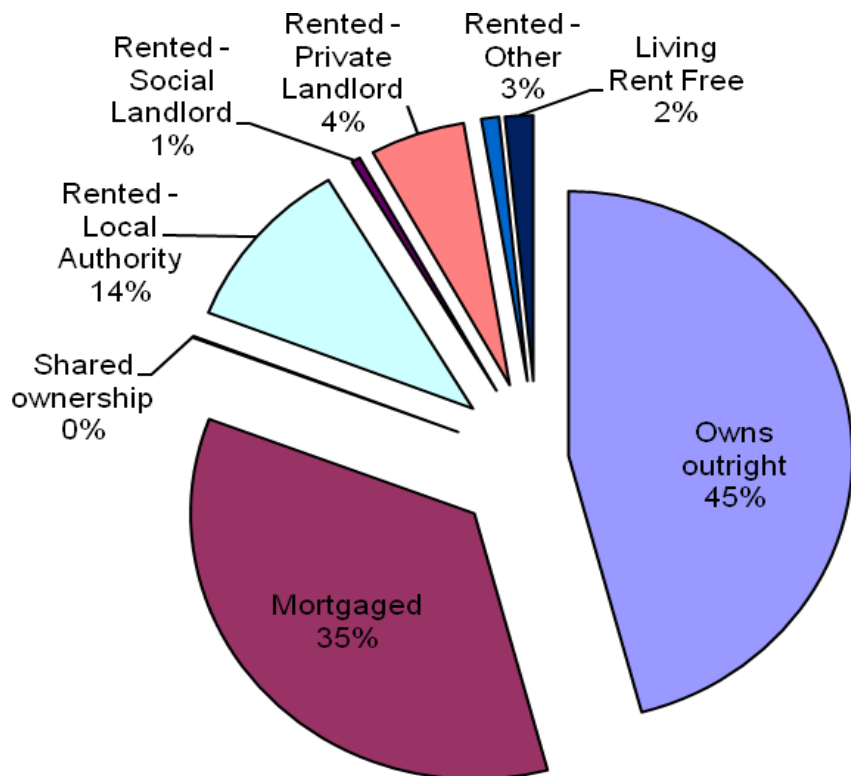
HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of detached and semi-detached houses which together make up just over 79% of all accommodation in Glyn. There is a larger proportion of terraced housing than flat, maisonette or apartments. The ward consists of 98 local authority owned properties and 5 Housing Association properties.

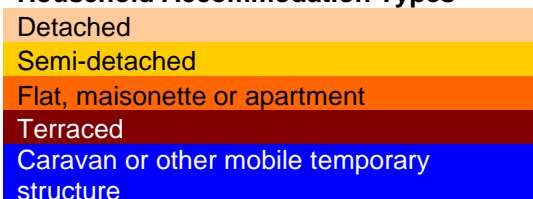

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Glyn, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £29,455 which is the 26th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 4.3% above the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in intermediate and lower supervisory and technical occupations (Levels 3 and 5).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Glyn** ranks as the 70th most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1066 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Glyn** is the Physical Environment domain, being ranked 49th in Carmarthenshire and 850 in Wales for this domain.
