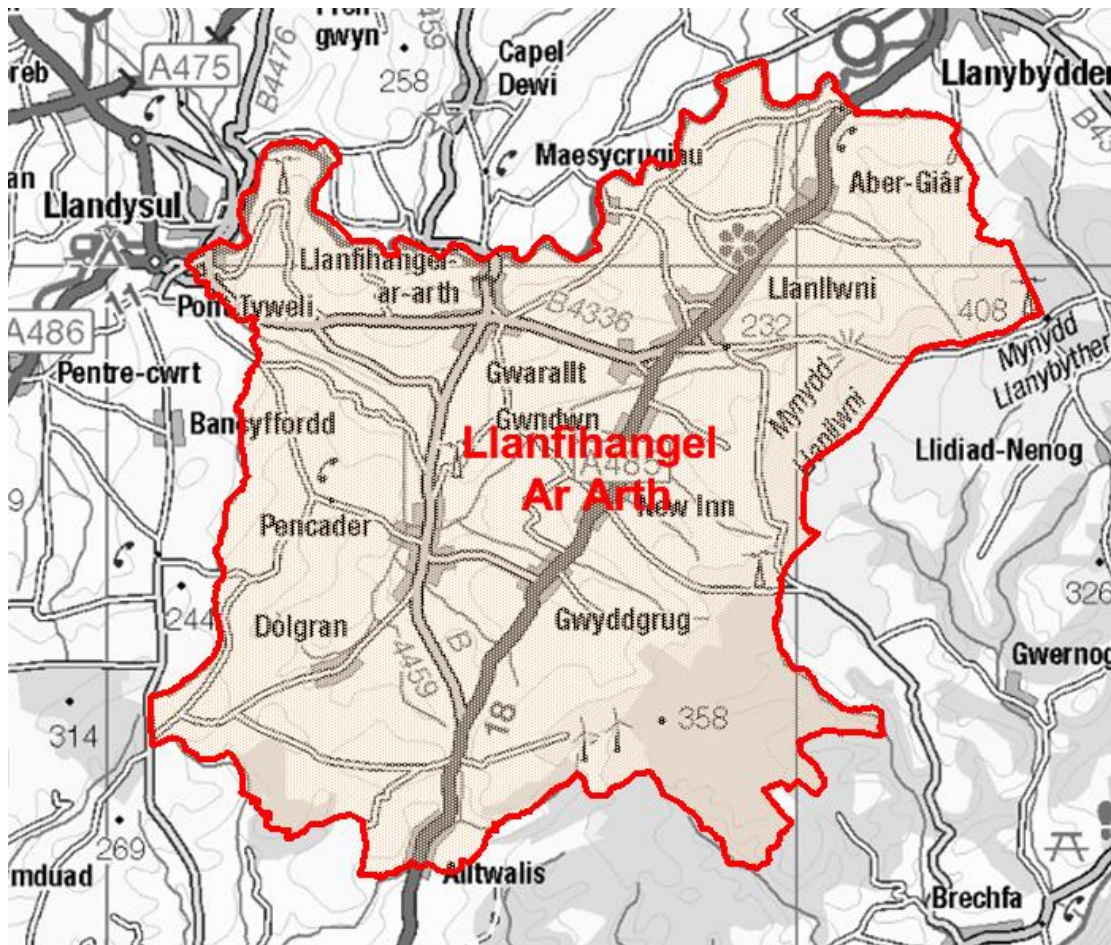

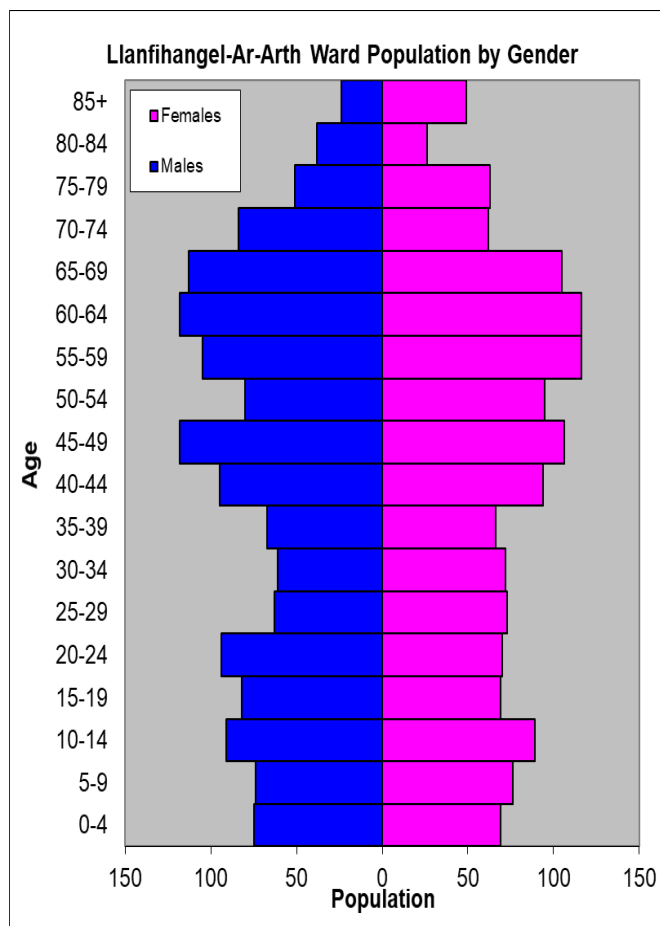

- ⇒ Slightly lower proportion of people with limiting long term illness than the Carmarthenshire average.
- ⇒ Higher proportion of Welsh Speakers than the Carmarthenshire average.

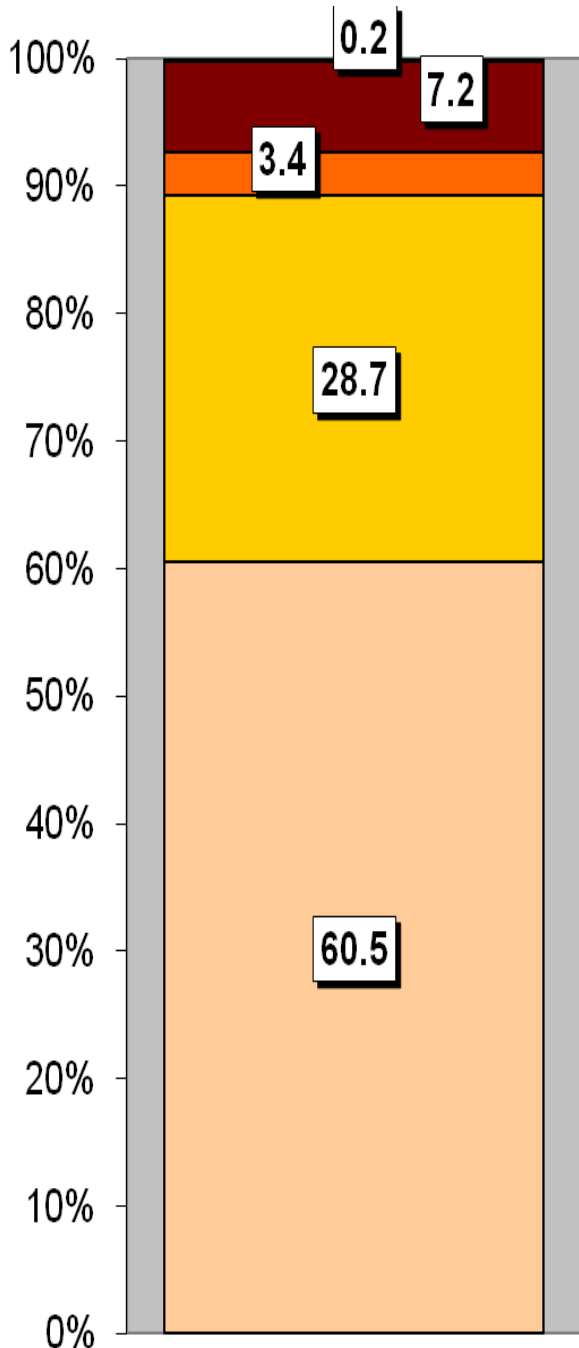

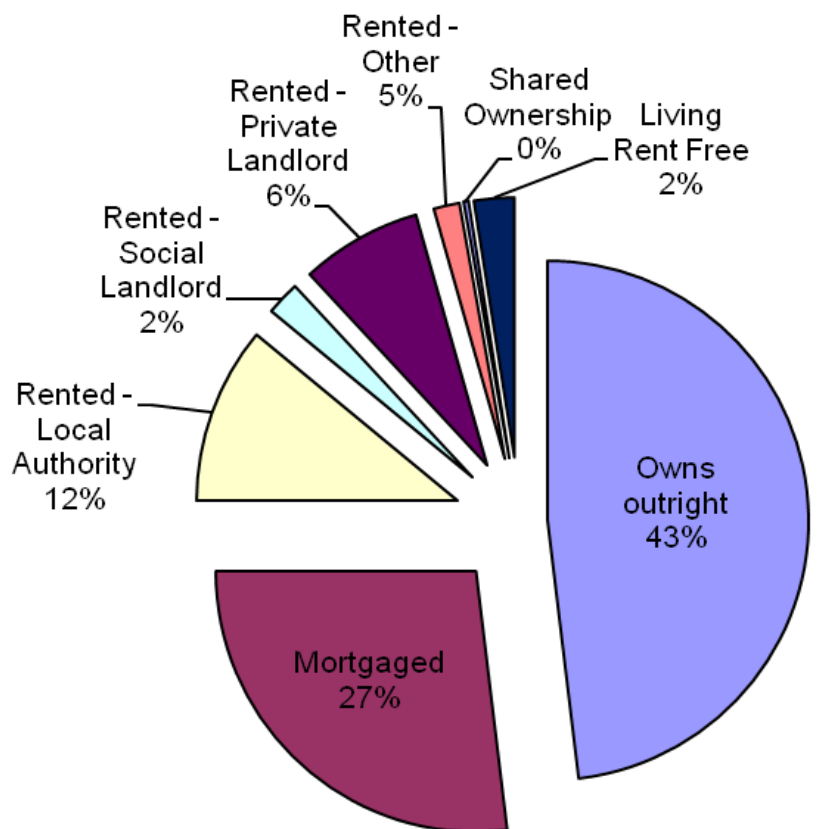
## HOUSING

The area's housing consists mostly of detached houses, which make up over 60% of the accommodation. There is a higher proportion of terraced accommodation than flat, maisonette and apartments. The ward consists of 134 local authority owned properties and 25 Housing Association properties.

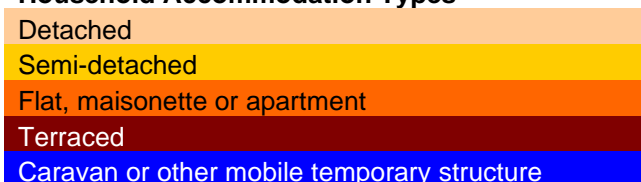

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llanfihangel-Ar-Arth, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £28,478 which is the 26<sup>th</sup> lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 1% above the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a lower than average level of people who have never worked and long term unemployed (Level 8) and a higher than average number of small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llanfihangel Ar Arth 1** ranks 36 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 673 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

**Llanfihangel Ar Arth 2** ranks 75 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1108 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llanfihangel Ar Arth 1** is the Housing domain, being ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 42 in Wales for this domain. In **Llanfihangel Ar Arth 2** the Access to Services domain is the most prominent ranking 14<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 104 in Wales.
