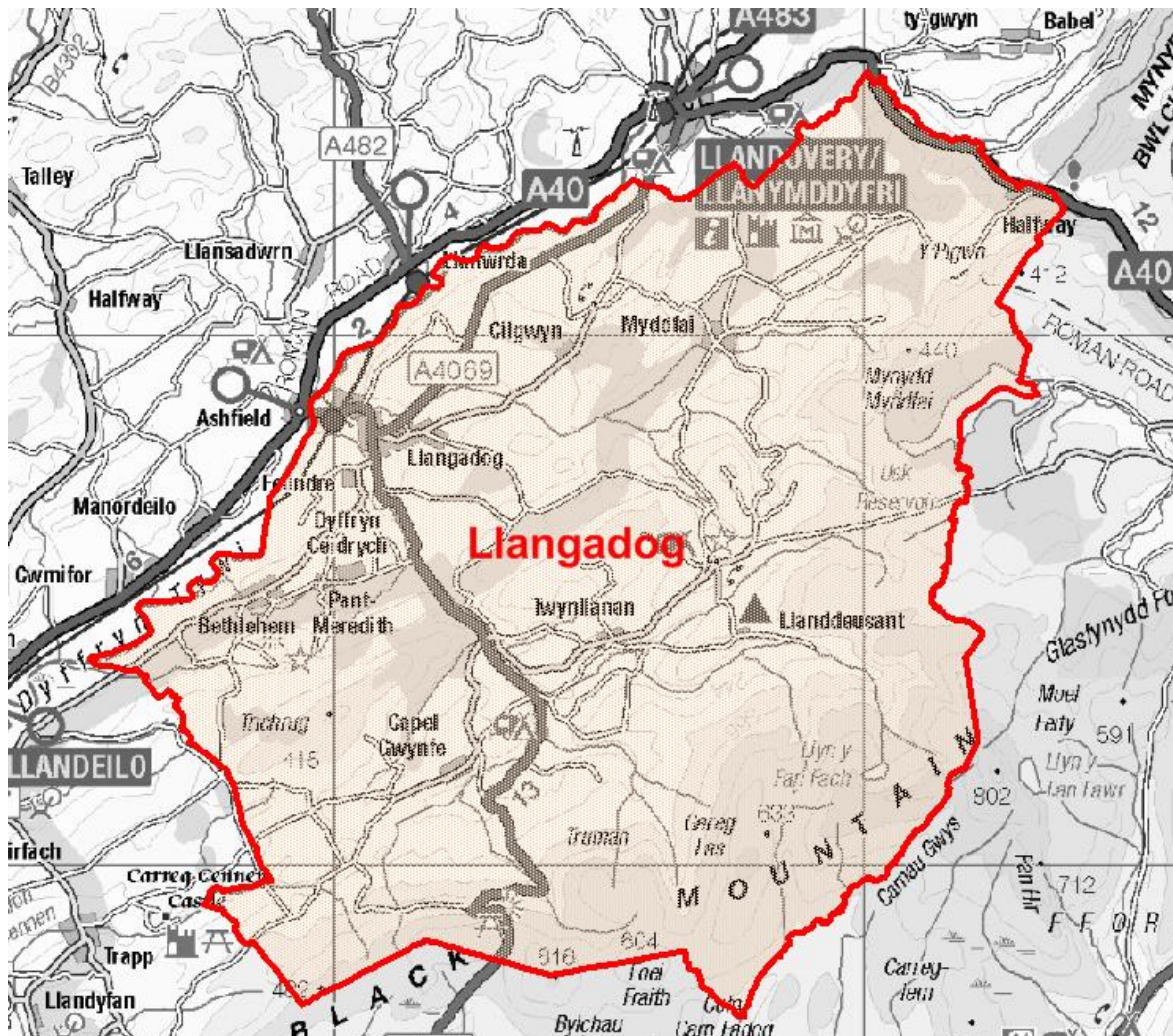

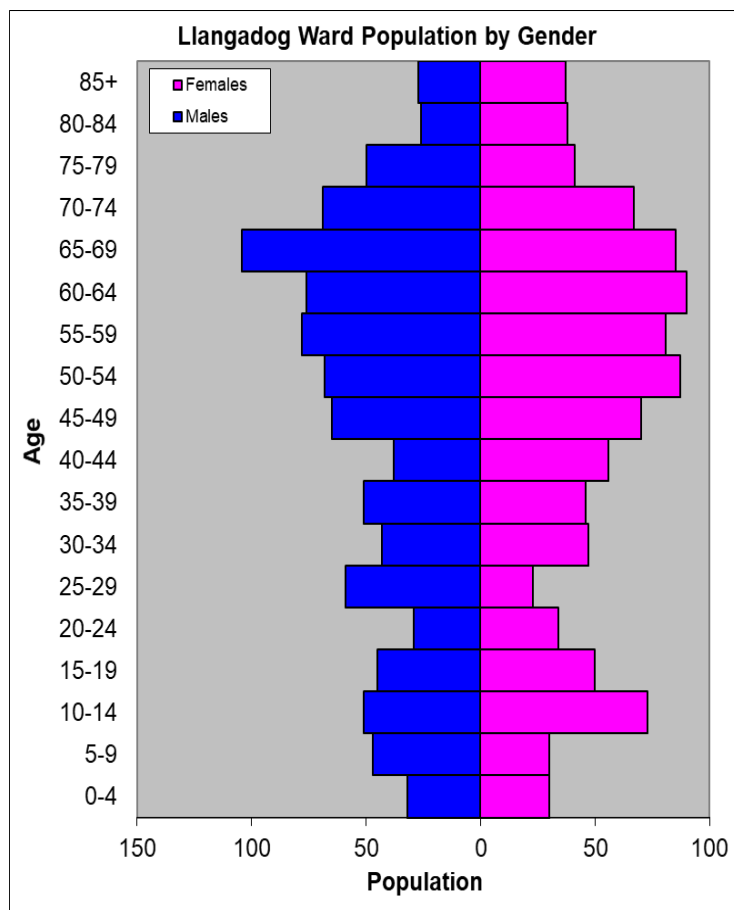

- ⇒ Higher proportion of Welsh Speakers than the Carmarthenshire average

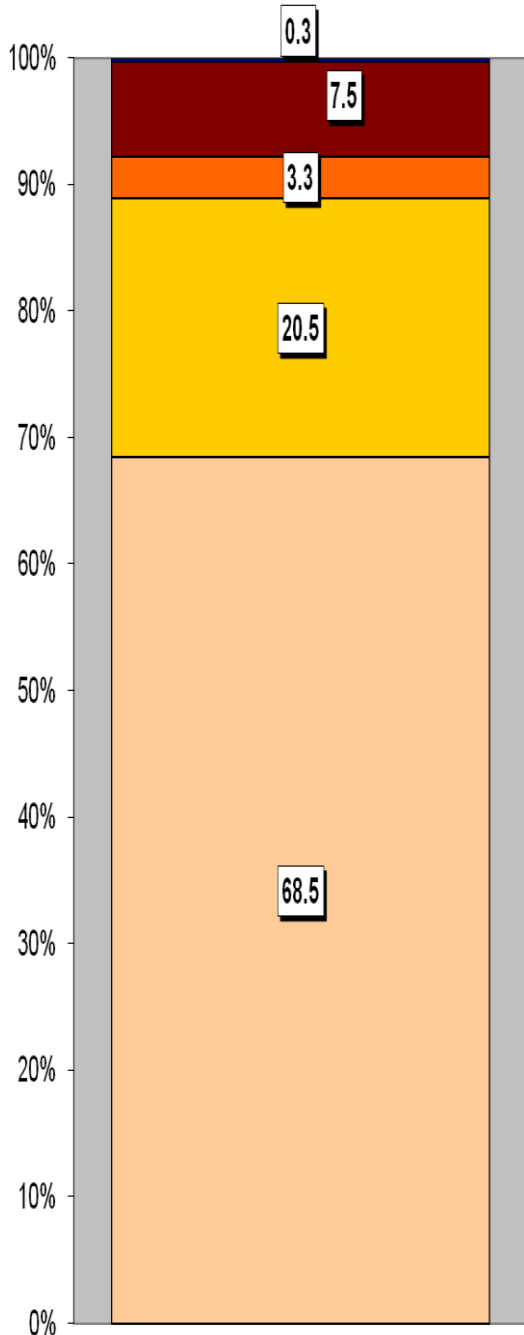

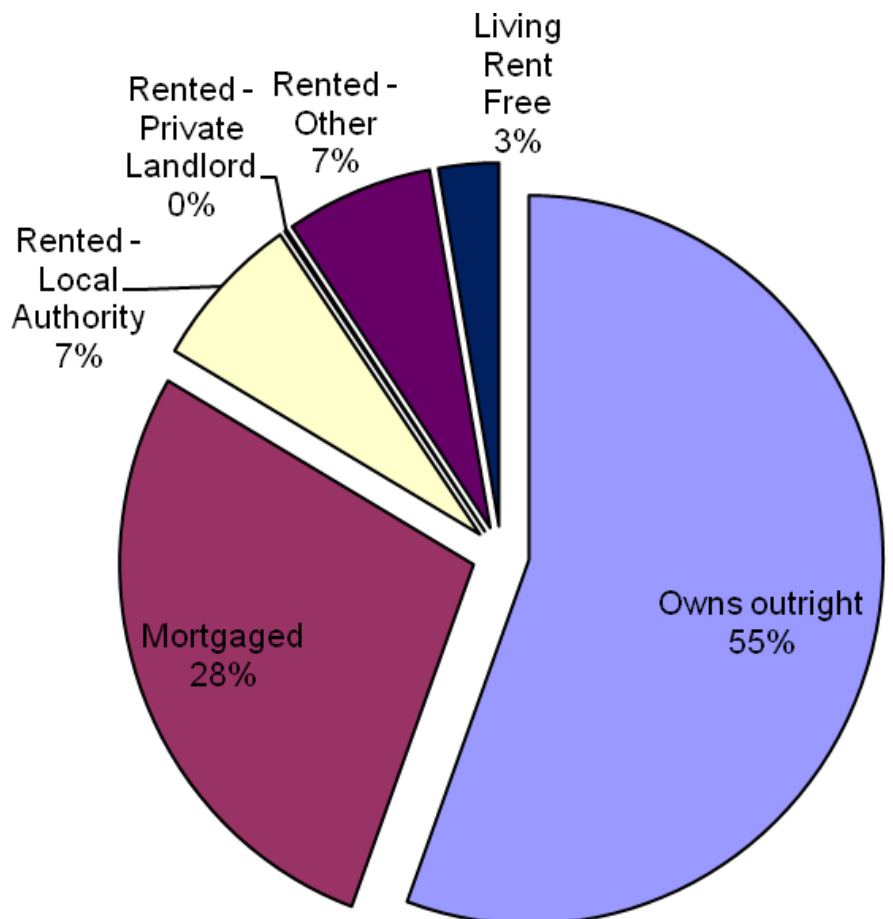
## HOUSING

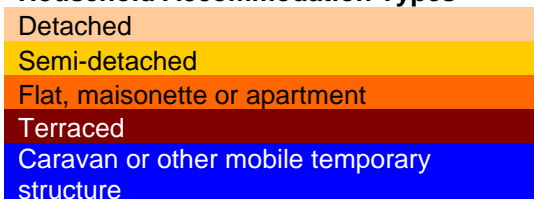

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llangadog, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £31,672 which is the 12<sup>th</sup> highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 11% above the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a lower than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi/routine occupations (Levels 5-7) and a higher than average proportion of small employers and own account workers (Level 4).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llangadog** ranks 53 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 883 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llangadog** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 6<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 32 in Wales for this domain.
