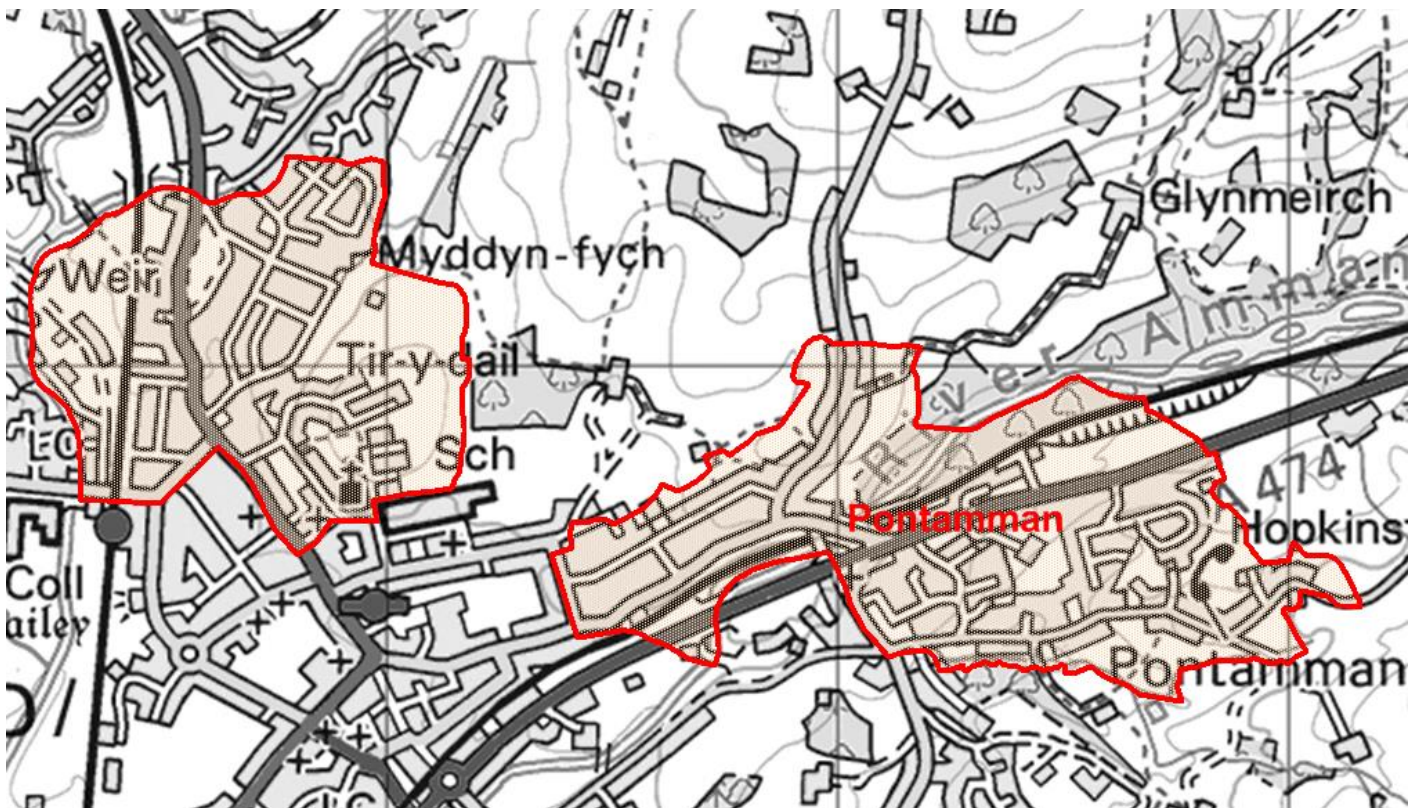

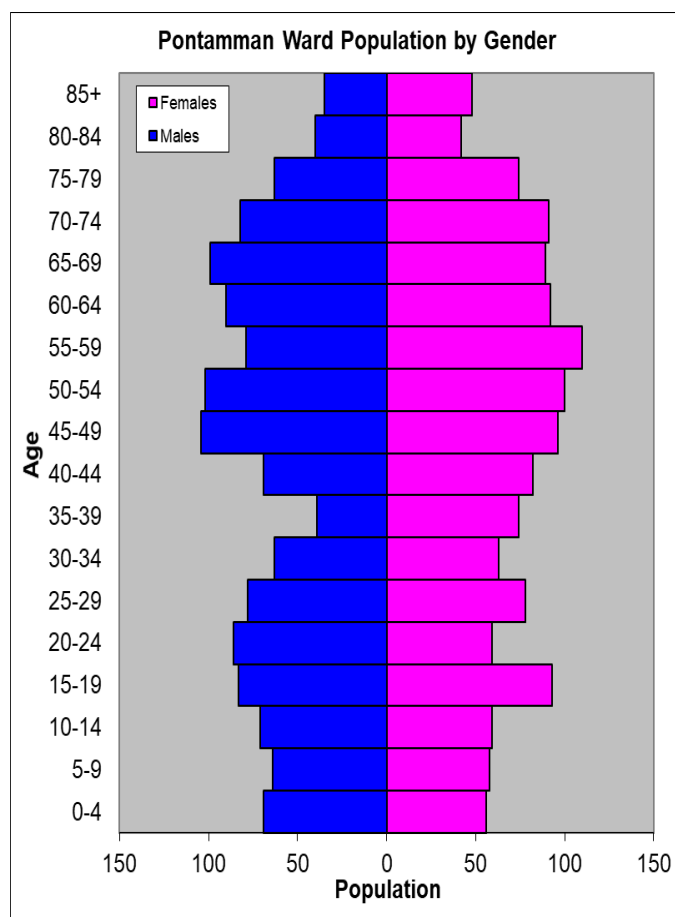

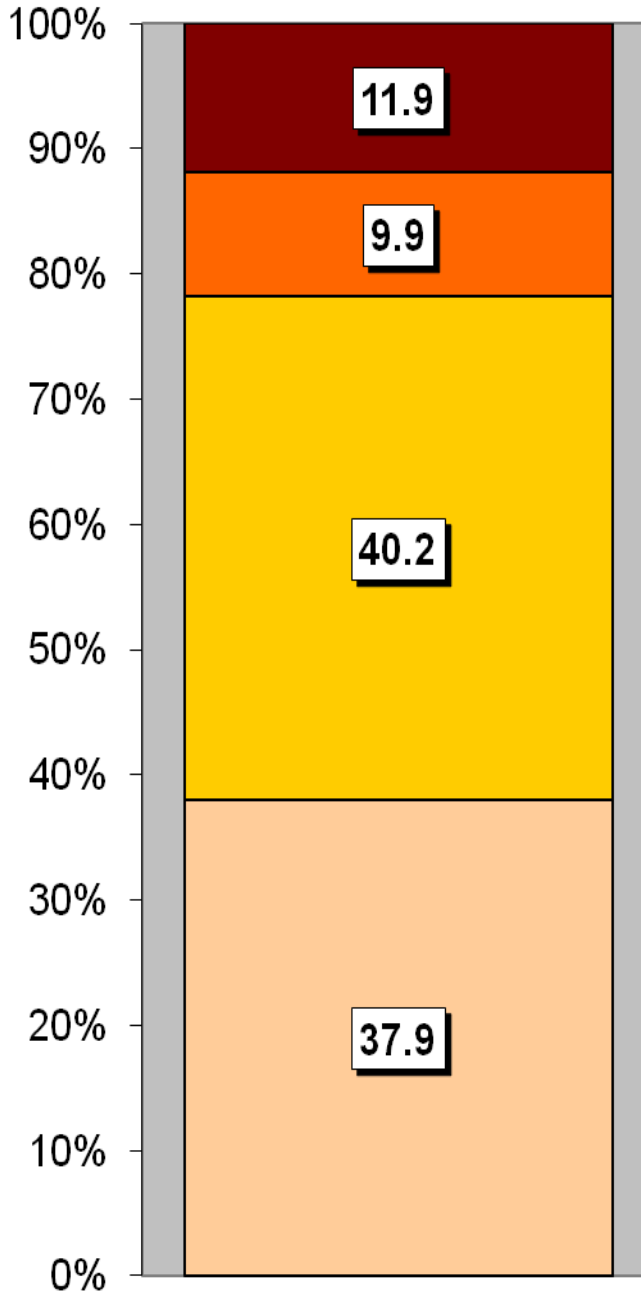

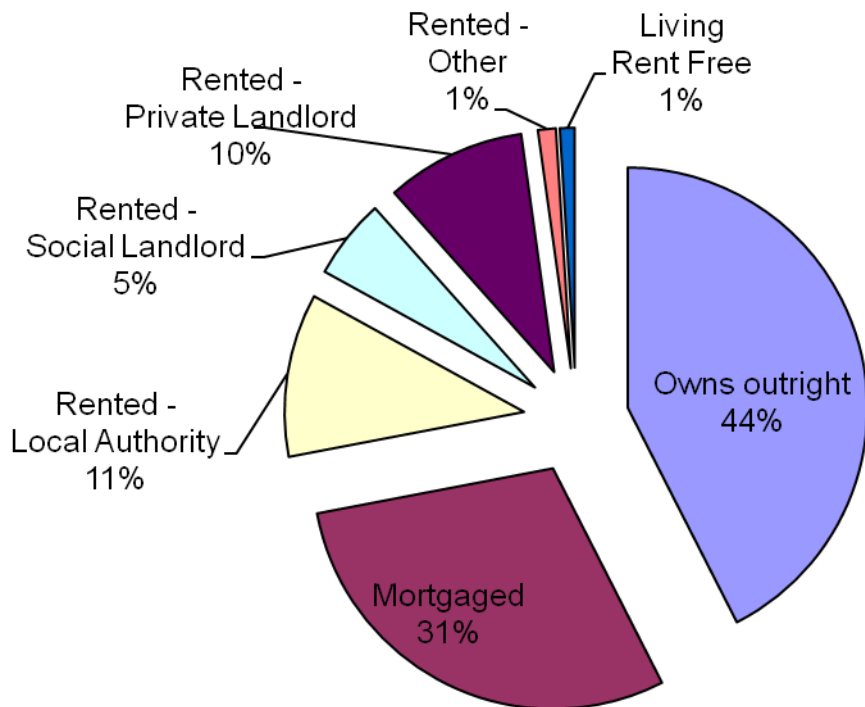
## HOUSING

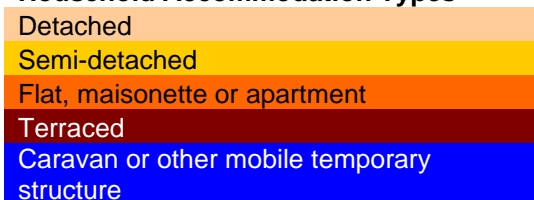

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Pontamman, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £28,326 which is the 24<sup>th</sup> lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 0.5% above the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in lower supervisory and technical occupations and semi/routine occupations (Levels 5-7).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.

Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Pontamman 1** ranks as the 22<sup>nd</sup> most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 494 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Pontamman 2** ranks 108 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1544 from 1909 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Pontamman 1** is the Employment domain, being ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 283 in Wales for this domain. In **Pontamman 2** the Physical Environment domain is the most prominent ranking 51 in Carmarthenshire and 862 in Wales.
