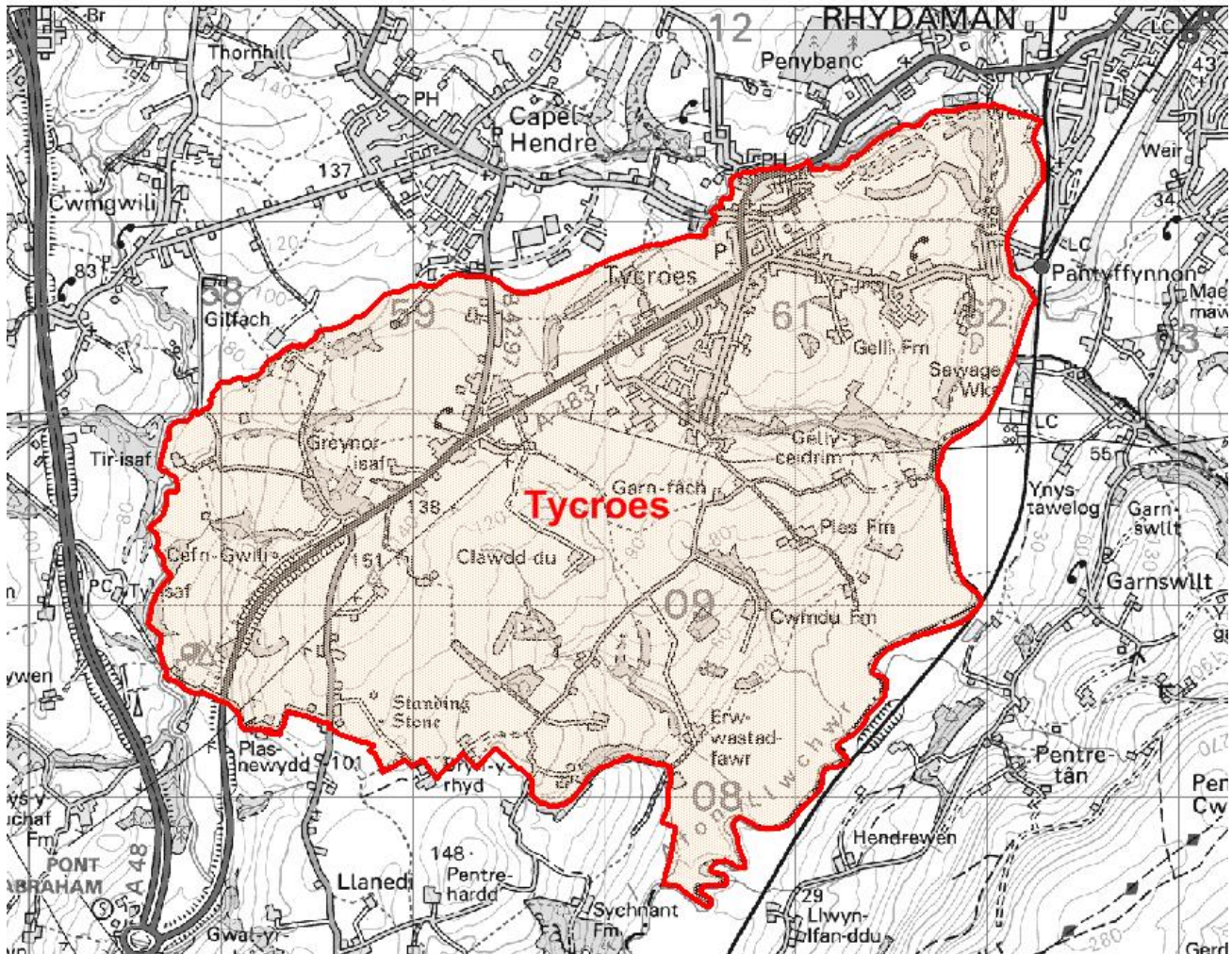

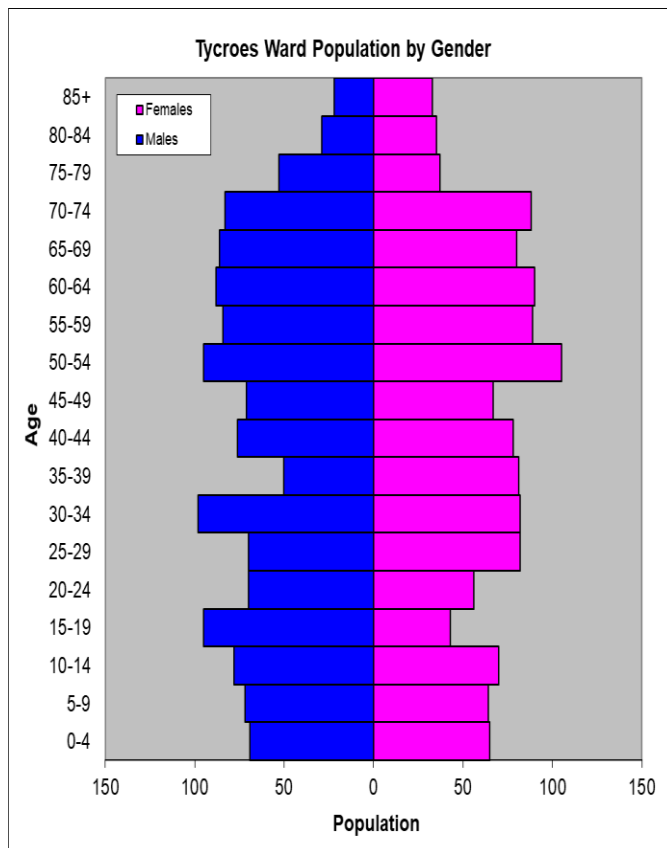

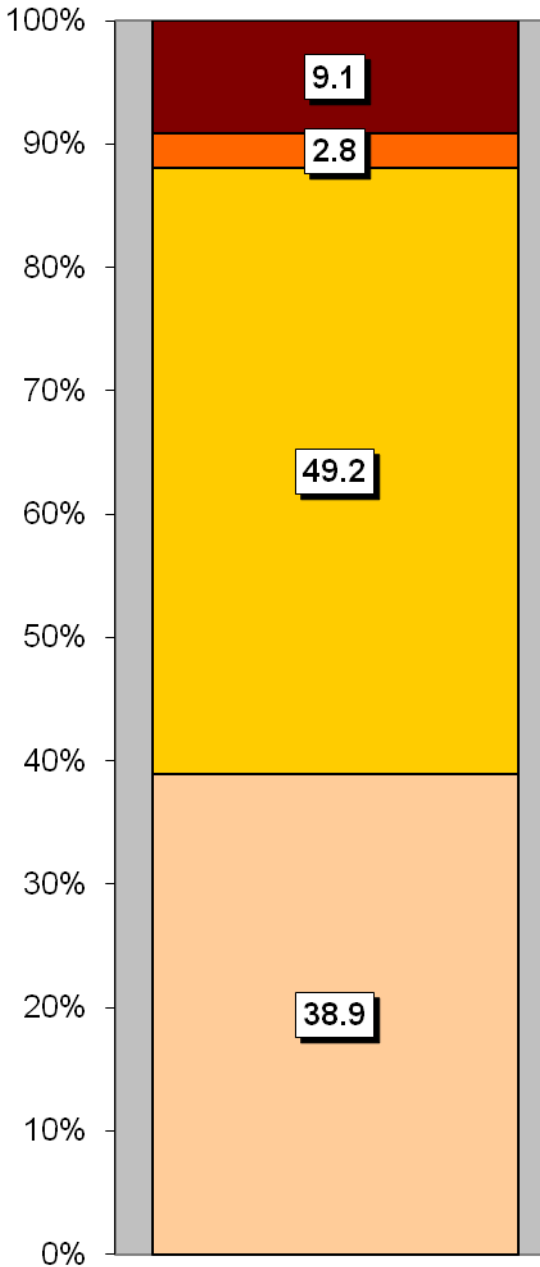

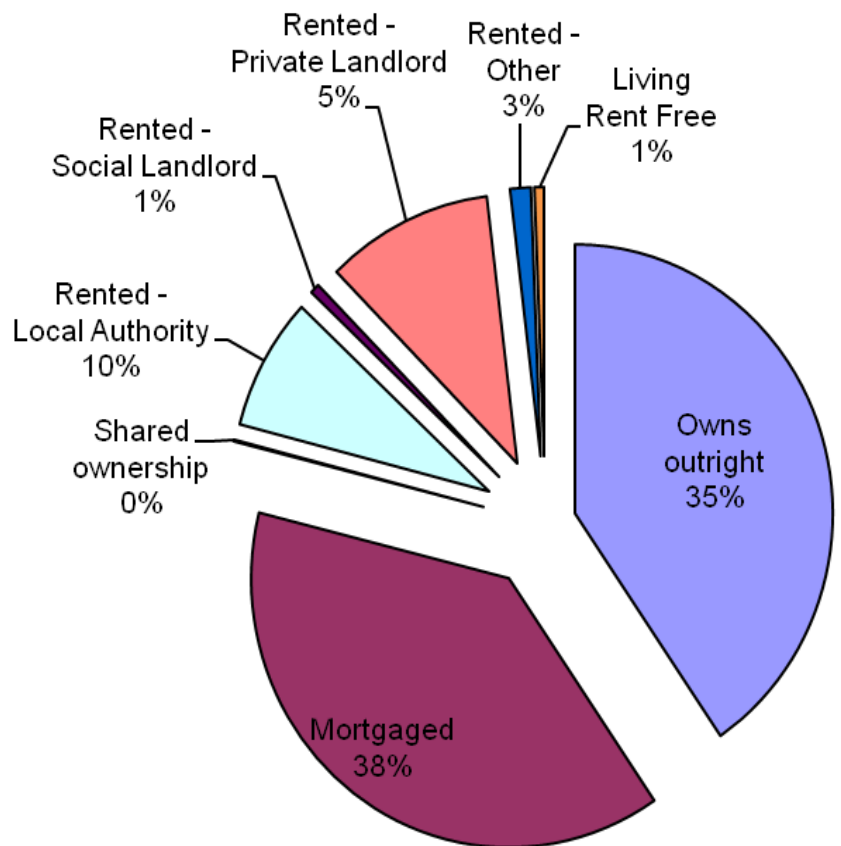
## HOUSING

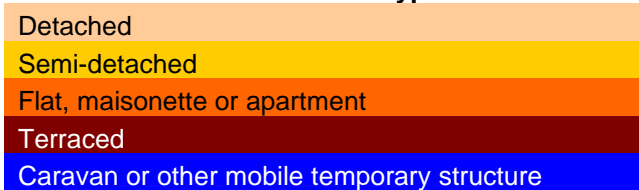

## SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Tycores, based on CACI's 2020 'PayCheck' data, is £30,581 which is the 18<sup>th</sup> highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 7.8% above the Carmarthenshire median of £28,186.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a high level of people in lower managerial and professional administrative occupations (Level 2) and intermediate occupations (Level 3) and a lower proportion of higher managerial and professional occupations (Level 1).

## WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2019 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2019 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Tycroes** ranks as the 94<sup>th</sup> most deprived area in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1296 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Tycroes** is the Education and Housing domains, being ranked 58<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 1003 and 898 respectively in Wales for these domains.
