NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 42 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 (the Act) and the School Organisation Code that Carmarthenshire County Council (the Council) having consulted such persons as required, propose to change the nature of Foundation Phase provision at Ysgol Y Felin, Ynyswen, Felinfoel, Llanelli, SA14 8BE from Dual Stream to Welsh Medium from 1 September 2022. The school is maintained by Carmarthenshire County Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note does not form part of the Notice but is offered by way of clarification)

1. It is the Authority's intention to change the nature of Foundation Phase provision at Ysgol Y Felin from Dual Stream to Welsh Medium.
