- Since the 2011 Census, there has been an increase of 18.9% in the number of people aged 65 years and over living in Carmarthenshire (45,400), and a decrease of 2.5% in people aged 15 to 64 years (112,100), and a decrease of 0.8% in children aged under 15 years (30,400).
