

STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURE FOR ACTIVE TRAVEL PURPOSES IN LLANGAIN

Carmarthenshire County Council intends to introduce a flat-top raised plateau road hump on the Class II, B4312 Llangain to Johnstown road, centred at a location approximately 10 metres west of its junction with the unclassified (U2137) road at Llangain.

Carmarthenshire County Council considers the measure to be necessary:

- a) in the interest of road safety; and
- b) to maintain low vehicle speeds within residential areas, areas of walked routes to school and in the vicinity of proposed and existing uncontrolled pedestrian crossing points.
