

What does WeITAG mean?

WeITAG (Welsh Transport Appraisal Guidance) is the Welsh Government's approach for planning and assessing transport projects. It helps understand what a transport problem is, explore different ways of addressing it and ensure that investment delivers real benefits for people and communities. WeITAG follows a series of stages:

Stage 1 - Strategic Outline Case

Identifies the problem, sets objectives and confirms the scheme fits with wider policies.

Stage 2 - Outline Business Case

Develops options, assesses impacts and selects a preferred way forward.

Stage 3 - Full Business Case

Provides detailed design, full appraisal and confirms the scheme is deliverable and offers value for money.

Stage 4 - Implementation

The scheme is delivered, with monitoring of costs, programme and outcomes.

Stage 5 - Post Implementation Review

Evaluates whether the scheme achieved its objectives and captures lessons for future projects.
