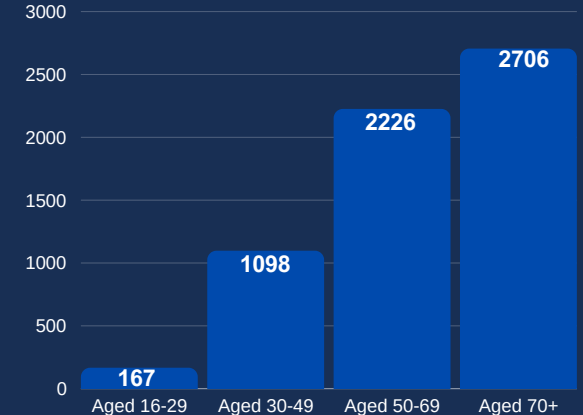
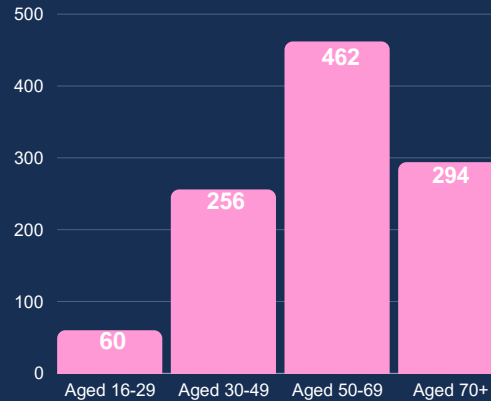

Economically Inactive
