

STATEMENT OF REASONS

PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN LLANELLI

Carmarthenshire County Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures in the form of raised plateau road humps at various locations in Llanelli.

Carmarthenshire County Council considers the measure to be necessary in the interests of road safety, by:

- a) making it easier and safer for pedestrians and cyclists (particularly individuals with a disability) to cross, by eliminating the height difference to the carriageway;
and
- b) slowing turning traffic and encouraging vehicular traffic to give way, thereby prioritising pedestrian safety.
