THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (YR C3201 LLANGLYDWEN (HEBRON TO CEFNPANT) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

WHEREAS the Carmarthenshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the Highway Authority for that length of the C3201 Llanglydwen (Hebron to Cefnpant) from a point 400 metres south of its junction with the C3208 (Hebron to Blaenwaun) for a distance of 100m in a southerly direction, are satisfied that traffic in the said length of road should be restricted by reason of the works proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW therefore the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of the Unclassified Road known as the C3201 Llanglydwen (Hebron to Cefnpant) from a point 400 metres south of its junction with the C3208 (Hebron to Blaenwaun) for a distance of 100m in a southerly direction.
- This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-First day of July Two Thousand and Twenty-Five and may be cited as The County of Carmarthenshire (Unclassified Road – C3201 Llanglydwen (Hebron to Cefnpant)) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2025.
