STATEMENT OF REASONS

The County of Carmarthenshire (Imposition of 50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2025

The purpose of this Traffic Regulation Order is to introduce a 50mph speed limit on selected sections of the highway network where the current national speed limit (60mph) is considered inappropriate due to road safety concerns and to support active travel objectives.

Analysis of traffic collision data and speed surveys has identified that vehicle speeds on the affected roads are often excessive for the road conditions, particularly in areas with limited visibility, sharp bends or junctions. Reducing the speed limit to 50mph is expected to lower the risk and severity of collisions, thereby improving safety for all road users.

Several of the roads included in this Order are used by pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians. A lower speed limit would create a safer and more comfortable environment for these vulnerable road users, especially where footways or segregated paths are absent or limited.

The following locations have been identified for the proposed speed limit reduction to 50mph:
