Part I

Road Hump with a Raised Plateau

Centred at a location along the B4459 road in Pencader 45 metres north of its junction with Glanawmor Road.

The proposed new road hump will extend across the full width of the carriageway and will be in the form of a flat-top raised plateau. The plateau will measure at least 6000 millimetres (6 metres) in length, and 75 millimetres in height in line with the tolerances permitted in the Regulations (where a hump shall not exceed 100 millimetres in maximum height).

Part II

Tapered Road Hump with a Round Top

Centred at a location along the B4459 road in Pencader 45 metres south of its junction with Glanawmor Road.

The proposed new road hump will be a round top tapered hump, which is not completely kerb-to-kerb. The curved top profile will measure at least 3700 millimetres (3.7 metres) in length, and 75 millimetres in height in line with the tolerances permitted in the Regulations (where a hump shall not exceed 100 millimetres in maximum height).
