

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

### **REMOVAL OF EXISTING SPEED CUSHIONS AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW ROAD HUMPS – B4459, PENCADER**

Carmarthenshire County Council intends to:

- a) remove the existing speed cushion centred at a location along the B4459 road in Pencader 45 metres north of its junction with Glanawmor Road and replace it with a new flat-top raised plateau road hump which will extend across the full width of the carriageway; and
- b) remove the existing speed cushion centred at a location along the B4459 road in Pencader 45 metres south of its junction with Glanawmor Road and replace it with a tapered road hump with a round top which is not completely kerb-to-kerb.

The proposed alternative traffic calming measures are intended to lower vehicle speeds and improve overall road safety. The raised plateau road hump will also incorporate a controlled, signalised crossing to provide a safer and more accessible crossing point for pedestrians.
