Census 2021 – The Welsh Language in Carmarthenshire



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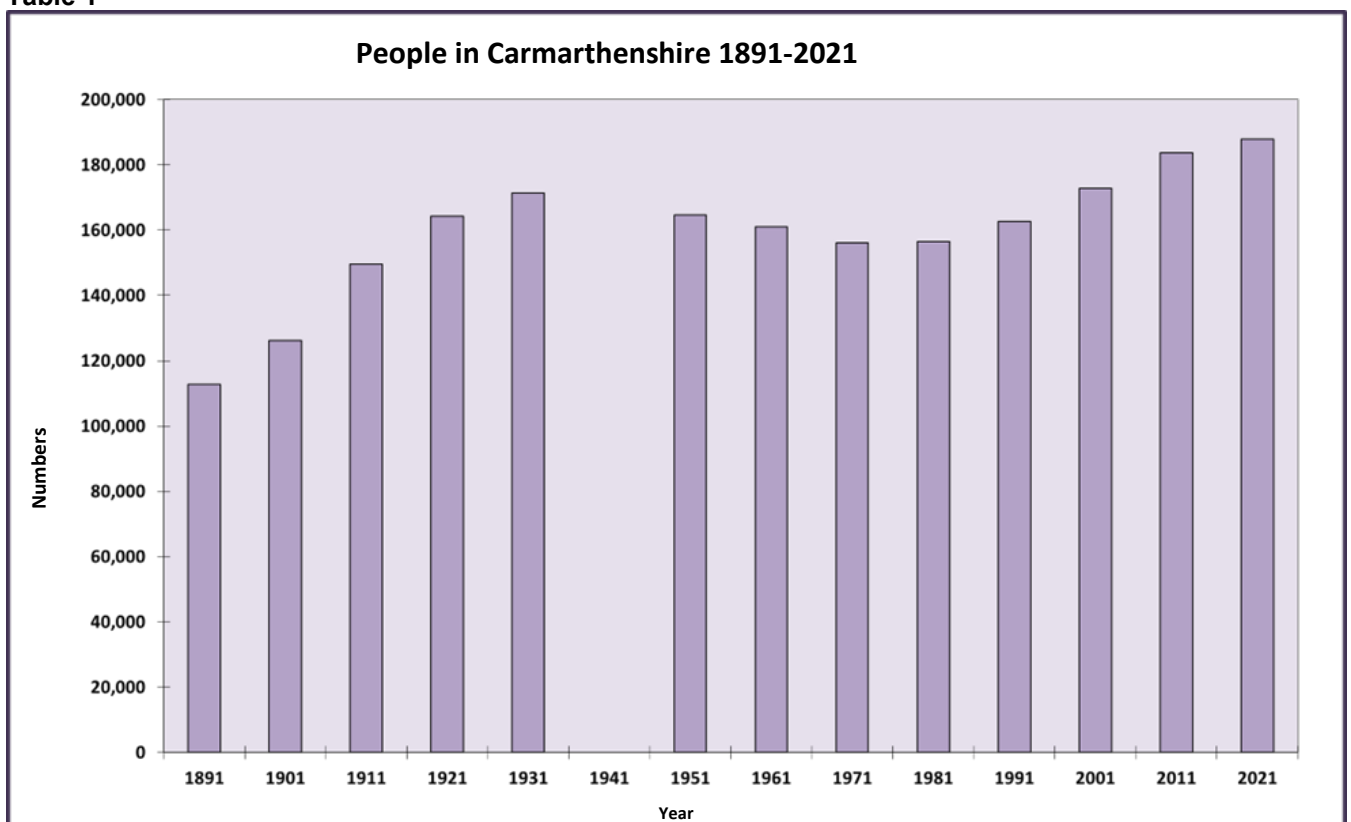
Introduction

The census is the most important source of information relating to the number, distribution and condition of the population in Wales. As well as being a mirror to the demographic, social and economic changes facing our communities, decade by decade, it is also an extremely important basis for public policy planning and service delivery into the years ahead.

It was in 1891 that information about the Welsh language began to be compiled for the first time in the census and, except in 1941 during the distressing years of the Second World War, more detailed, more comprehensive, and more sophisticated data about the Welsh language and its speakers was published every ten years from then.

In recent decades of the census has shown a steady increase in population in Carmarthenshire, starting from the economic boom of the 1980s with a population of 156,484 reaching to 187,897 in 2021, a 20% increase. Since the 2011 census, Carmarthenshire's population has grown by just over 4,000 (2.2%) to 187,897.

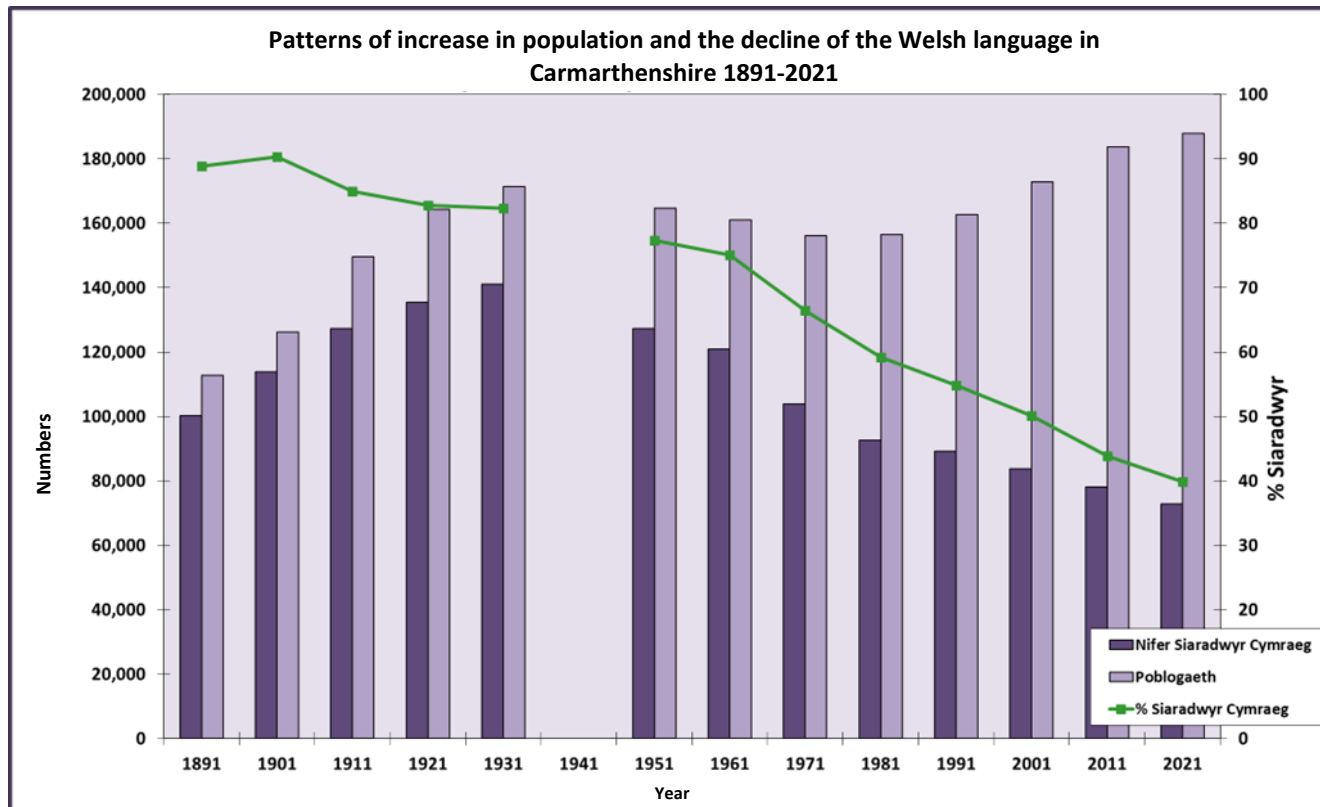

Section 1 - Welsh Speakers

Despite the continued increase in population in Carmarthenshire, the number and percentage of Welsh speakers continues to fall. This is also the case for Wales, with the only local authorities to see an increase in the numbers of people able to speak Welsh are Cardiff, Vale of Glamorgan, Rhondda Cynon Taf and Merthyr Tydfil.

The 2021 Census indicates that Carmarthenshire is home to 72,838 Welsh speakers. This translates to 39.9% of the county's total population.

This figure has **decreased by 5,210** since the last Census in 2011, which translates to a percentage point decrease of 4.0. This is the largest percentage point decrease of all local authorities in Wales.

In 2001 and 2011, Carmarthenshire had the highest number of Welsh speakers of all local authorities in Wales, with 84,196 and 78,048 Welsh speakers respectively. These new figures mean that the county now has the second highest number of Welsh speakers of all local authorities in Wales.

Carmarthenshire remains the fourth highest in terms of the percentage of the population that are able to speak Welsh.

Welsh Speakers at Ward level

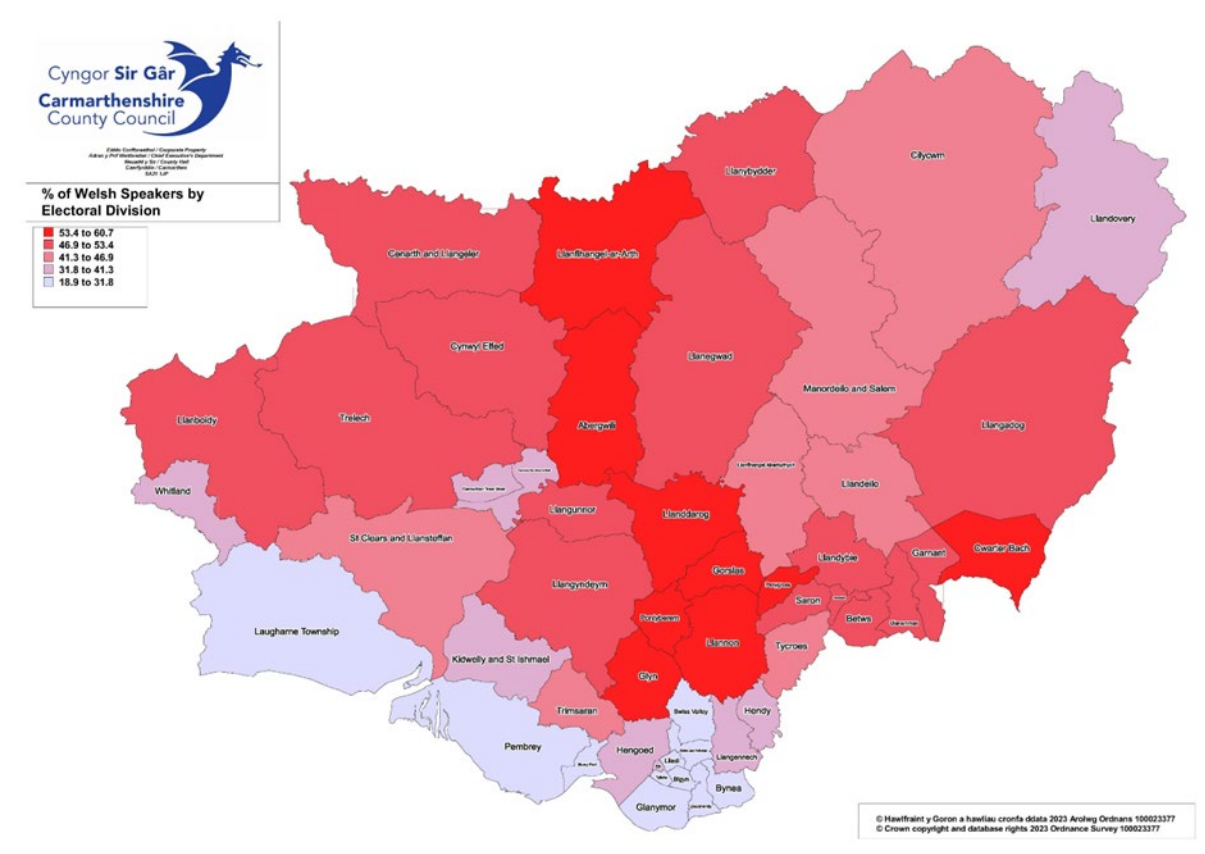
Due to Local Authority Electoral Boundary changes in July 2021, it is not possible to compare census data at Ward level between 2021 to 2011.

The percentage of Welsh speakers at Ward level shows that only one Ward area has over 60% of residents (aged 3 and over) that can speak Welsh. This is Pontyberem with 60.7%, followed by Cwarter Bach with 59.4% and Gorslas with 58.4%. The lowest figures (under 20%) is Tyisha with 18.9% and Glanymor with 19.2%.

Welsh Speakers at LSOA (Lower Super Output Area) Level

Data at LSOA level can be compared with 2011 census which shows that the majority of the 111 LSOA's saw a reduction in the percentage of Welsh speakers, with only eight either remaining the same or showing a slight increase. Four areas show a decrease of 10 percentage points or more, these are: - Glanaman 1, Glanaman 2, Llangyndeyrn 1 and Llanybydder 2.

Welsh Language by Age Group

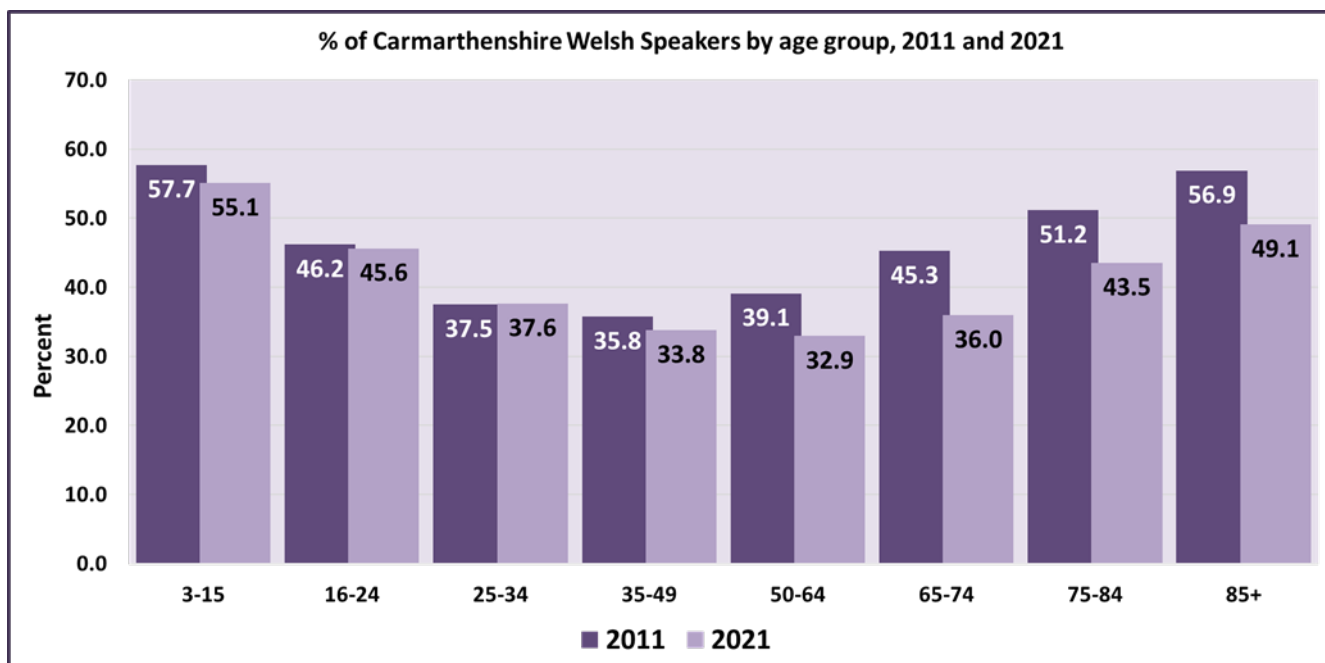
All local authorities saw a decrease in the percentage of children aged 3 to 15 reported as being able to speak Welsh between 2011 and 2021.

At a national level it is thought that the decrease in both the number and percentage of people aged three years or older able to speak Welsh is mainly driven by a fall among children and young people who reported as being able to speak Welsh.

In Carmarthenshire there has been a reduction of just over 500 aged 3-15 able to speak Welsh, this translates to a percentage point decrease of 2.6.

The only age group that has seen a very slight increase are those aged 25-34, with decreases visible within all other age categories. The most significant reduction in people able to speak to Welsh are for those aged 65-74, with a 9.4 percentage point decrease. This is also the age group which has the highest % of people born outside of Wales with 34.3%.

Dependent children (aged 3 - 18) that can speak Welsh, by family type and Welsh speaking parent(s)

The number of dependent children (aged 3-18) that can speak Welsh in Carmarthenshire has reduced from 18,281 in 2011 to 17,553 in 2021.

Changes in the proportion of Welsh speaking dependents aged 3 to 18 based on their family set up in 2021 compared to 2011, show an increase in those living with a couple where both speak Welsh, when split to two age groups of 3 -11 and 12-18 years, 3-11 years show an increase and a reduction in the 12 to 18 yrs.

Surprisingly there's a slight increase in the proportion of Welsh speakers in all age categories living with a couple where neither are able to speak Welsh but a decline when living with a single parent that cannot speak Welsh.

Welsh speakers by Occupation

At County level (Occupation)

The 2021 Census shows the highest number and percentage of Welsh speakers in Carmarthenshire are within the **Professional occupations**. This is a change from the 2011 Census, where Skilled trades occupations were the highest, this area has seen a 2.3 percentage point reduction between 2011 and 2021.

At Ward level (By Occupation) (Appendix B)

The 2021 Census shows us that the highest percentage of Welsh speakers (aged 16 years and over in employment) per Ward are split over three occupation categories, with the majority in **Professional occupations** followed by **Skilled trades occupations** and the **Caring, leisure and other service occupations**, this is in-line with the split at County level (above). The table below shows the Ward with the highest percentage in these three categories and the Wards with the highest number. Full details can be seen in Appendix B.

At LSOA level (By Occupation)

A snapshot based on the occupation breakdown shows that Gorslas 2 has the highest number of Welsh speakers in five out of the nine occupation categories. This is not surprising as Gorslas 1 has the highest number of Welsh speakers aged 3 and over in the County with 1,467 (61.1% of the 3+ population), and Gorslas 2 has the second highest number with 1,399 (55.8%).

Welsh speakers by Industry

At County level (By Industry)

As in 2011, the 2021 Census shows the highest number and percentage of Welsh speakers in Carmarthenshire are within **Public administration, education, and health industries**. This industry area has also seen the highest percentage change, with a 4.4 percentage point increase from 38.2% in 2011 to 42.6%. The highest percentage point reduction of 2.7 is in the Distribution, hotels and restaurants industries from 19.2% to 16.5%.

At Ward level (By Industry)

The 2021 Census shows us that **Public administration, education and health industries** have the highest percentage of Welsh speakers (aged 16 years and over in employment) for all Carmarthenshire Wards other than Cilycwm, Llangadog and Trelech Wards, where the highest percentage of Welsh speakers are in the **Agriculture, energy and water industries**.

A full breakdown of Welsh speakers by Industry at Ward level is available in Appendix D.

At LSOA level (By Industry)

A snapshot based on the industry breakdown shows that almost 60% of Welsh speakers aged 16 years and over in employment in the Elli 1 area work in the Public administration, education and health industry area. Again, as in the data by occupation, Gorslas features strongly in the highest number in most of the industry categories as they have the highest numbers of Welsh speakers aged 3 and over in the County.

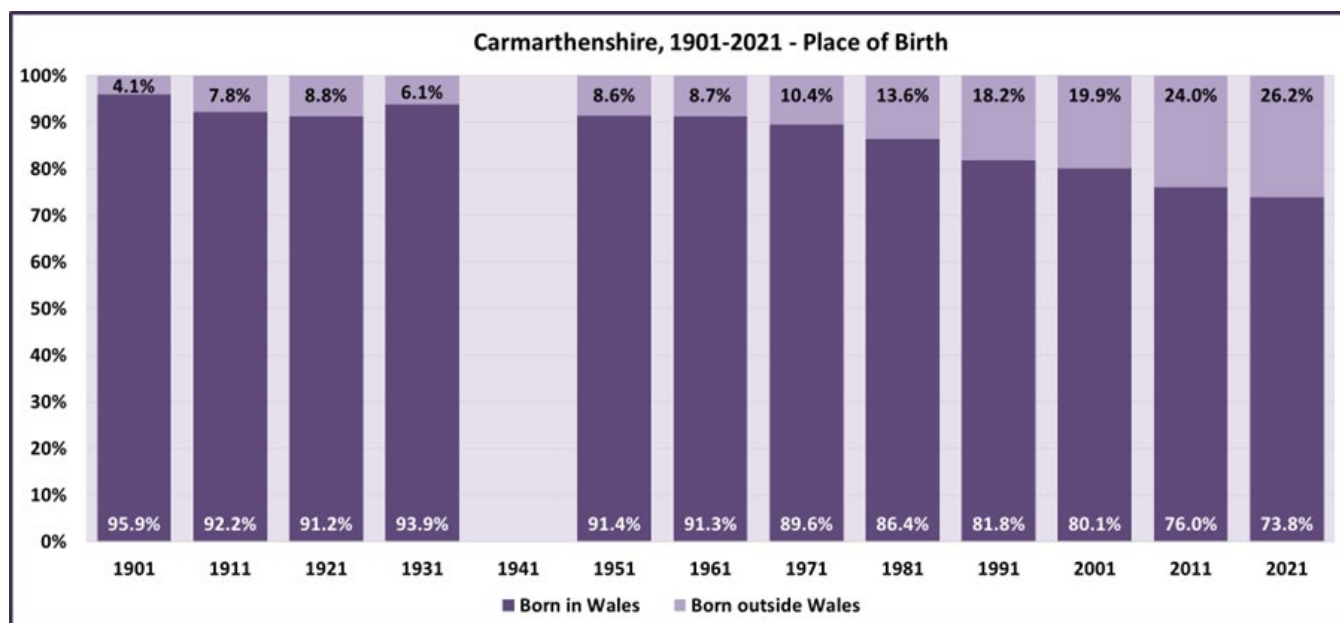

Section 2 - Possible Contributors

Over a quarter (26.2%) of people that now live in Carmarthenshire were born outside of Wales, with 20.2% of those born in England. There has been a decrease in the proportion of Welsh-born people living in the county since the last census with a decrease of 2.2 percentage points. The highest age group of people born outside of Wales is 65 to 74 years, coincidentally this is the age group that has seen the most significant reduction in people able to speak to Welsh.

Of the Welsh speakers in Carmarthenshire, 82.3% identify themselves as Welsh only, with 7.6% as Welsh and British only.

The percentage of people that have moved to Carmarthenshire from within other areas of the UK and outside the UK in 2021 has increased by 166% since the 2011 census.

Section 3 - Welsh Language Skills

74,355 people living in the county reported that they have no skills in Welsh during the 2011 Census. This level has increased over the last ten years to 85,287 or 4.8 percentage points.

The number of people able to speak, read and write Welsh in the county has decreased by 1.9 percentage points or 1,828 people. This is a considerably lower decrease than the figures for those only able to speak Welsh.

Welsh skills for Carmarthenshire veterans

From the 7,278 that responded to this question almost 60% of veterans in Carmarthenshire do not have any combinations of skills in the Welsh language.

Section 4 – Understands Welsh Only

The 2021 census asked respondents about their Welsh skills in detail, one of those specific skills being “understands Welsh only”.

Results show that 10.96% (20,036) of people in Carmarthenshire responded that they could “understand spoken Welsh only”. This is above the Welsh average of 5.20% but shows a 0.7 percentage point decrease when compared to the 2011 census result of 11.66% (20,716). This could be in line with the decrease in Welsh skills that we have seen in the most recent census.

Ward level statistics are not comparable between 2011 and 2021. However, in 2021 the Swiss Valley Ward had the highest proportion of residents who could understand Welsh only at 14.59%. (354), compared to 29.78% stating they could speak Welsh. Although more residents in this ward can speak Welsh compared to only understanding the language, Swiss Valley was the 10th lowest ward in Carmarthenshire for proportion of Welsh speakers to residents. This tells us that those less likely to speak Welsh are more likely to understand the language. Furthermore, the electoral ward with the lowest proportion of those who understand Welsh only was Llanfihangel-ar-Arth with 6.92%. However, this ward ranked the 9th highest for Welsh speakers, with 53.4%. This translates to 1,436 out of 2,689 residents being able to speak Welsh. This indicates that those with a lower proportion of residents that can understand Welsh, are likely to have higher levels of those that can speak Welsh.

In 2021, the LSOA De Tref Caerfyrddin 2 had the highest percentage of people who could understand Welsh only at 15.95%. This translates to 274 people out of 1,718 living this LSOA. However, in 2011 the highest % for this Welsh skill was 16.91% in Rhydaman 1.

A similar pattern can be seen with the lowest percentages, with 2021's lowest percentage being lower than those recorded in 2011. In 2011 the lowest percentage at LSOA level was 6.21% in Llanybydder 2. However, in 2021 the lowest percentage fell to 5.84% and was in Llangeler 2. Although there is no correlation between which LSOA's are receiving the lowest percentage, it is notable that the overall percentages are lower in 2021 than in 2011 for both highest and lowest. This illustrates the all-round decline in Welsh language skills within the county.

From the 2021 data, 35 out of the 111 (32%) LSOA's have seen **increases** in the percentage of people who can understand Welsh only, these increases varied from 3.55 percentage points in Llanybydder 2 to 0.02 in Cynwyl Elfed 1.

The table below compares the 35 LSOA's which have exhibited an **increase** in the proportion of residents that are able to **understand Welsh only**, alongside the percentage change in **Welsh speakers** for the same LSOA. All LSOA's that saw increases in the proportion of those that understand Welsh only, saw a decrease in Welsh speakers.

The other 75 (68%) of LSOA's saw a **decrease** in the proportion of residents who could understand Welsh only in 2021. The table below shows the five LSOA's with the biggest decrease, from Glanymor 1 with a 4.22 percentage point reduction, followed by Rhydaman 1 with a decrease of 3.75 percentage points. Identifying the LSOA's with the largest decline in people who can understand Welsh only allow us to target interventions in the areas of most need.

The age group in Carmarthenshire with the highest percentage that could understand Welsh only was the 50–64 age group, this equates to 3.12% (5,368). Whereas the lowest was 15-and-under at 7.89% (2,148 people). This low percentage could be because a proportion of those aged under 15 are still developing their Welsh skills.

It is a cause for concern that those who are 15-and-under exhibit the lowest proportion of those who can understand Welsh. 58% of schools in Carmarthenshire are Welsh medium or dual stream¹, therefore it could be assumed that there would be a high level of residents aged 15-and-under who would be able to understand Welsh. A possible contributor to this low percentage could be the slight change in classification on this Census question.

At LSOA level, the highest percentages by age group that can understand Welsh only is in De Tref Caerfyrddin 2 for both 16–24-year-olds and 35–49-year-olds. Similarly, De Tref Caerfyrddin 1 had the highest percentage for the 15-and-under age group at 15.38%, although at a county level, this is the age group with the lowest percentage overall. This substantiates the data in Appendix F which indicates that the LSOA's in the De Tref Caerfyrddin area consistently have the highest proportion of residents who understand Welsh only.

Llanfihangel-ar-Arth 2 has the lowest percentages of residents that can understand Welsh only for both 16–24 year olds and 50-64 year olds. The lowest proportions of people who can understand Welsh only, differed among age groups.

For example, in Abergwili the age group that understood Welsh only the least was 25-34 year olds, whereas in Glyn the 15 and under age group ranked the lowest. However, the lowest percentage of those who can understand Welsh only within individual LSOA's never fell within the 35-49 and 50-64 age groups.

Across Carmarthenshire more women could understand Welsh only than men, with 11.40% of women (10,679) compared to 10.50% (9,357) of men.

The age group which has the highest percentage that can understand Welsh only of **50-64** also shows that the percentage of women is higher than men with 13.78% and 12.41% respectively. But the age group with the lowest percentage that can understand Welsh only of **15 and under** shows us that boys are higher than girls with 8.16% and 7.60% respectively which is a contradiction to other trends we can see with age and gender.

At LSOA level, Llangeler 2 ranks the lowest in the percent of women who understand Welsh with 5.06%. As well as having the lowest male and female combined of 5.84%.

In contrast, Dafen 1 has the highest percent of women who understand Welsh at LSOA level, with 16.84%. This translates to 126 women out of 748 in this area.

Among each LSOA none of the lowest percent for women came from the 50-64 and 35-49 age group.

Like all usual residents, the age groups that are in the 'middle' tend to have the highest proportion of those who can understand Welsh. With either the youngest or oldest women in Carmarthenshire consistently having the lowest numbers.

Tables 25 & 26 below depict the five highest and lowest proportions of male residents who understand Welsh only by LSOA. De Tref Caerfyrddin 2 has the overall highest proportion of male residents that can understand Welsh only, with 16.46% (134 residents), followed by Elli 1 with 16.01% (106).

In contrast, Llanfihangel-ar-Arth 1 had the lowest percentage of men who can understand Welsh only, with only 5.84% (44). However, this LSOA has the highest overall percentage of residents who can speak Welsh, with 62.2% (847).

Appendix H shows that the highest percentage of men that can understand Welsh were from with 16-24 age group, where 22.73% reported having this skill in Welsh. With the lowest percentage of men coming from Trimsaran with 0% of men aged 16-24 being able to understand Welsh. Like women in the county, men aged 50-64 had the highest proportion of residents who could understand Welsh. With 12.41% of male residents across all LSOA's reporting they could understand Welsh. Within this age group Gorllewin Tref Caerfyrddin 1 had the highest proportion of 50–64-year-olds who reported having this Welsh skill, with 22.22%.

However, for men there was no LSOA with multiple age groups that had either the highest or lowest proportion of people who can understand Welsh. Therefore, there is no one LSOA in regard to men that stands out as a good example, or one that needs improving.

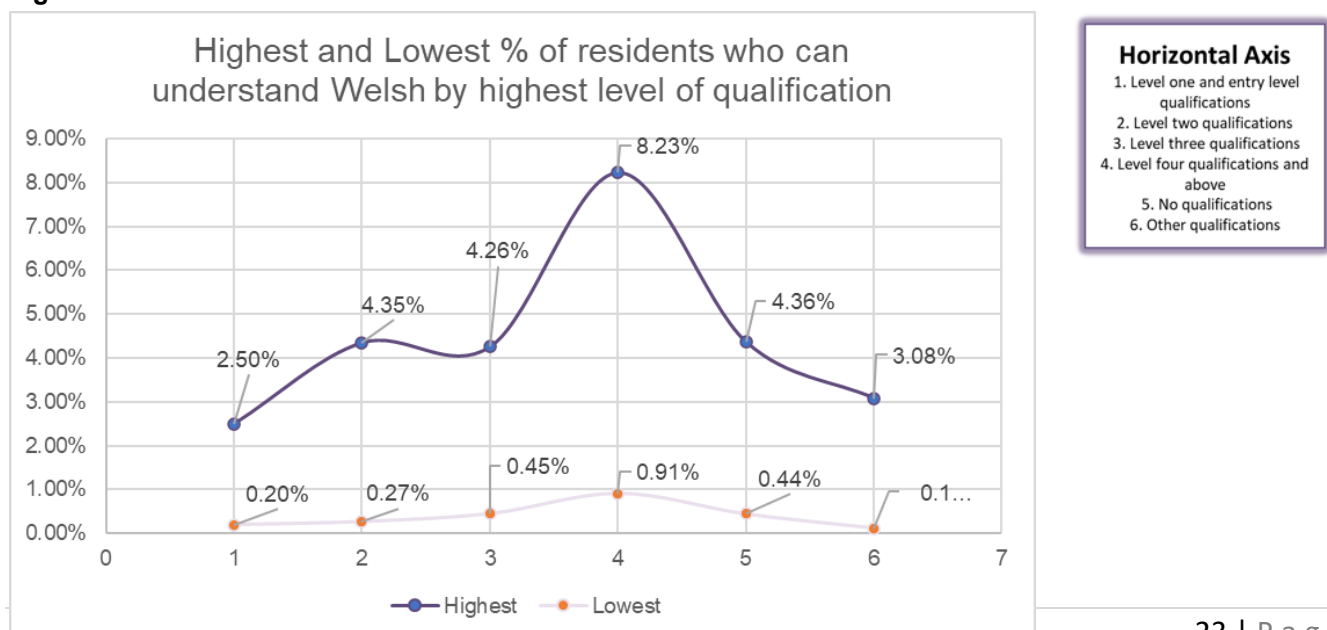

From Level one and entry level qualifications to Level four qualifications the percentage of those who can understand Welsh only gradually increases. From 0.83% (1,512 residents) at Level one to 3.12% (5,700 residents) at Level four and above having the highest. This suggests that those with a higher level of qualification are more likely to be able to understand Welsh only. Therefore, there is a need to target interventions at those who are younger or have lower-level qualifications. Interestingly, the second highest proportion of those who can understand Welsh is those with no qualifications, at 1.78% (3,251 residents).

Qualifications at each level within our 111 LSOA's shows a dramatic difference between the highest and the lowest proportions of residents who can understand Welsh only, as the graph below illustrates. For example, the highest level of those who understands Welsh only with level four qualifications or above was 8.23%, but this dropped to 0.91% at its lowest. This is a difference of 7.32 percentage points between LSOA's.

Of the highest percentages by qualification level, Hengoed 2 had the highest proportion of residents who could understand Welsh in three out of six categories. Those with level one, level two, and level 4 & above qualifications in this LSOA all had the highest percentage for their respective category. This LSOA also has the highest percentage across all LSOA's and qualification levels, with 8.23% in the level 4 and above category. Hengoed 2 is also the highest LSOA overall, with 20.81% of residents with level one qualifications and above being able to understand Welsh. This translates to 225 out of 1,081 residents.

Table 28 depicts the LSOA's with the lowest proportion of those who are qualified to some level and can understand Welsh. The lowest being 3.45% of qualified residents in Cwarter Bach being able to understand Welsh, which translates to only 72 residents out of 2,089. The LSOA's in the table above are areas that we can identify as being a priority when looking to improve Welsh language skills in the county.

Section 4 – Main Findings

The above data provides insights into where possible interventions could be concentrated within the county to support the promotion and protection of the Welsh language. Main findings are summarised below under key themes.

Siarad Cymraeg

- ❖ 2.2 percentage point increase in population in Carmarthenshire but a 4.0 percentage point decrease in the percentage of Welsh speakers.
- ❖ Pontyberem is the only Ward to have over 60% of the population 3 and over able to speak Welsh with 60.7%. Whereas Tyisha ward was the lowest with 18.9%.
- ❖ Five LSOA's have over 60% of those aged 3 to 18 able to speak Welsh.
 - Cwarter Bach 1 / Llannon 2 / Gorslas 1 / Pontyberem 1 / Pontyberem 2
- ❖ Four LSOA's had decreased by more than 10 percentage points between 2011 and 2021,
 - Glanaman 1, / Glanaman 2, / Llangyndeym 1, / Llanybydder 2.
- ❖ All local authorities saw a decrease in the 3-15 age group, in Carmarthenshire this has decreased by 510 people, a 2.6 percentage point decrease.
- ❖ The only age group to see a slight increase of 0.1 percentage point was the 25-34 group, whereas those over 65 saw significant decreases, with the largest decrease of 9.4 percentage points within the 65-74 age group, this is also the age group which has the highest % of people born outside of Wales with 34.3%.
- ❖ There has been an increase in the proportion of Welsh speakers aged 3-18 living with a couple where neither can speak Welsh.
- ❖ The 2021 Census showed the highest percentage of Welsh speakers in Carmarthenshire work within Professional Occupations. This has changed from Skilled Trades in 2011. At Ward level the split of the highest percentage of Welsh Speakers vary between the three occupational groups of Professional occupations, Skilled Trades occupations and the Caring, leisure and other service occupations.
- ❖ At LSOA level, Gorslas 2 has the highest number of Welsh speakers in five out of the nine occupation categories. This is not surprising as Gorslas 2 has the second highest number of Welsh speakers 3 and over (1,399), only behind Gorslas 1 with 1,467 people.
- ❖ In Carmarthenshire, the highest number and percentage of Welsh speakers are employed within the public administration, education, and health industries. The highest percentage point decrease was 2.7 in the distribution, hotels and restaurants industries, from 19.3% to 16.5%.
- ❖ Over a quarter of Carmarthenshire residents state that they were born outside of Wales, a 2.2 percentage point increase from the 2011 Census and a possible contributor to the decrease in Welsh speakers.
- ❖ 20.2% of residents were born in England, and there has been a 166% increase in the number of residents moving to Carmarthenshire since the 2011 Census.
- ❖ 85,287 residents reported having no skills in Welsh, which is a 4.8 percentage point increase over the last 10 years. The number of residents able to speak, read, and write Welsh has decreased by 1,828 people.

- ❖ 10.96% (20,036) of people in Carmarthenshire “understand spoken Welsh only”, this is above the Welsh average of 5.20% but shows a 0.7 percentage point decrease against the 2011 census result of 11.66% (20,716).
- ❖ Swiss Valley Ward has the highest proportion of residents who could understand Welsh only at 14.59%. (354), compared to 29.78% stating they could speak Welsh. Llanfihangel-ar-Arth had the lowest percentage that could understand Welsh only with 6.92%. However, this ward ranked the 9th highest for Welsh speakers, with 53.4%.
- ❖ The LSOA De Tref Caerfyrddin 2 had the highest percentage of residents that can understand Welsh only at 15.95%. However, in 2011 the highest percentage was 16.91% in Rhydaman 1.
- ❖ Of the 111 LSOA’s in Carmarthenshire, 35 saw an increase in the percentage of residents who can understand Welsh only. This could be to the detriment of those that could speak Welsh as each of these 35 LSOA’s that increased the proportion of those that understand Welsh only, had a decrease in Welsh speakers. This could be an indication that there has been a decline in confidence among Carmarthenshire residents to utilise their Welsh skills.
- ❖ 75 LSOA’s saw a decrease in the proportion of residents that can understand Welsh only. The biggest decrease was in Glanymor 2 with a decrease of 4.22 percentage points.
- ❖ Of all the age groups, the 50-64 age group had the highest percentage of residents who could understand Welsh only, with 13.12%. Gorllewin Tref Caerfyrddin 1 was the LSOA with the highest proportion of residents in that age group who could understand Welsh only with 21.36%.
- ❖ Residents who were 15-and-under at the time of the Census had the lowest percentage that can understand Welsh only, with 7.89%. Many factors could contribute to this, the change in classification to “understands Welsh only” may mean this is more representative of those 15 and younger in English medium education/households. Rather than all residents 15-and-under.
- ❖ Across Carmarthenshire more women could understand Welsh only than men, with 11.40% of women (10,679) compared to 10.50% (9,357) of men. The split in the 50-64 also shows that the percentage of women is higher than men with 13.78% and 12.41% respectively, the 15 and under age group showing boys are higher than girls with 8.16% and 7.60% respectively which is a contradiction to other trends we can see with age and gender.
- ❖ Understand Welsh only by highest level of qualification revealed that those with a level 4 qualification or above were more likely to understand Welsh only compared to those with lower-level qualifications. The proportion of those that understand Welsh only, gradually increased with the level of qualification, from 0.83% at Level one to 3.12% at Level four and above. Interestingly the second highest proportion of those who understand Welsh came from those who reported having no qualifications, with 1.78%.
