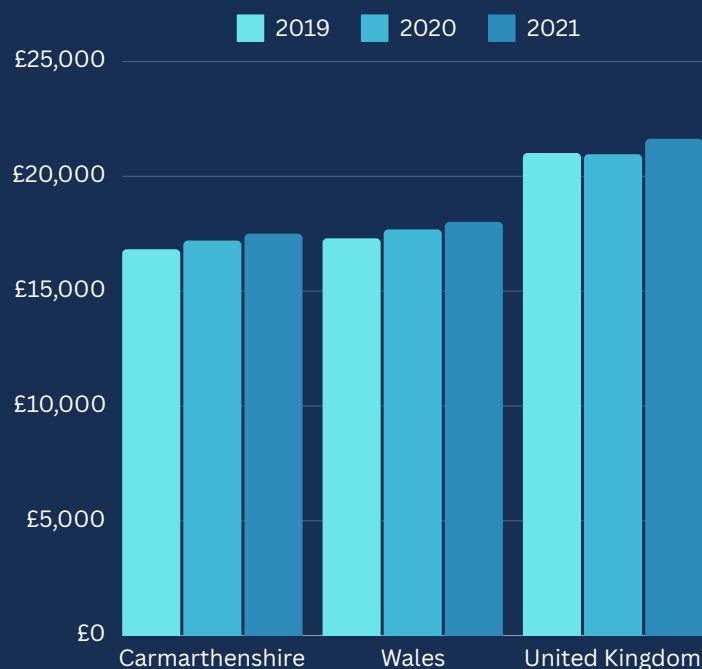


Economic Profile for Carmarthenshire

In 2022 Carmarthenshire was 2% below the Wales rate and over 20% below the UK rate.

Primary Income per head

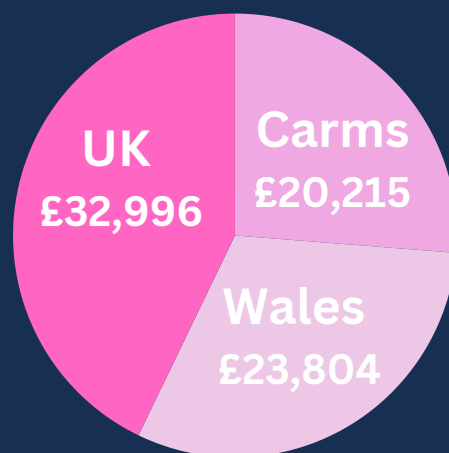
