(PUBLIC FOOTPATH 51/120 (PART), BLAENAU ROAD, LLANDYBIE)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC ORDER 2023

WHEREAS the Carmarthenshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the Highway Authority for that length of Public Footpath specified in the Schedule to this Order are satisfied that traffic on the said length of the Footpath should be restricted by reason of safety.

NOW therefore the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

No Pedestrians shall proceed along those lengths of Footpath specified in column 1 in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

This Order shall come into operation on the 25th October, 2023 and may be cited as The County of Carmarthenshire (Public footpath 51/120 (part), Blaenau Road, Llandybie) Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic Order 2023

Footpath 51/120 (part), Llandybie	From site entrance off Blaenau Road, crossing bridge, then following track in a generally westerly direction to junction with Footpath 51/O/36. Length: 370m	Following Blaenau Road in a south westerly direction, then turning northwards along Footpath 51/O/32 to rejoin original path. Length: 1250m
